

How to Digitally Sign a PDF in Adobe Reader

You should first ensure that you are using the latest version of Adobe Reader:

- Open Reader
- Click on *Help* at the top toolbar
- Click on *Check for Updates*
- Adobe will prompt you if there is an update available

To sign a PDF form:

- Open the form in Adobe Reader
- Click on the *Signature* box
 - o **If you have not already created a Digital ID, then follow these steps:**
 - When you click on the Signature box, a dialogue box called *Add Digital ID* comes up
 - Choose I want to sign this document using *a new digital ID I want to create now*
 - Then click *Next*
 - Select New PKCS #12 digital file
 - Then click *Next*
 - Enter your information; the only fields required are your name and email address
 - Then click *Next*
 - Enter a password; you will use this password to access your signature in the future
 - Then click *Finish*
 - o **If you already have a Digital ID on file, then when you click on the *Signature* box Adobe will prompt you to choose one**
- Once your signature is added to the document, you will need to save it
 - o If there is an Email Submit button on the PDF, then you can open the document back up and use the *Email Submit* button.
 - o You can also just attach the signed copy to an email as you would any attachment.
