PREFACE

This report is based on information obtained by licensing boards during the 2014 license renewal process. Copies of practitioner responses to questions on license renewal applications were provided to the Health Statistics Branch by the licensing boards. Because the data was collected by several boards using questionnaires designed to meet the licensing requirements of the individual professions, a certain consistency of format and content, desirable for manpower measurement, is missing from the data. Various items of demographic data, e.g., ethnic origin and gender, are obtained by some, but not all, of the boards. Information relating to a practitioner's location- address, city, county, state, etc.- meets the licensing board's need to communicate with the practitioner by mail and may or may not identify the site(s) where health related services are actually performed.

The report includes tables, maps and graphs representing health professions manpower distribution and demographics in Arkansas counties. The 2010 Census from the U.S. Census Bureau, Population Division, was used in the computation of population ratios throughout this report.

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Acknowledgement: We wish to express our gratitude to the licensing boards of these professions for their cooperation in providing requested access to their license-renewal files.

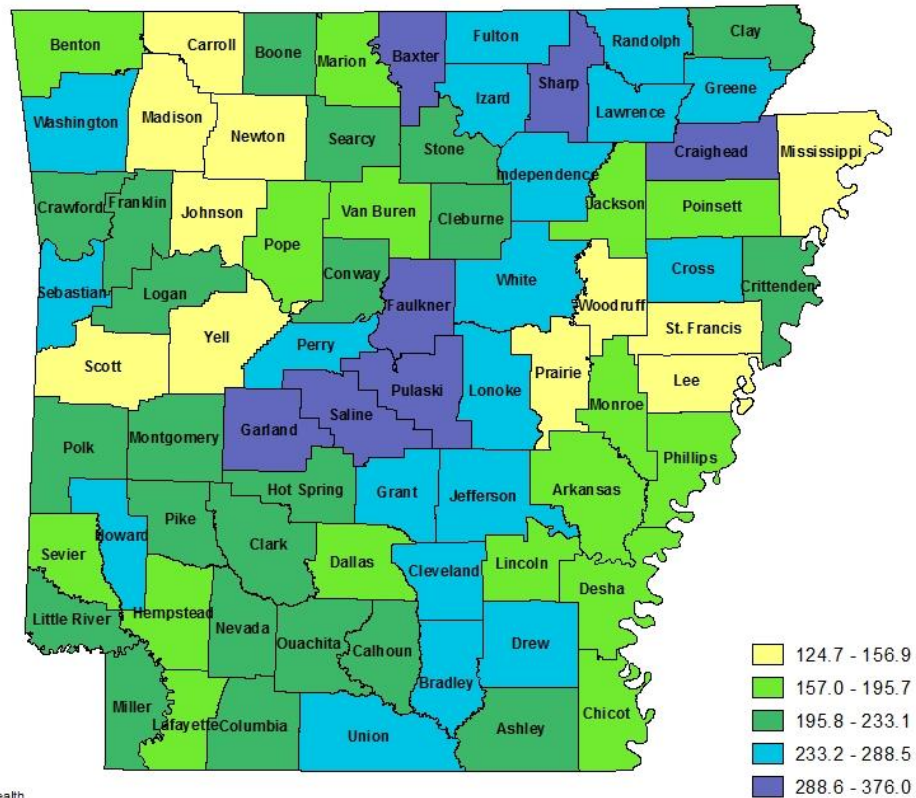
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Health Professionals in Arkansas

In 2014, there were 80,098 licensed health professionals with Arkansas mailing addresses serving 2.96 million Arkansans, a population ratio of 270 professionals for every 10,000 population living in the State. There were 17 professions administered by 13 boards. The largest registration was by the Arkansas State Board of Nursing with 49,210 licensees, followed by the Arkansas State Medical Board with 10,077 licensees. The smallest registration was by the Arkansas Board of Podiatric Medicine with 73 licensees. As a group, health professionals were distributed fairly evenly across the counties with a heavier concentration in counties with larger populations.

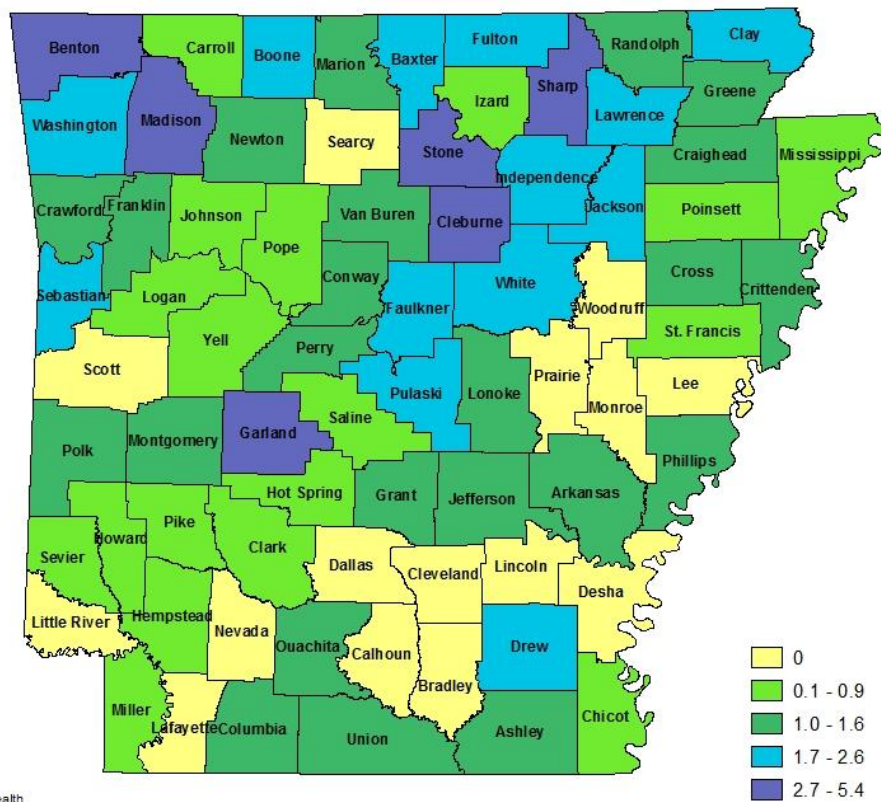

Chiropractors in Arkansas

In 2014, the Board of Chiropractic Examiners licensed 503 chiropractors with mailing addresses in Arkansas, about 1.7 per 10,000 populations. Of the 75 counties in Arkansas, 14 counties (19%) had no registered chiropractors and 14 other counties (19%) had only one.

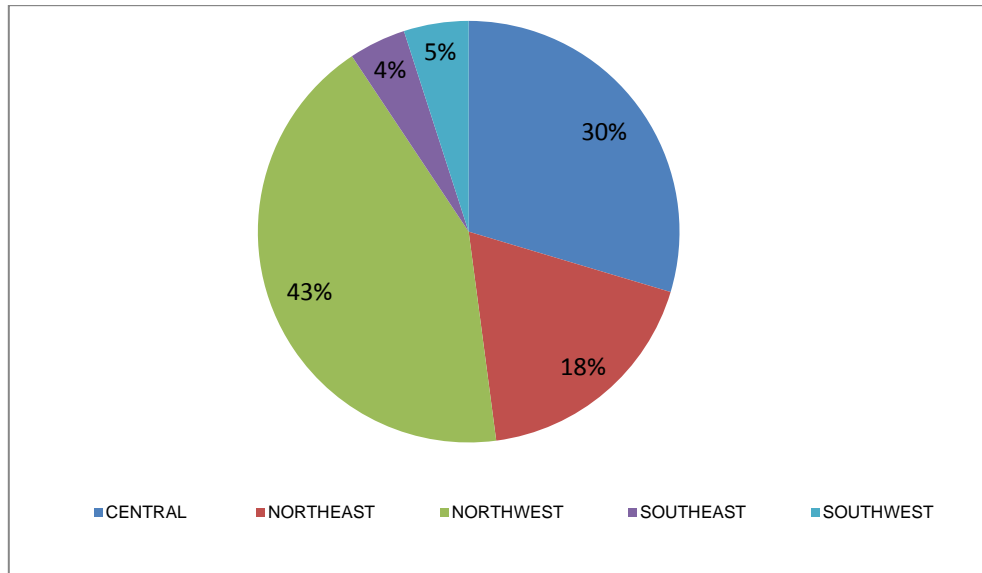
Chiropractors by Counties Per 10,000 Population



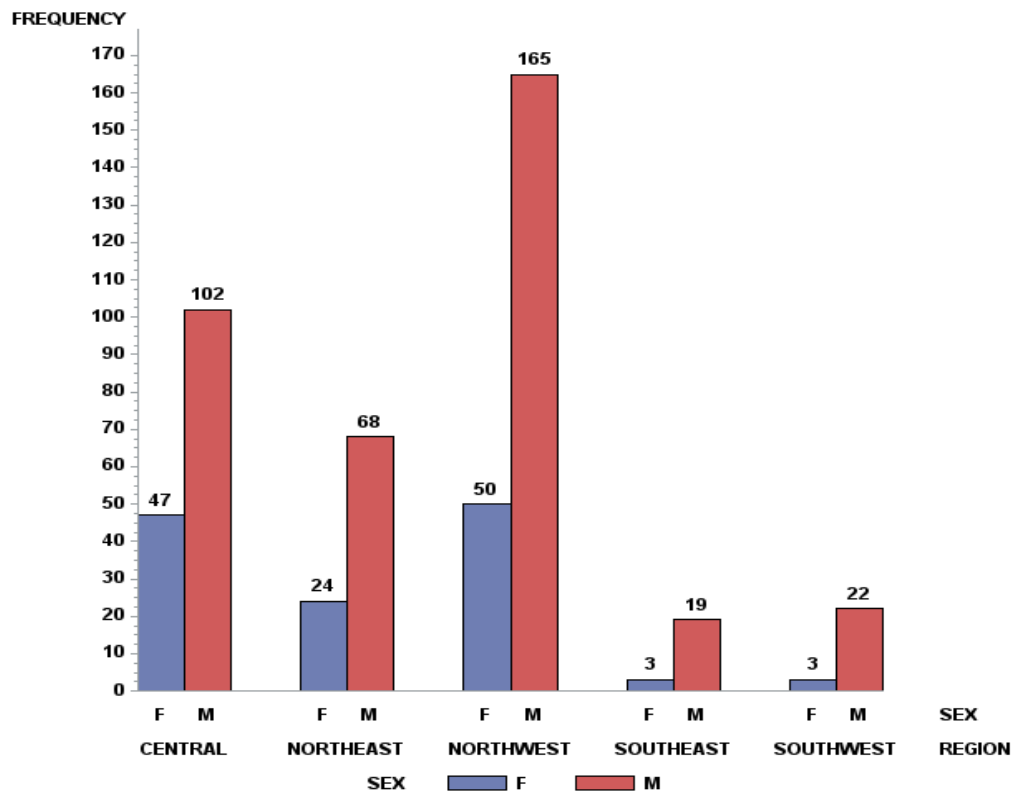

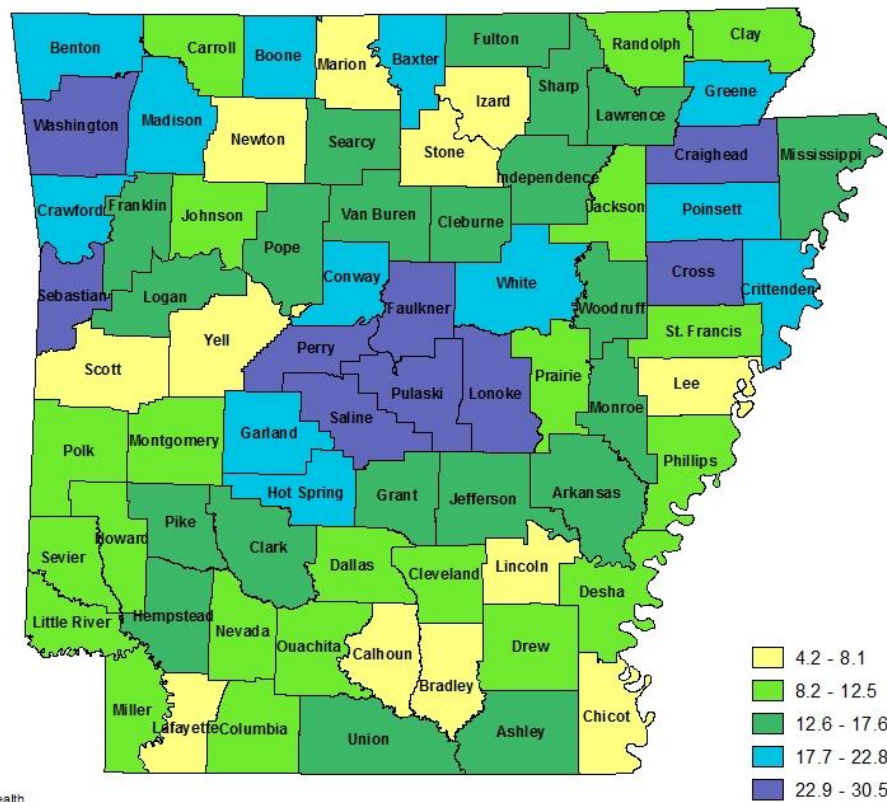

Dental Health Providers in Arkansas

In 2014, the Board of Dental Examiners licensed 6,026 providers of dental health services with mailing addresses in Arkansas, about 20 per 10,000 populations. This total includes 1,301 dentists (D), 3,124 dental assistants (DA), and 1,601 dental hygienists (DH). Overall, the number of dental health providers increased by 0.2% for the state. Individually there was an increase in D by 2.6%, a decrease in DA by 2.6%, and an increase in DH by 6.9%. Each of the 75 counties in Arkansas had at least three registered dental health providers.

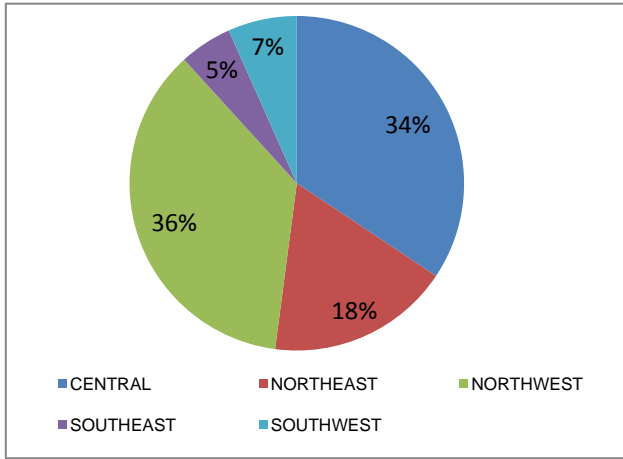
Dental Health Providers by Counties Per 10,000 Population



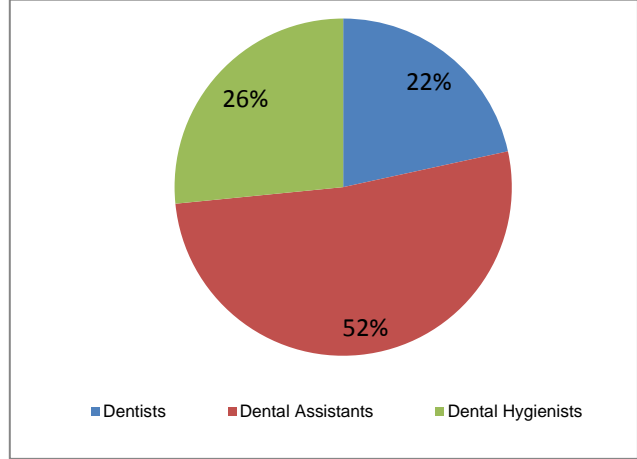

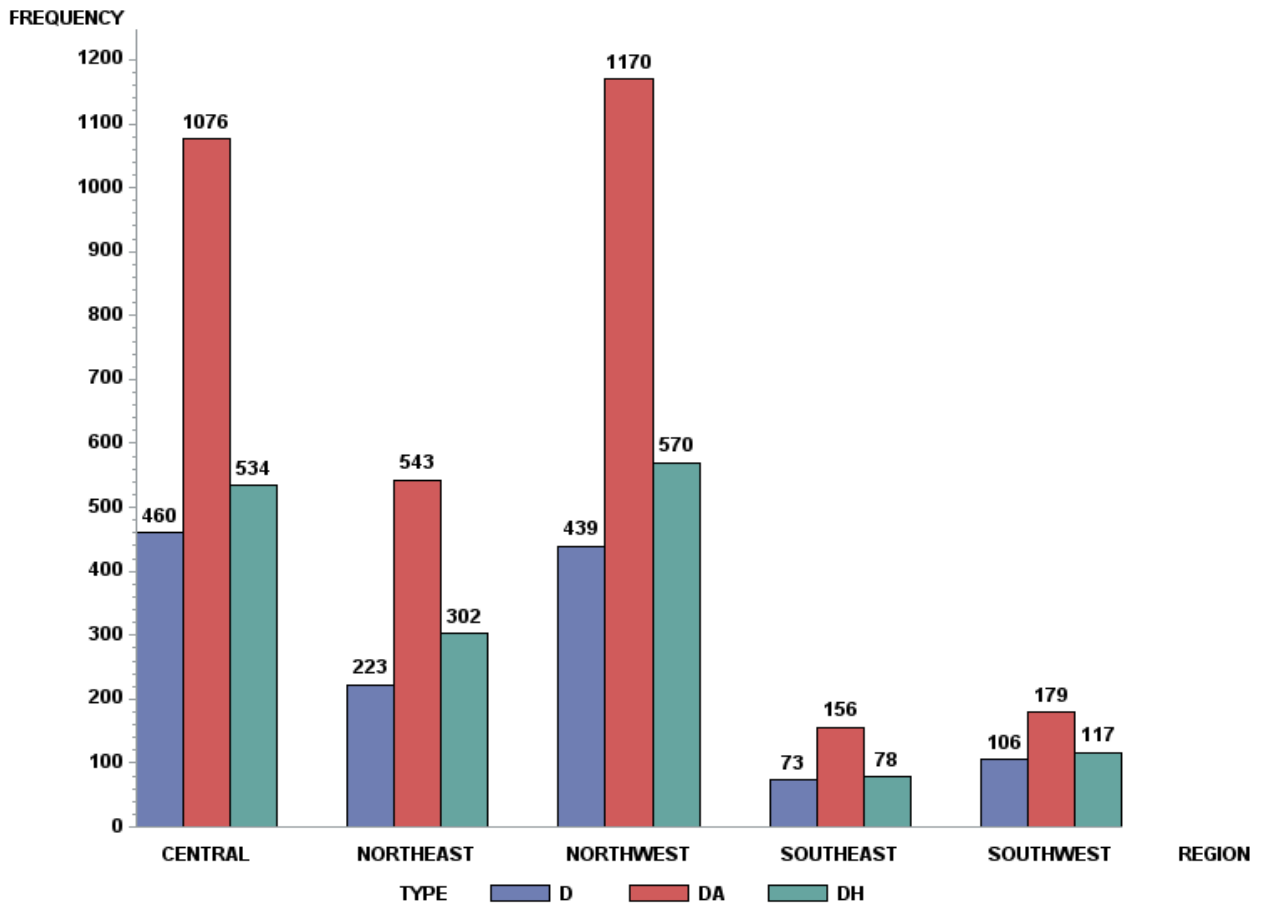
Distribution of Dental Providers by Region



Distribution of Dental Providers by Specialty

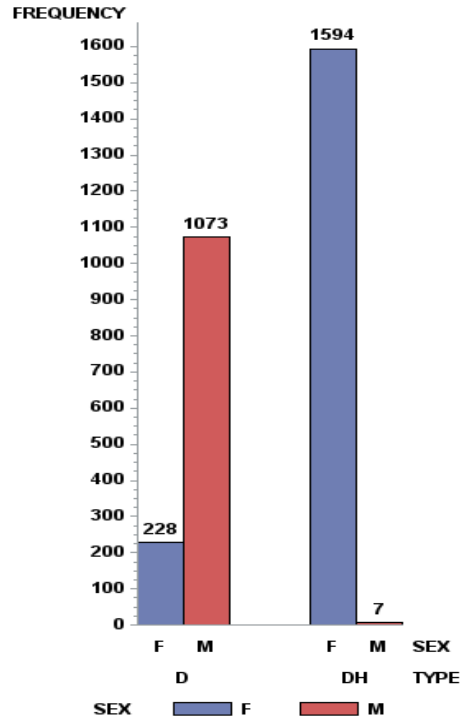


Dental Health Providers by Region

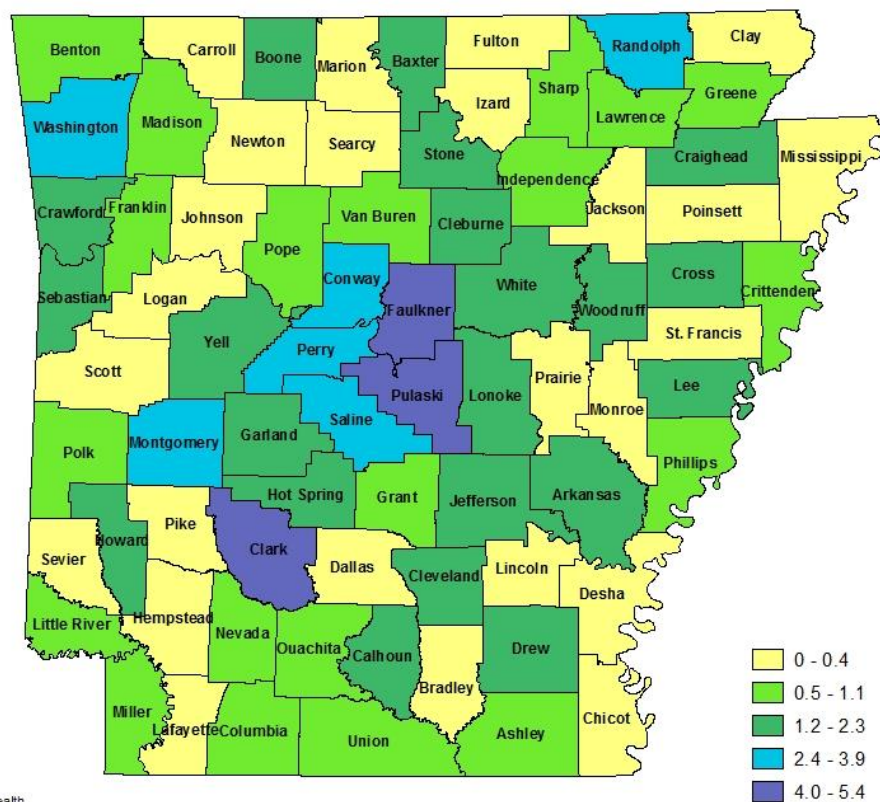

Dietitians by Counties Per 10,000 Population

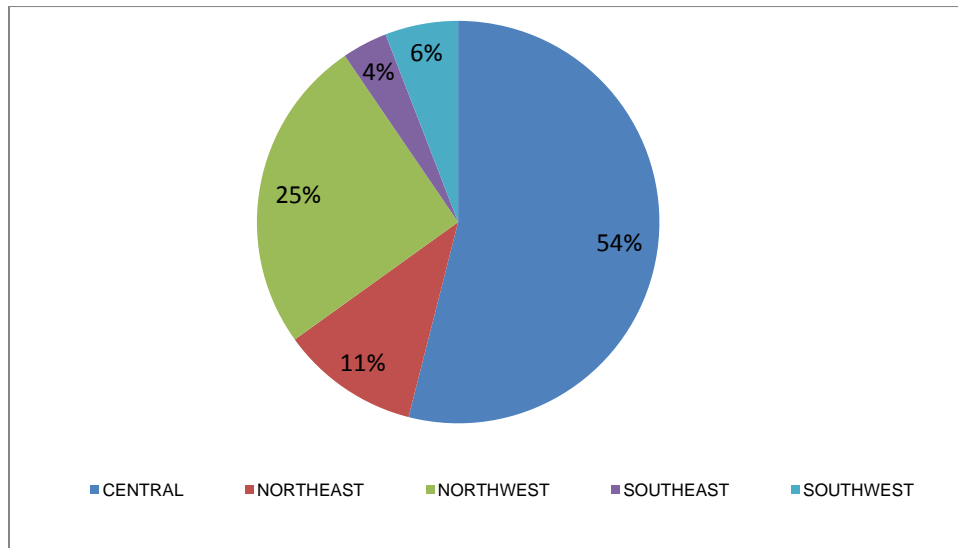

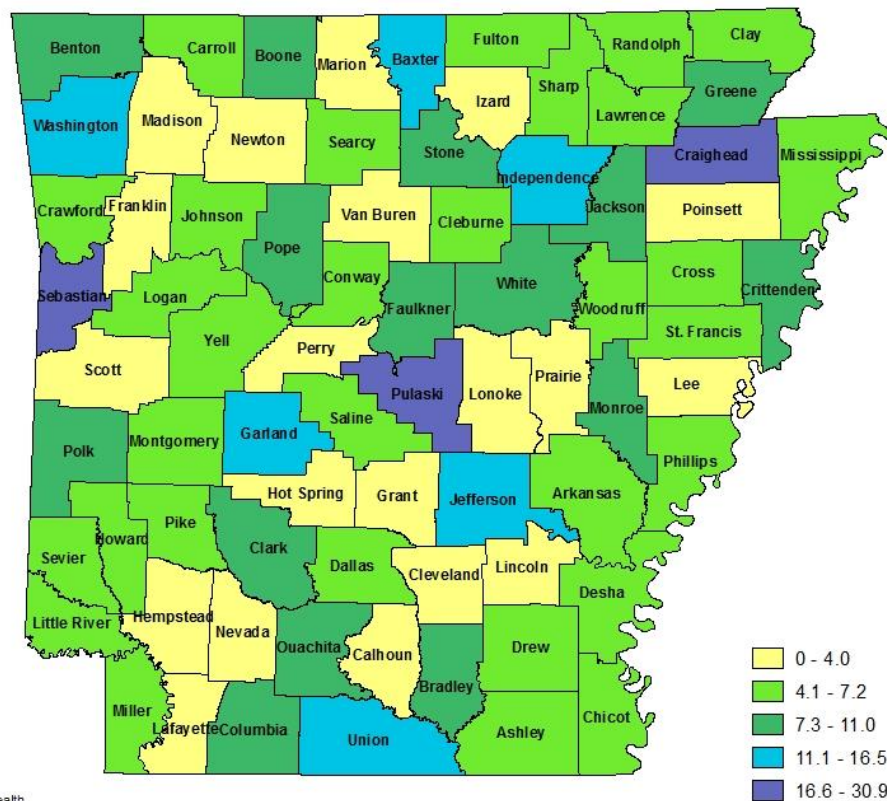

Medical (Doctors) in Arkansas

In 2014, the Medical Board licensed 10,077 health professionals with mailing addresses in Arkansas. The 2014 registry includes 3,721 physicians (37%) registered in five primary care specialties with mailing addresses in Arkansas, about 12.5 per 10,000 population. This list includes: 1,454 family practice, 95 general practice, 1,299 internal medicine, 302 obstetrics-gynecologists (OB/GYN), and 571 pediatrics. At least one fully licensed primary care physician was registered in each Arkansas County with the exception of Prairie County. The board licensed 2,675 physicians as secondary specialists and 25 physicians who reported no specialty. Also, the board licensed 3,681 health professionals as Health Related Professionals. This total is made up of 1,739 Respiratory Therapists (LRCP), 1,236 Occupational Therapists (OT), 426 Occupational Therapy Assistants (OT-A), 270 Physician Assistants (PA), 6 Radiologists (RA) and 4 Radiology Assistants (RPA).

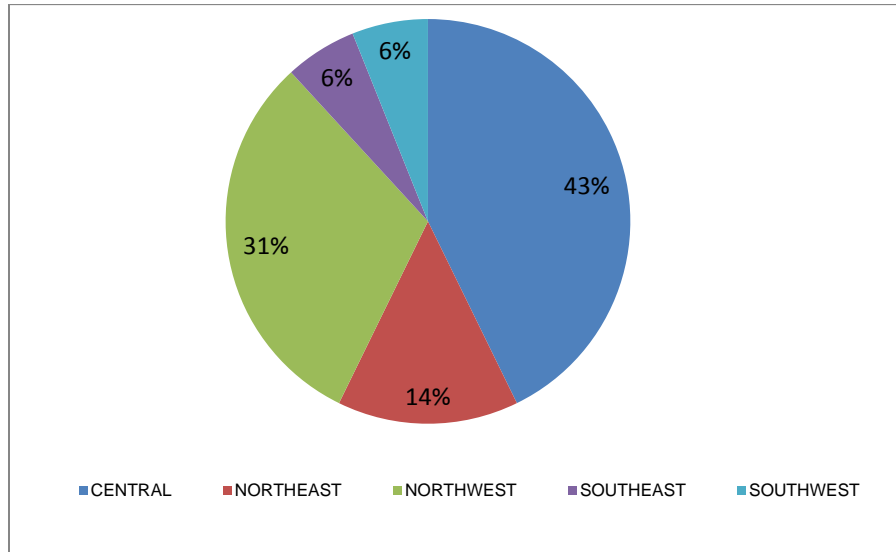
Primary Care Physicians by Counties Per 10,000 Population



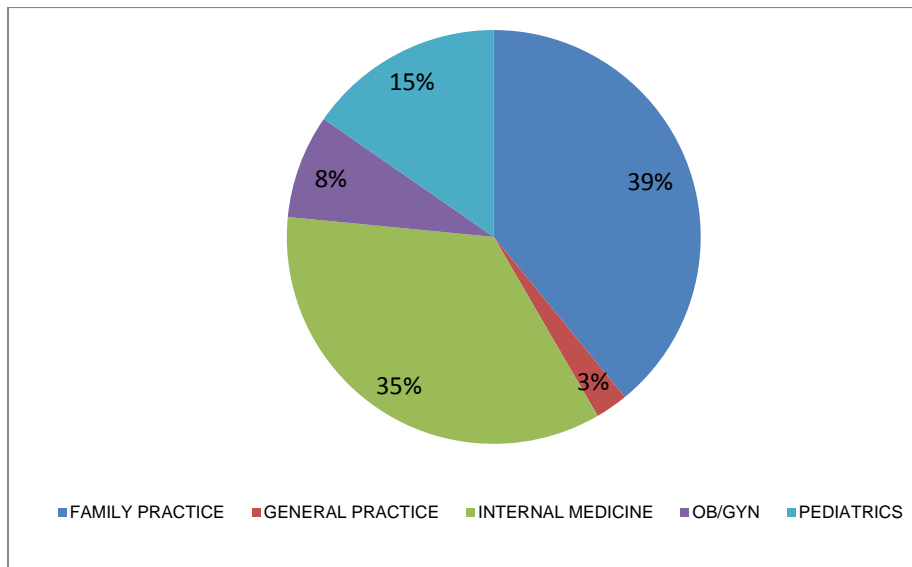

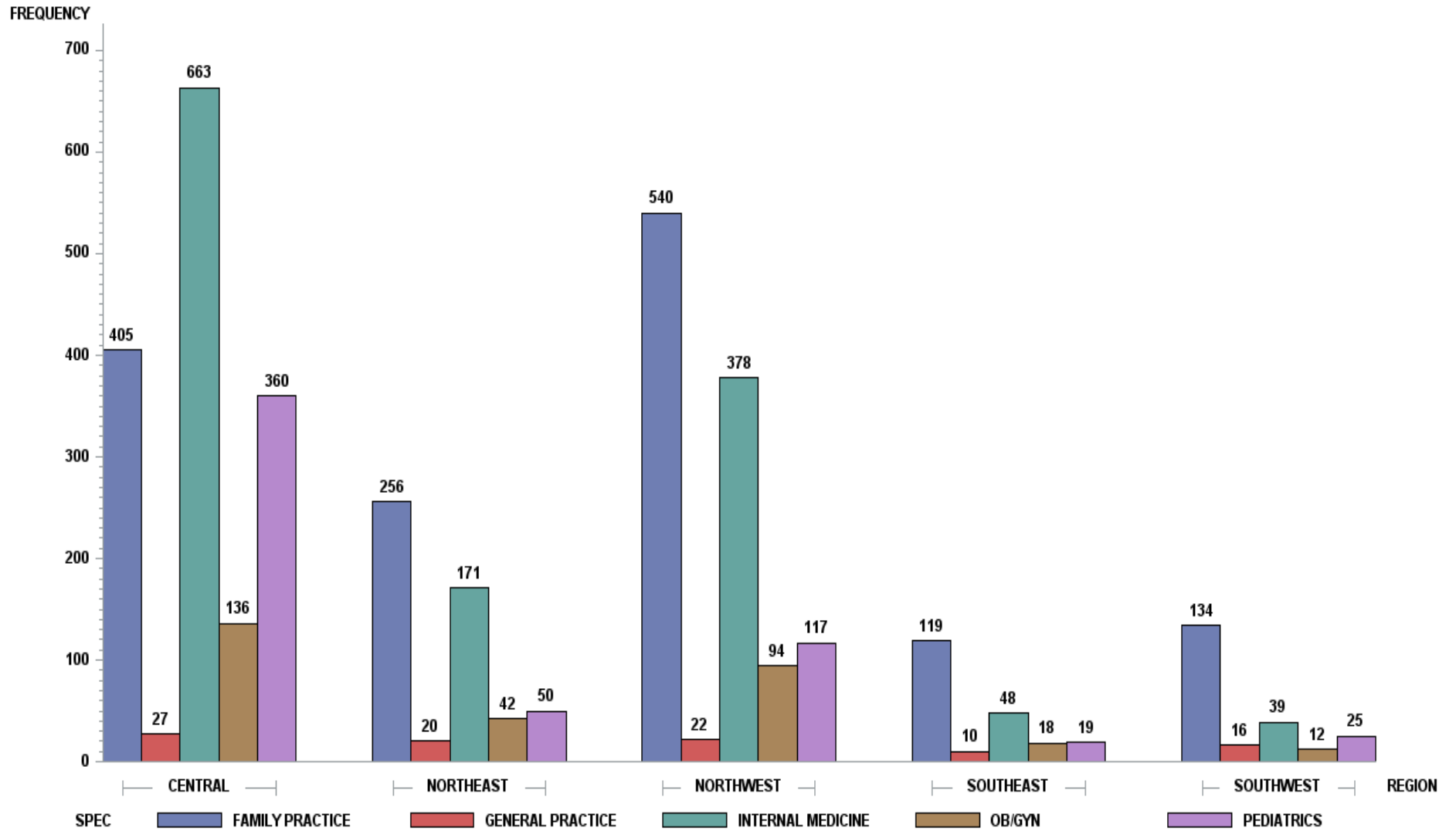
Distribution of Primary Care Physicians by Region



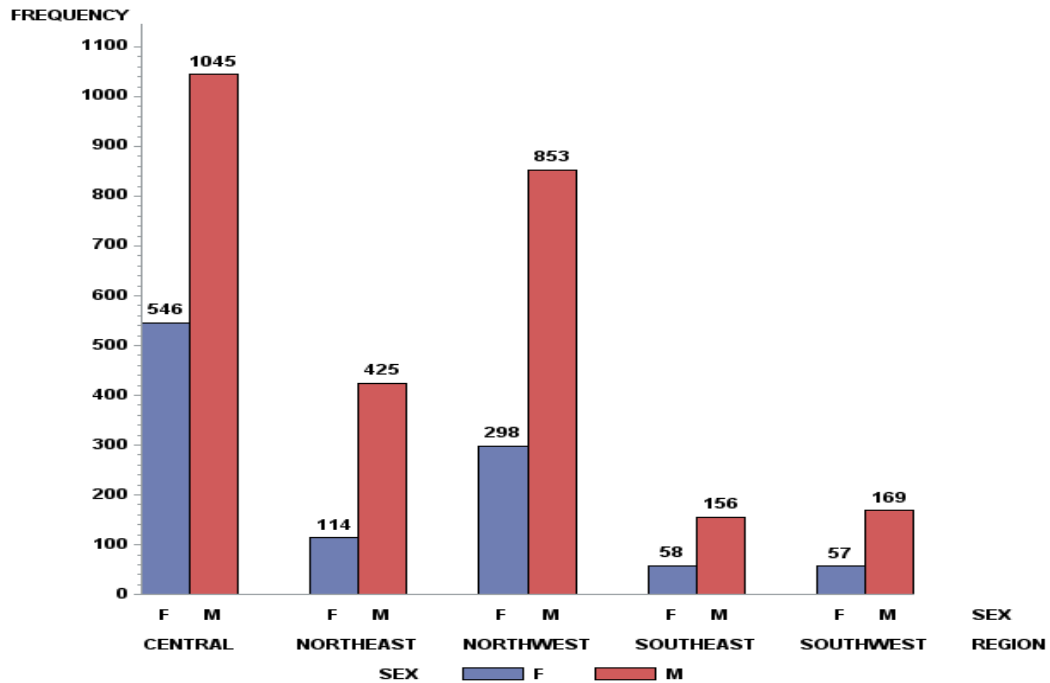
Distribution of Primary Care Physicians by Specialty



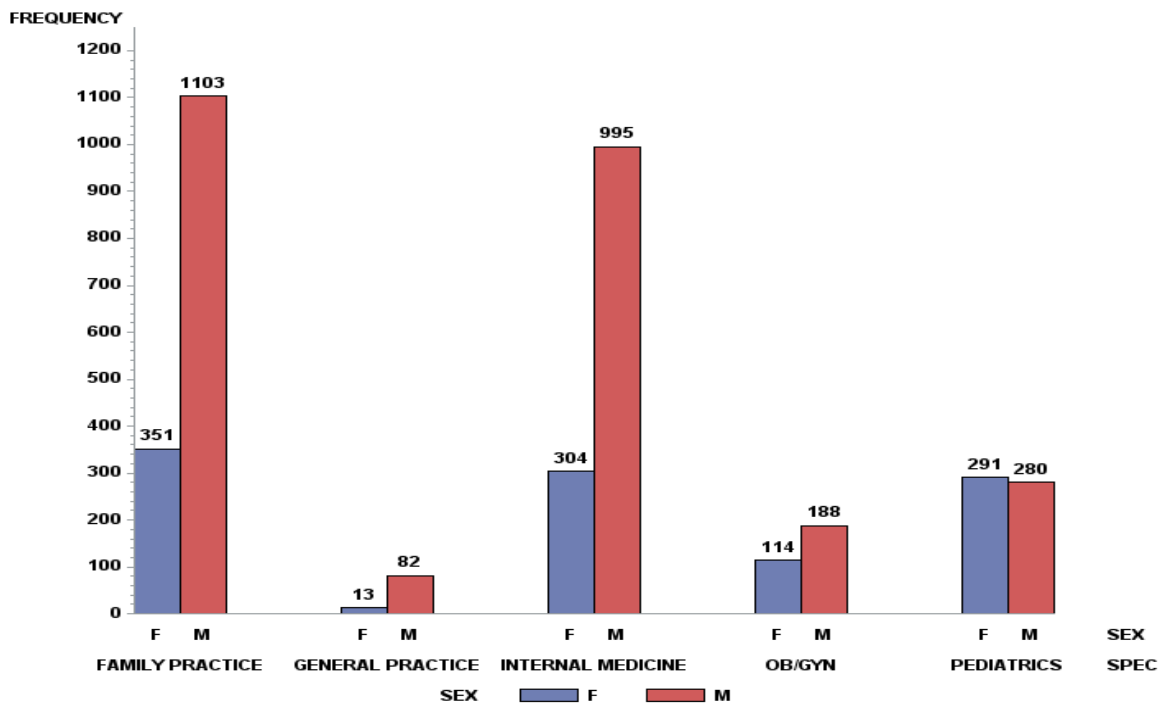
Primary Care Physicians by Region and Specialty



The gender distribution of licensed primary care physicians is heavily skewed toward males (71%), with only (29%) of licensed primary care physicians being females.



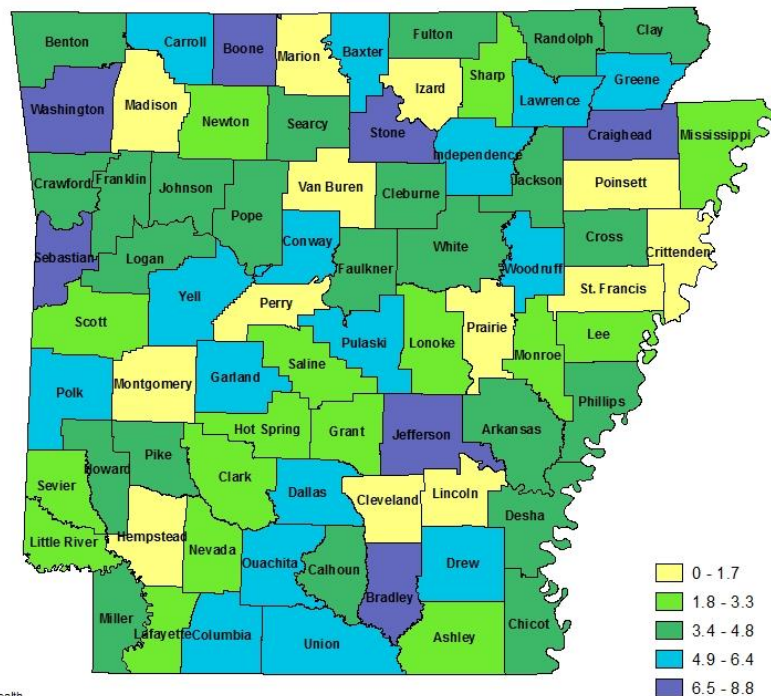
The next graph displays gender demographics among primary care physicians by specialty. The data indicate that, with the exception of pediatricians, primary care physicians are disproportionately male.

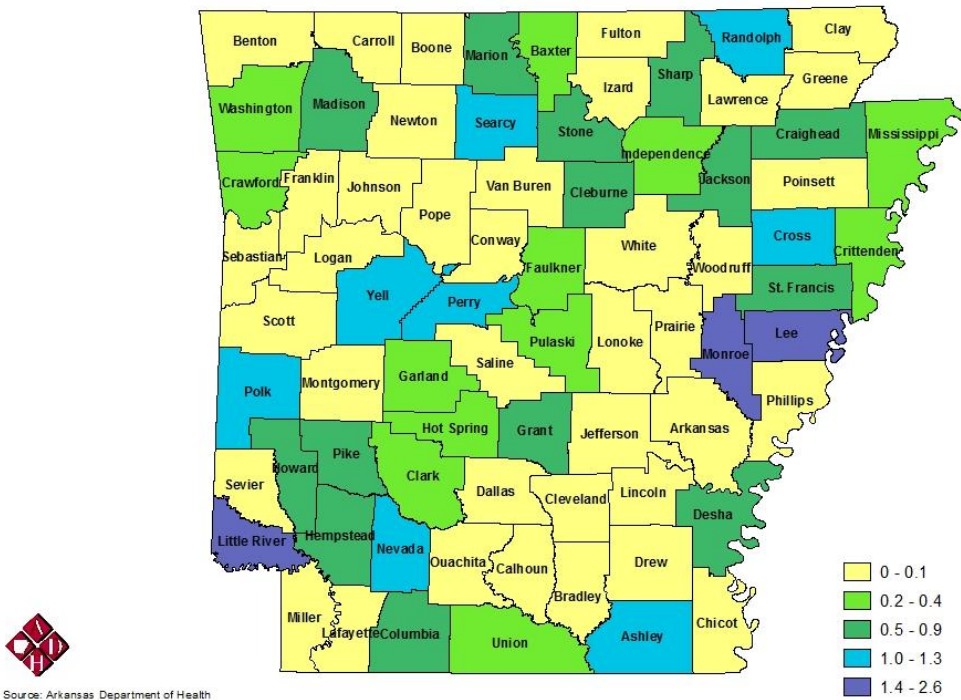

Family Practice Physicians by Counties Per 10,000 Population

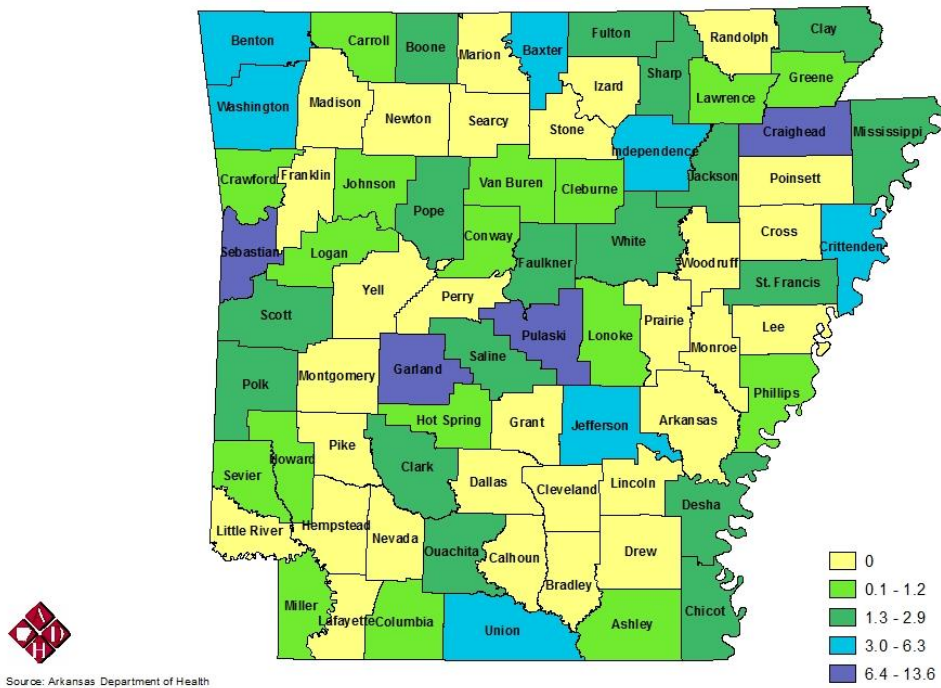

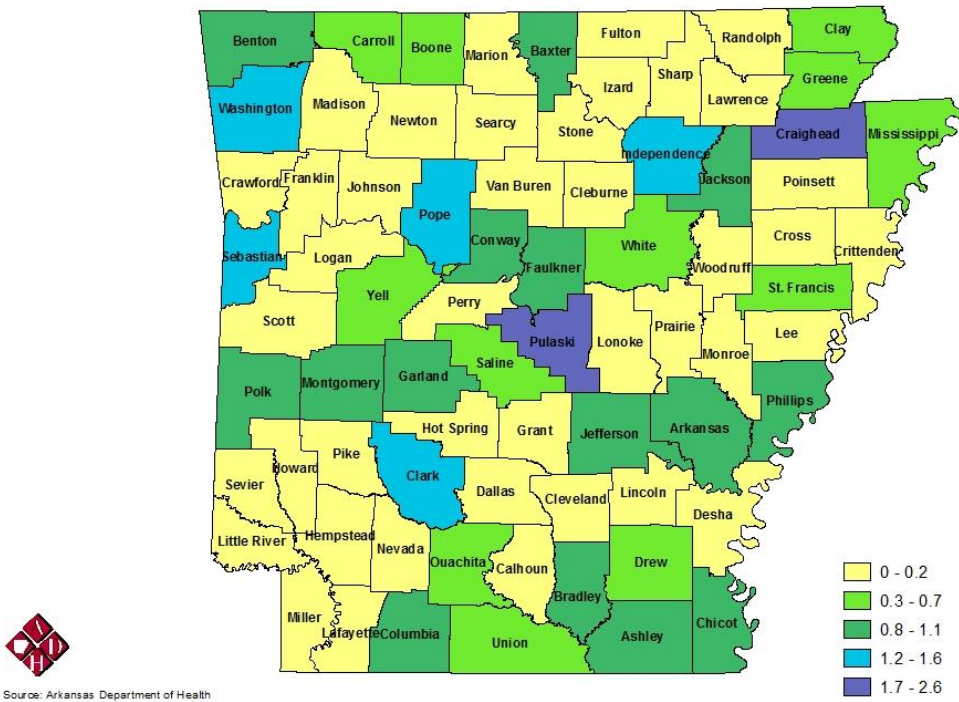
General Practice Physicians by Counties Per 10,000 Population



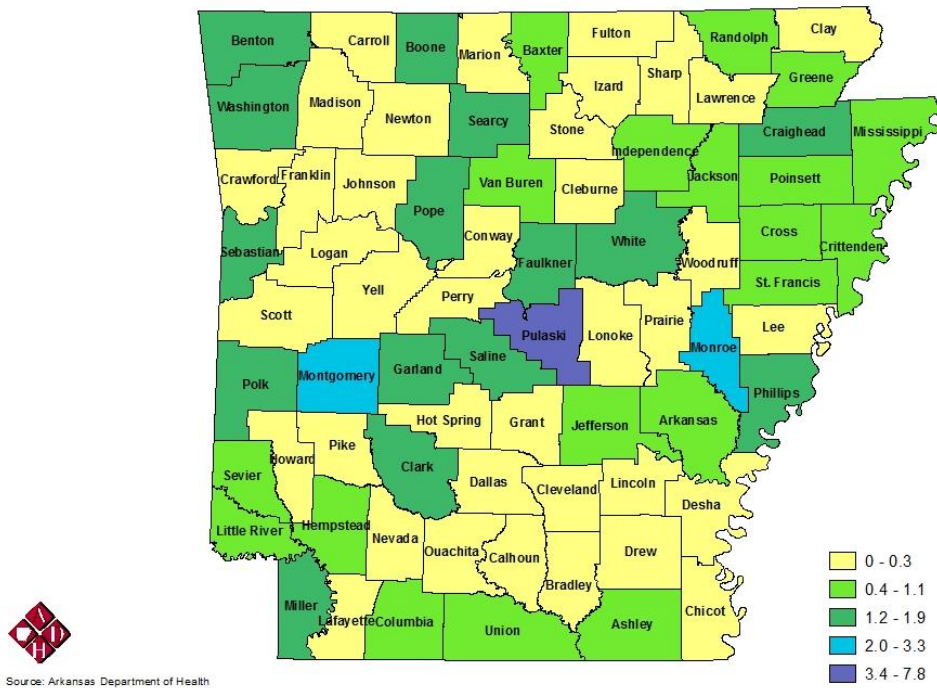
Internal Medicine Physicians by Counties Per 10,000 Population

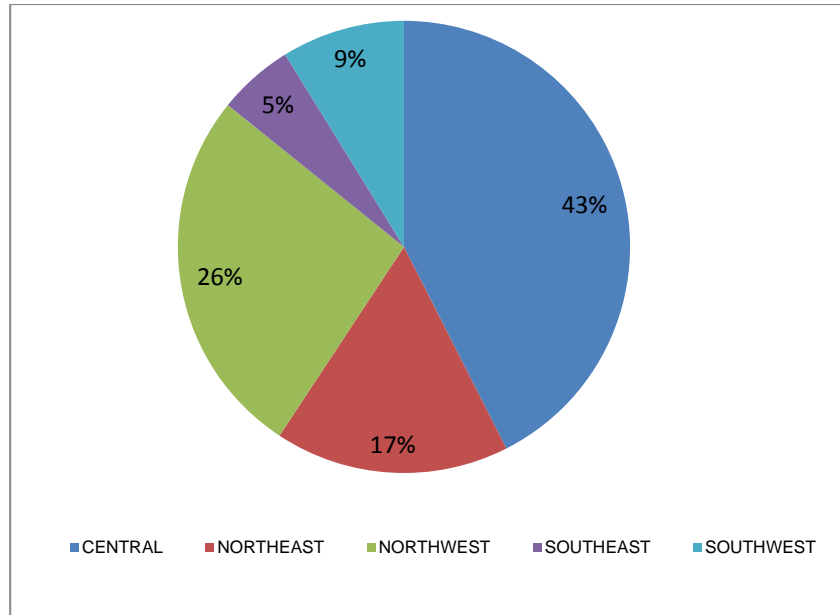

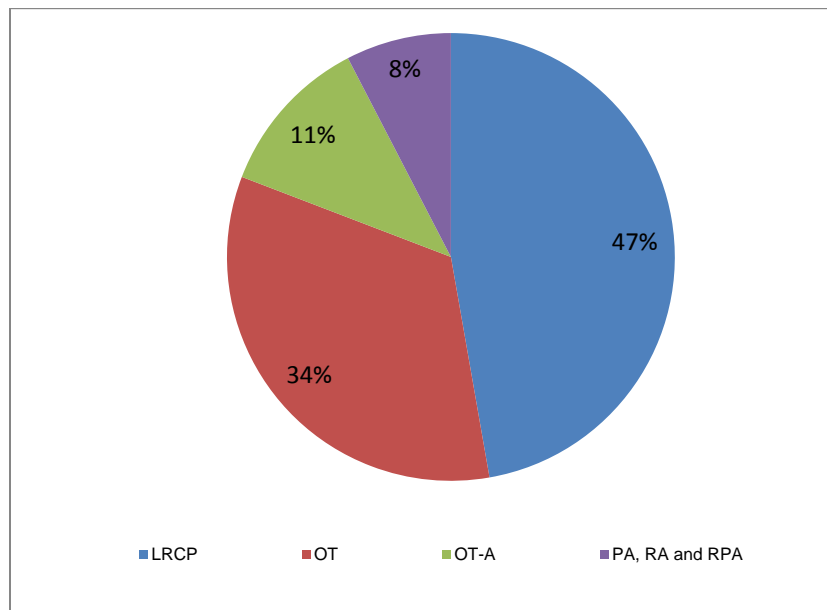
As a reminder from the introduction earlier, the board licensed 3,681 health professionals as Health Related Professionals, this total includes 1,739 Respiratory Therapists (LRCP), 1,236 Occupational Therapists (OT), 426 Occupational Therapy Assistants (OT-A), 270 Physician Assistants (PA), 6 Radiologists (RA) and 4 Radiology Assistants (RPA).

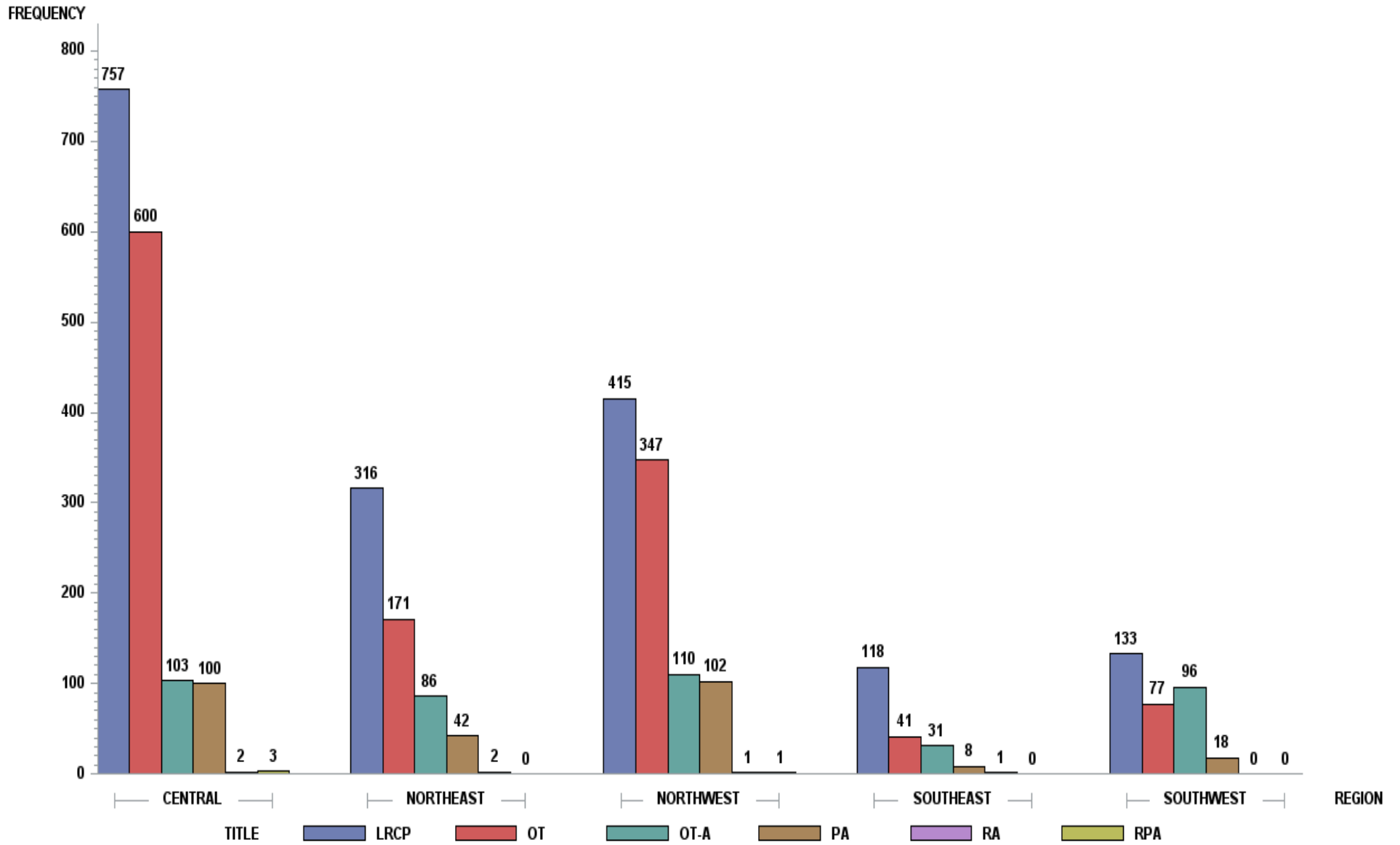
Health Related Professionals by Region



Health Related Professionals by Specialty

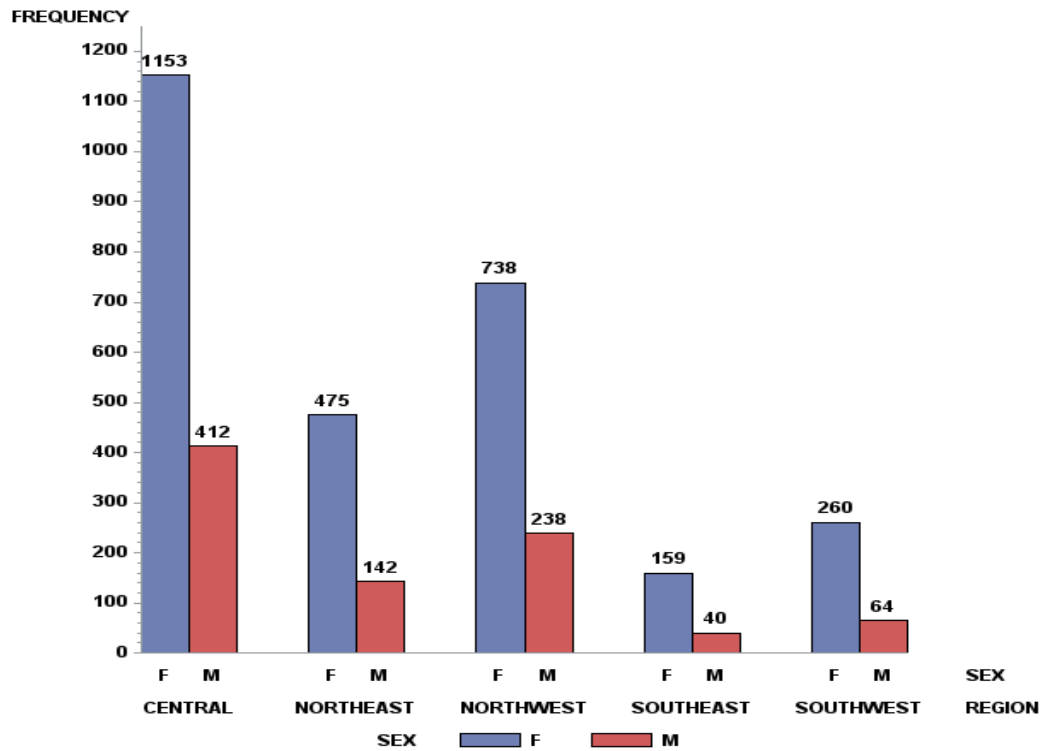


Health Related Professionals by Region and Specialty

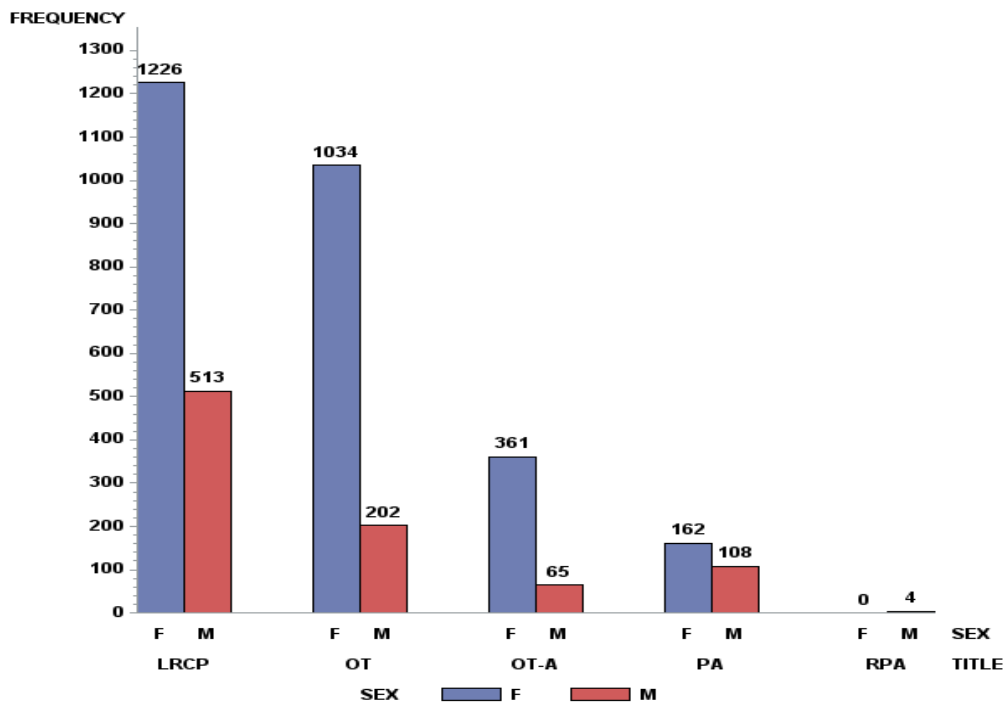

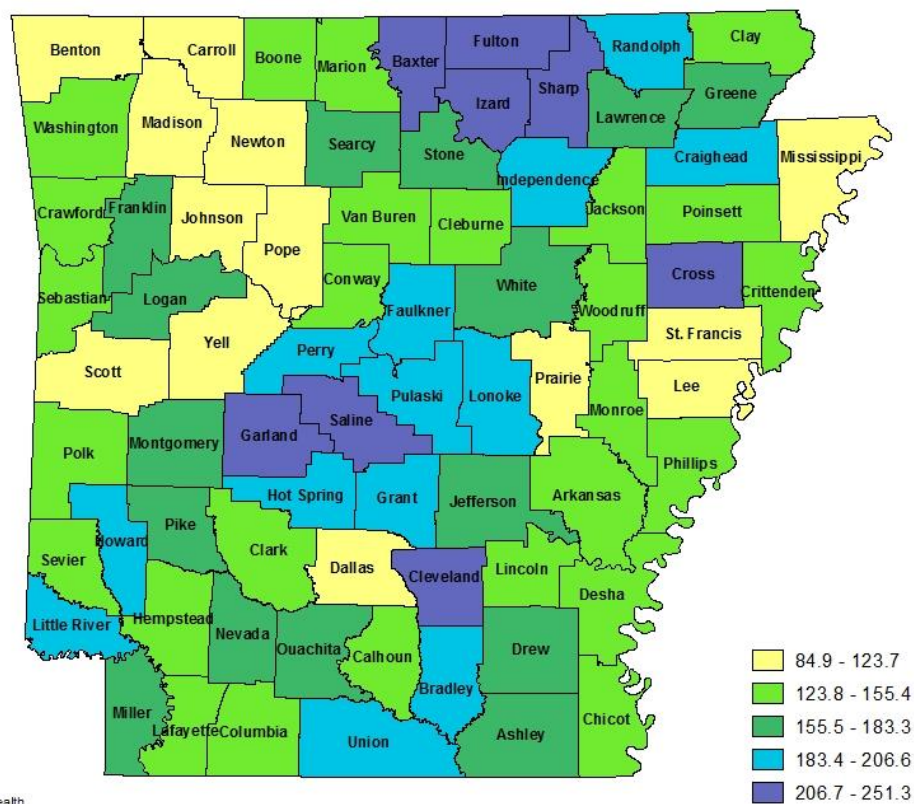

Nurses in Arkansas

In 2014, the Nursing Board licensed 49,210 nurses with mailing addresses in Arkansas, about 166 per 10,000 populations. This total includes 32,397 Registered Nurses (RN), 13,963 Licensed Practical Nurses (LPN), 89 Licensed Psychiatric Technician Nurses (LPTN), and 383 Registered Nurse Practitioners (RNP). There were 2,378 nurses registered as Advanced Practice Nurses (APN). These 49,210 nurses had a total of 52,845 licenses but for the purposes of this report we used the following hierarchy to take the highest of the five license types: LPN < LPTN < RN < RNP < APN. The APNs consist of four different licenses but will be grouped together for the majority of this section. They will be broken down into individual licenses later in the section. The number of licensed nurses for the state increased 1.4% from 2013 to 2014.

After completing basic nursing programs, RN and LPN must pass nationally standardized examinations. LPTN must have passed a state licensure exam. RNP have completed a nurse practitioner program in addition to their RN program. To be licensed as an APN, an RN must complete an advanced practice nursing program and hold certification from a Board approved, nationally recognized, certifying body.

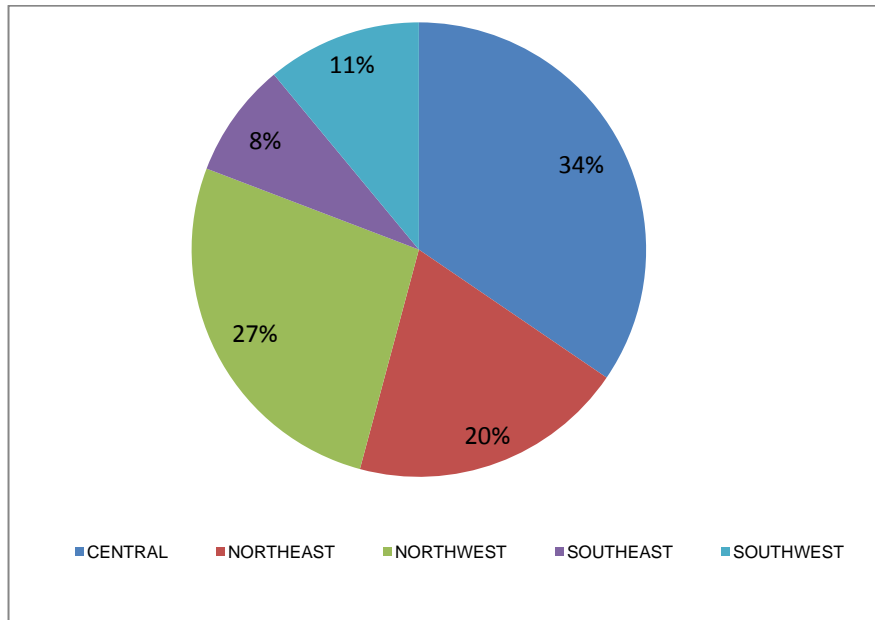
Nurses by Counties Per 10,000 Population



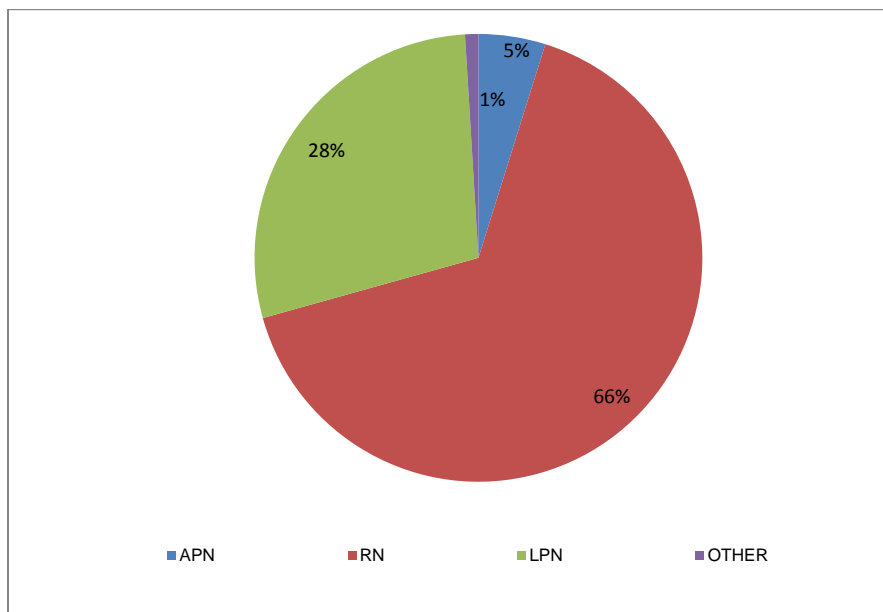

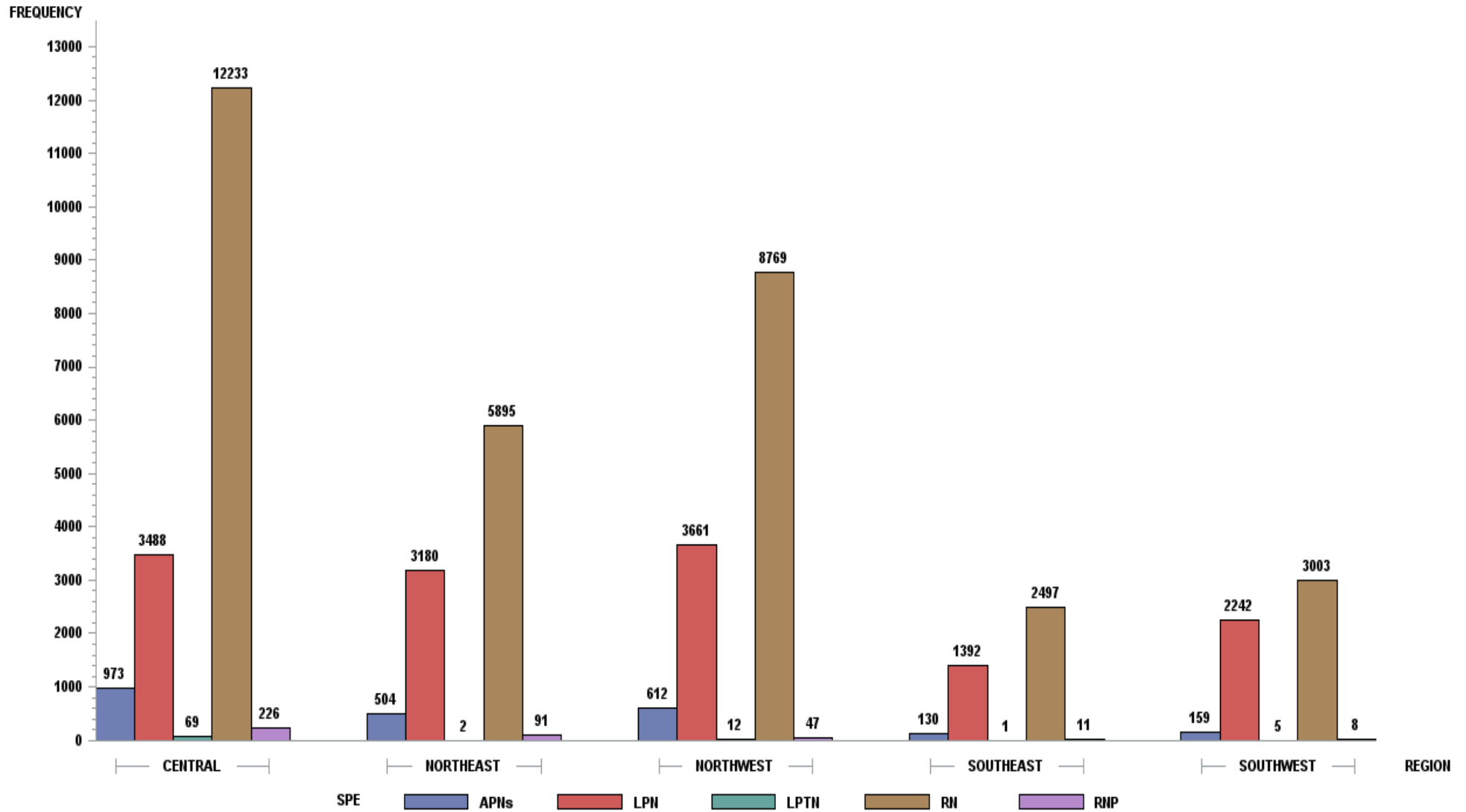
Distribution of Nurses by Region



Distribution of Nurses by Title

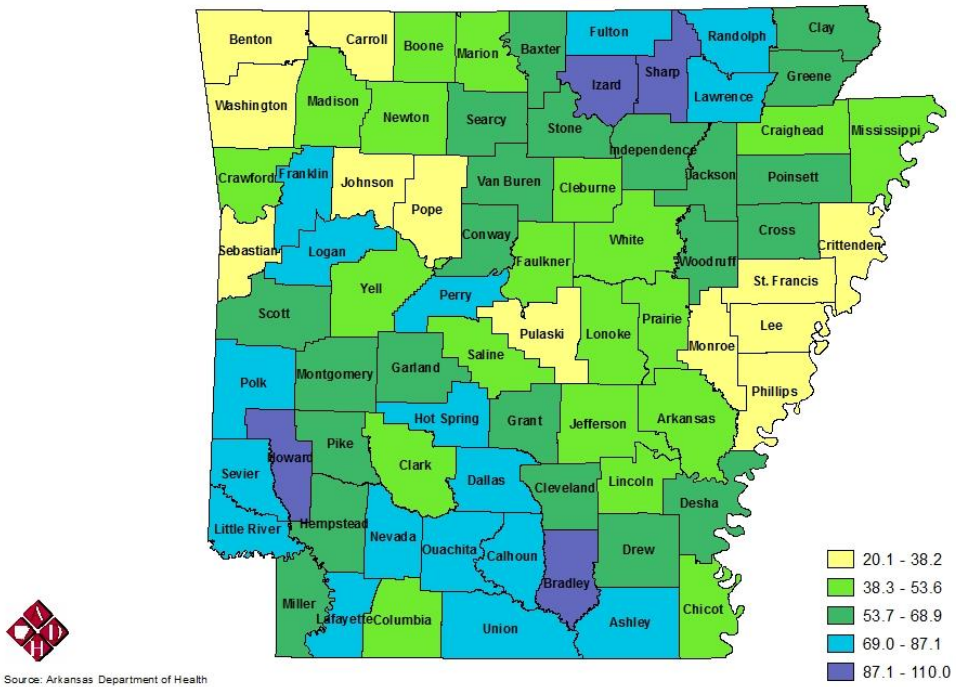


Nurses by Regions and License Type

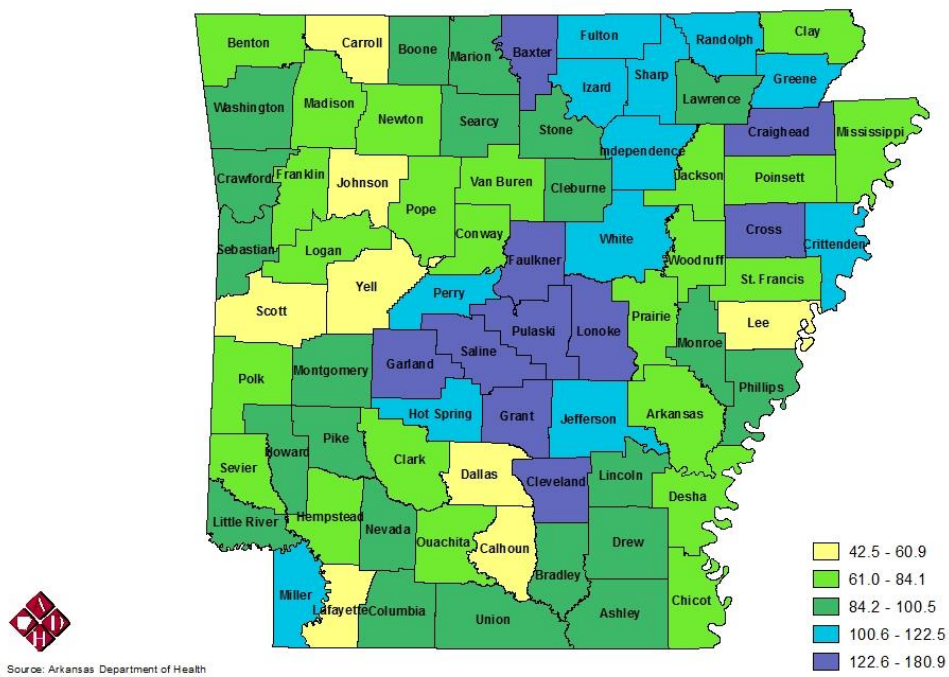

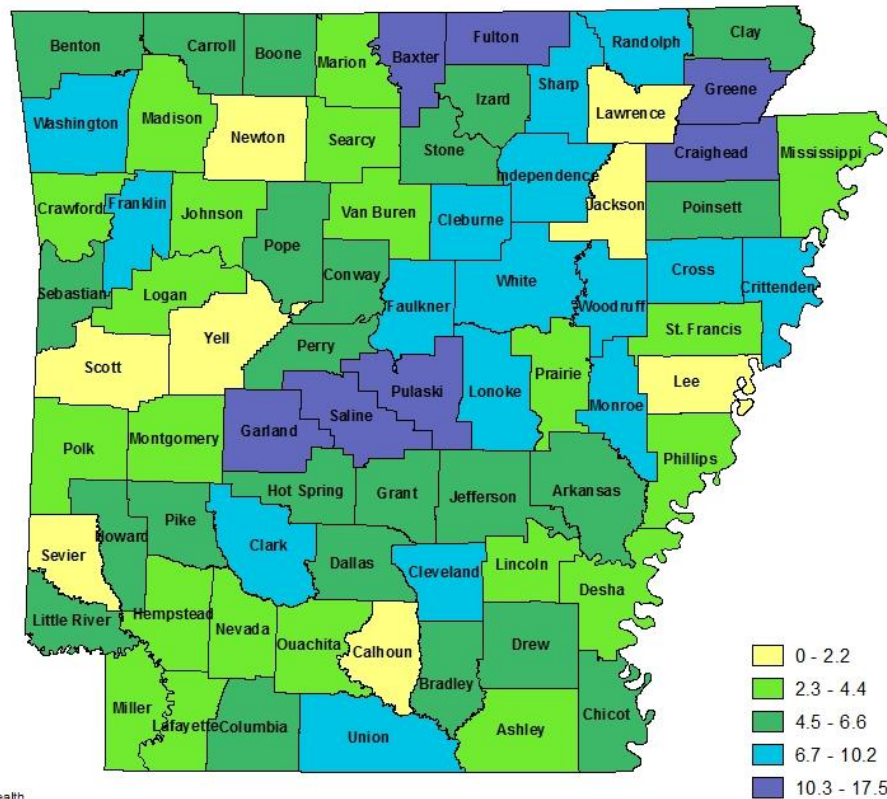

At this point in the section, we will look at the Advanced Practice Nurse group and break it down into the individual license types. The four licenses in this category: Certified Nurse Midwife (CNM), Clinical Nurse Specialist (CNS), Certified Registered Nurse Anesthetist (CRNA), and Certified Nurse Practitioner (CNP). Certified Nurse Practitioner has replaced the term Advanced Nurse Practitioner (ANP). These four licenses are considered equal in educational requirements so there is not a hierarchy for this group. Since they are considered equal, the nurses that have more than one APN license will be counted in the analysis for each license they have.

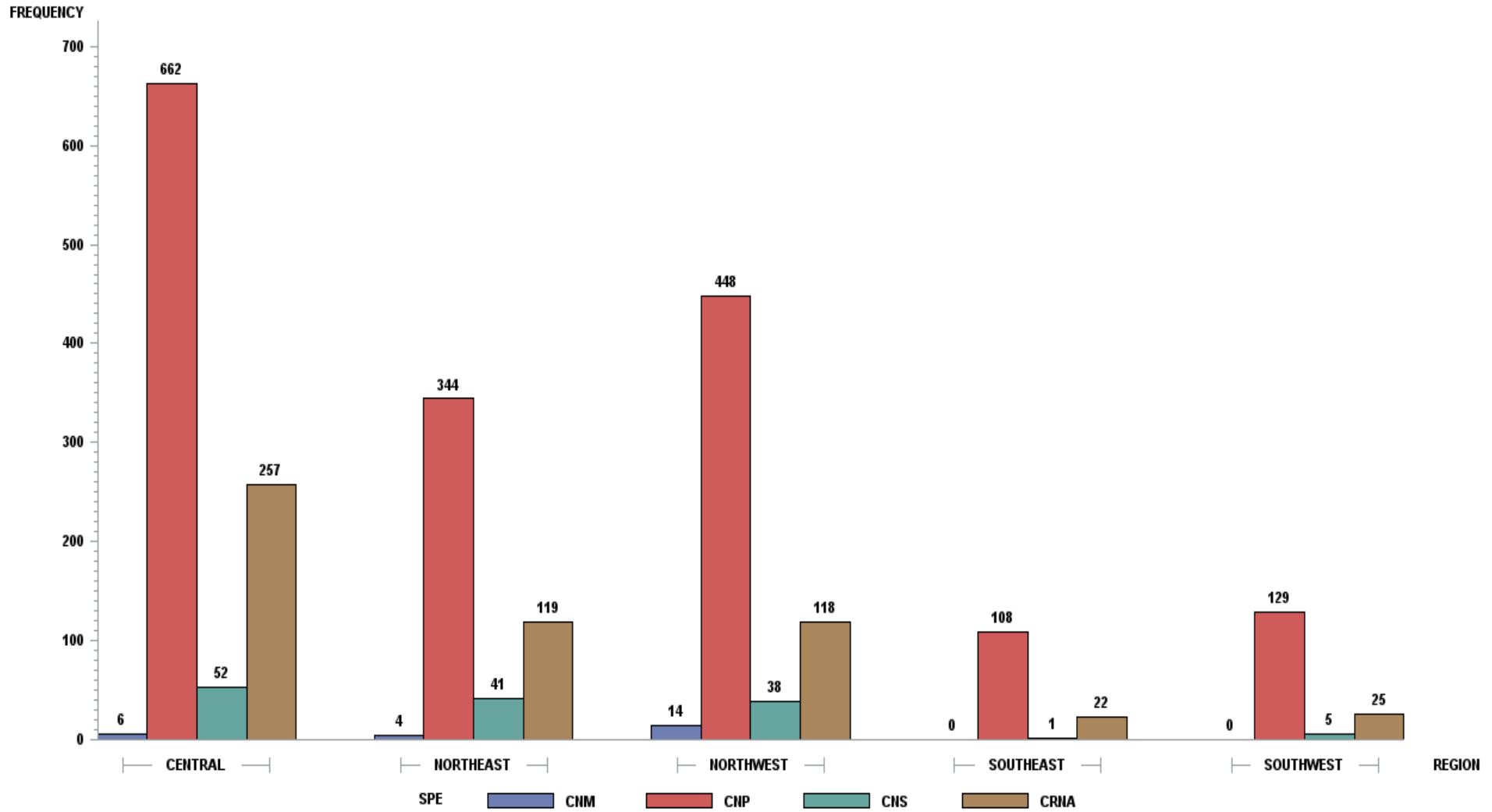

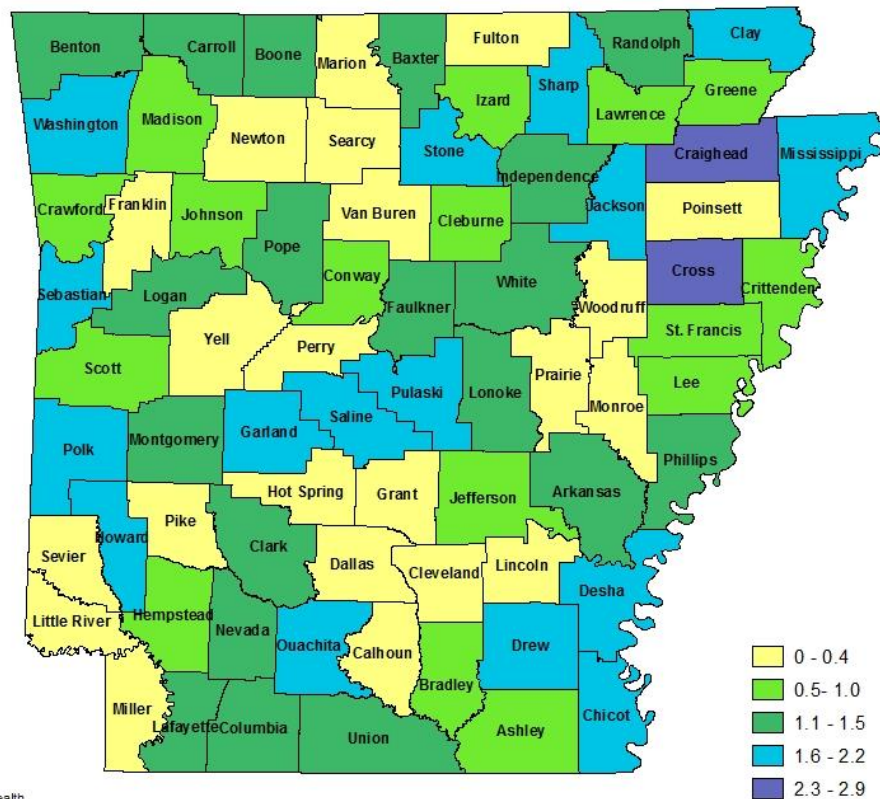

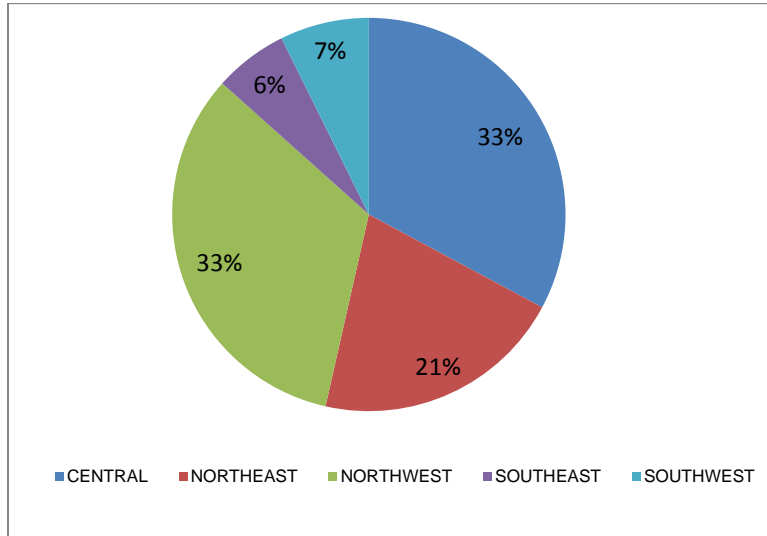
Optometrists by Counties Per 10,000 Population



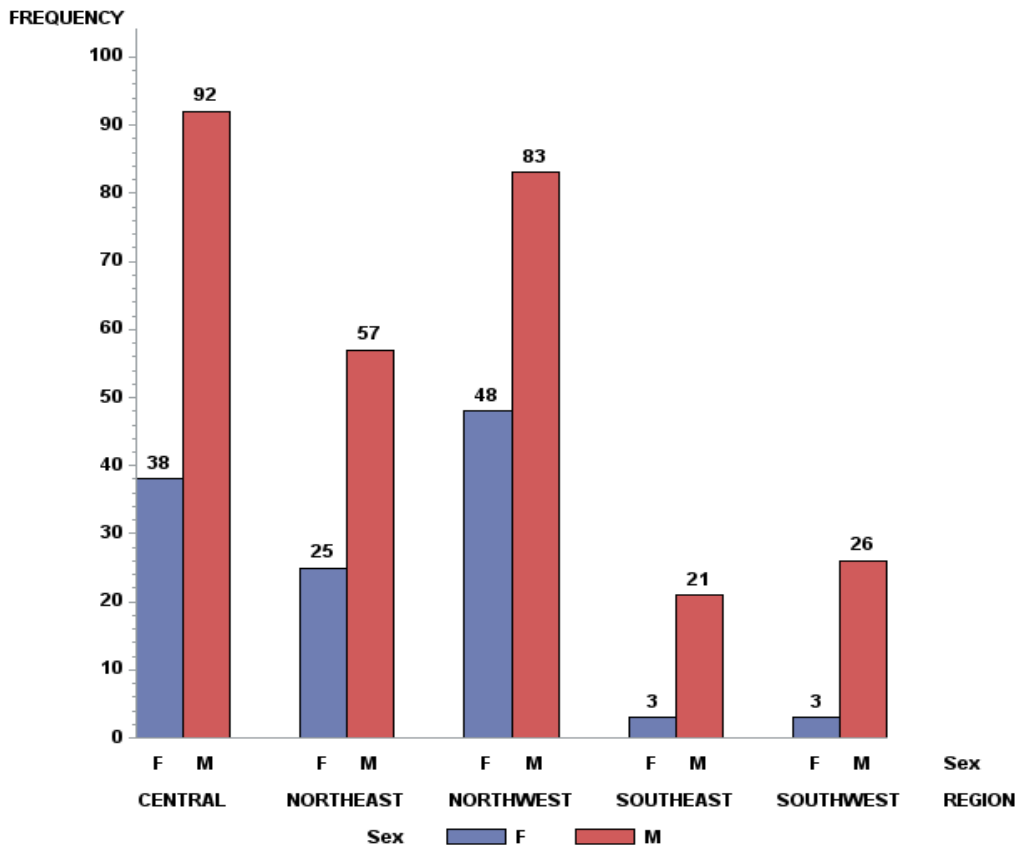

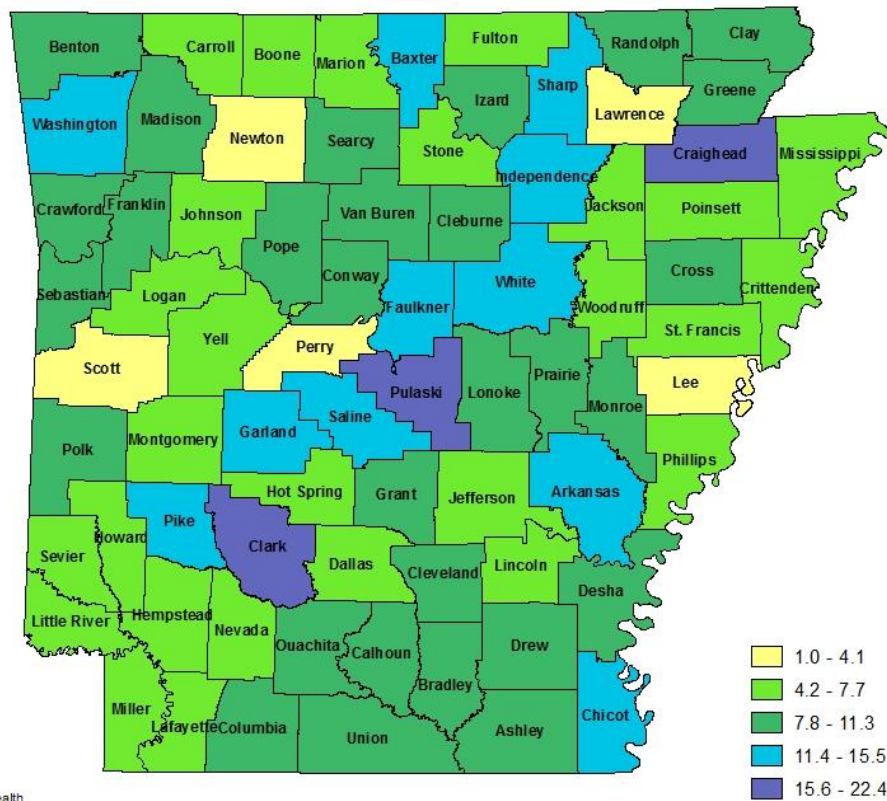

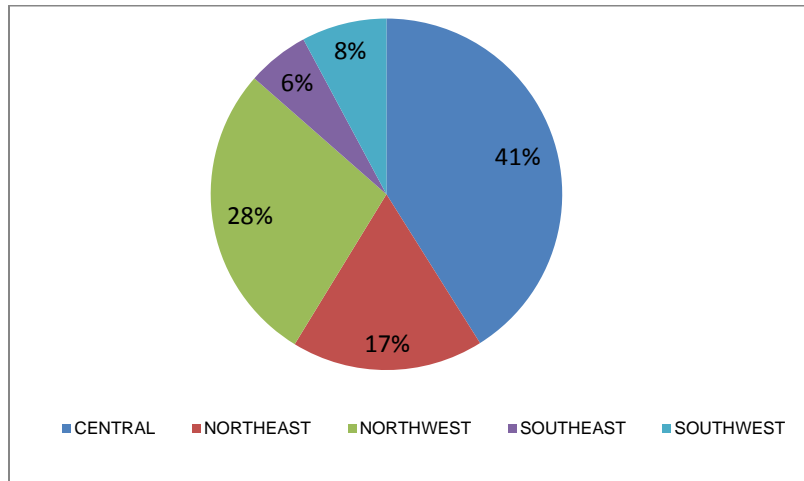
Pharmacists by Counties Per 10,000 Population



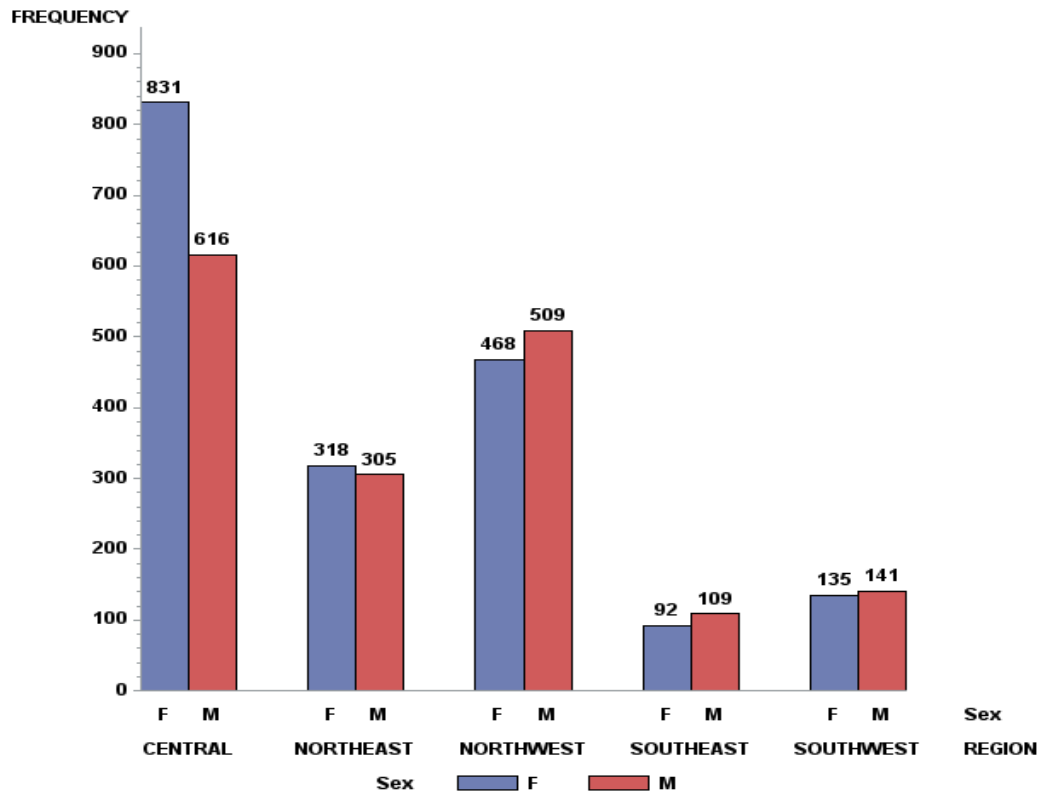

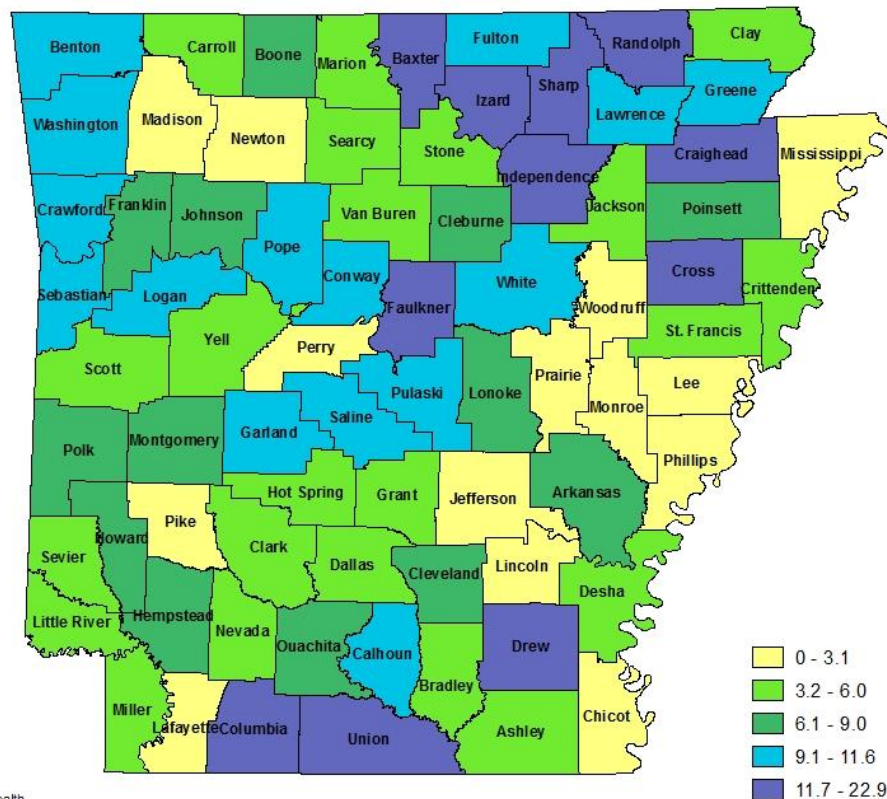

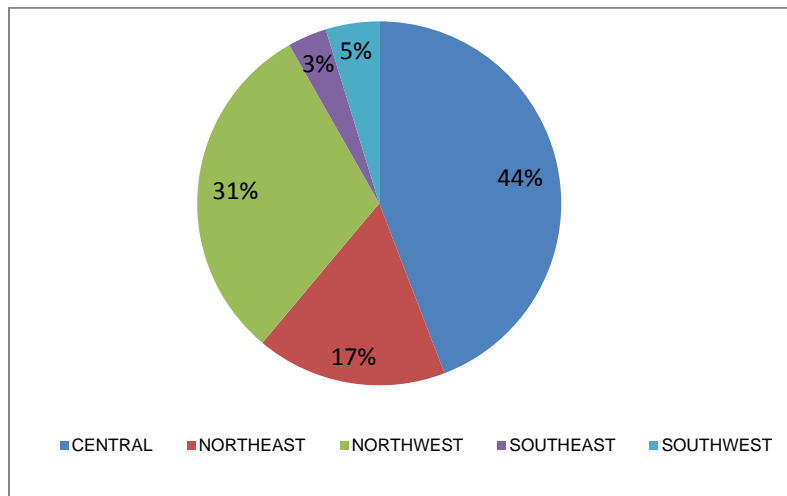
Physical Therapists by Counties Per 10,000 Population



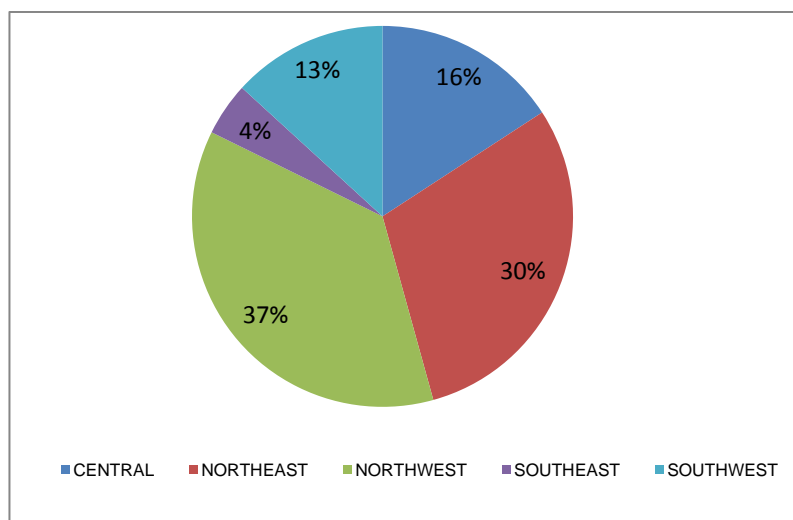

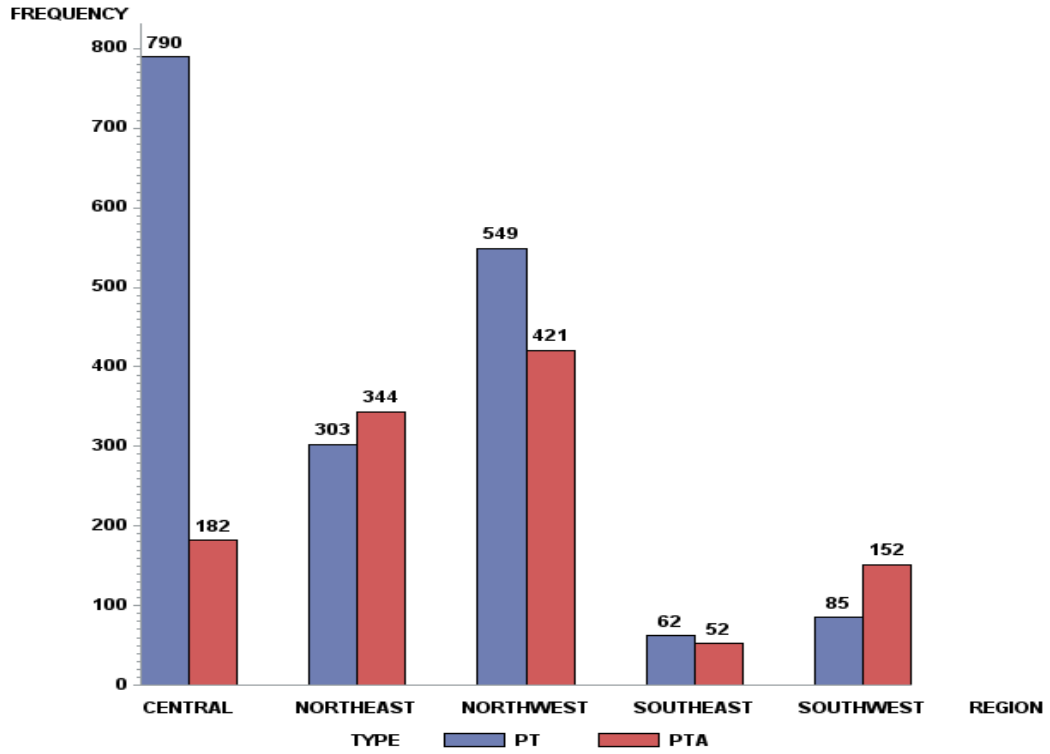

Physical Therapists by Region

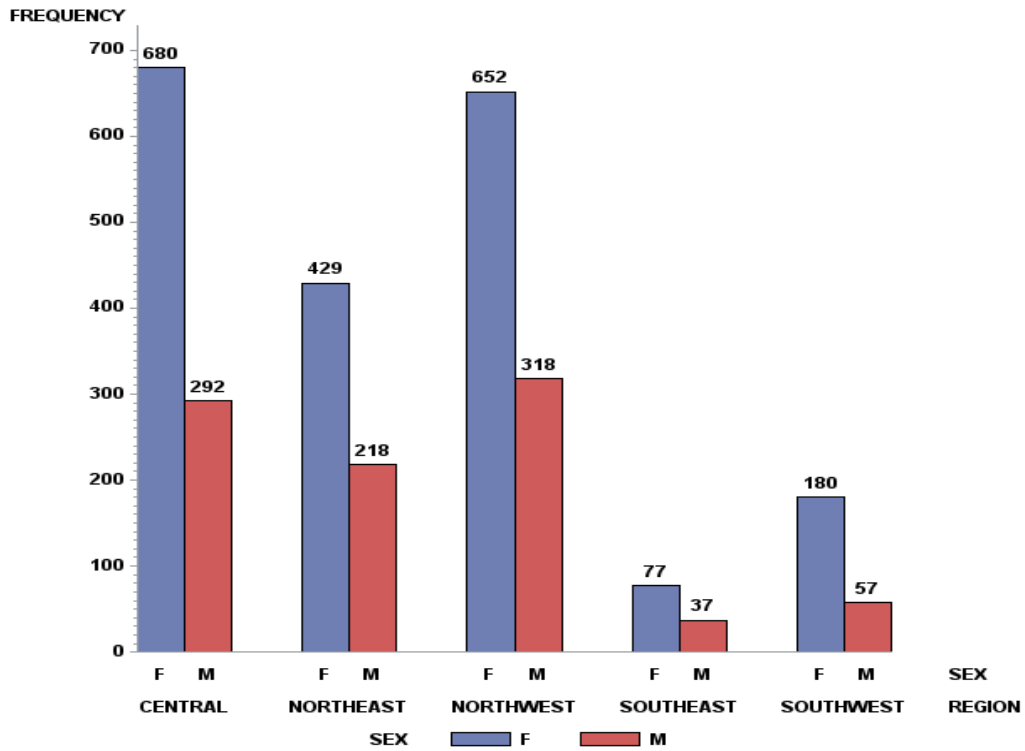


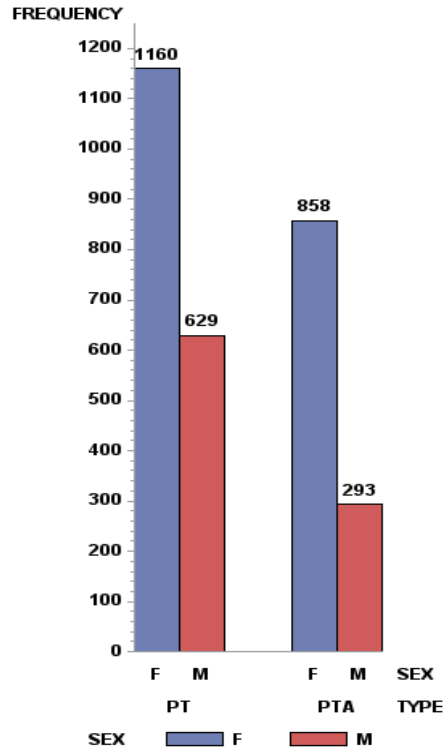
Physical Therapist Assistants by Region

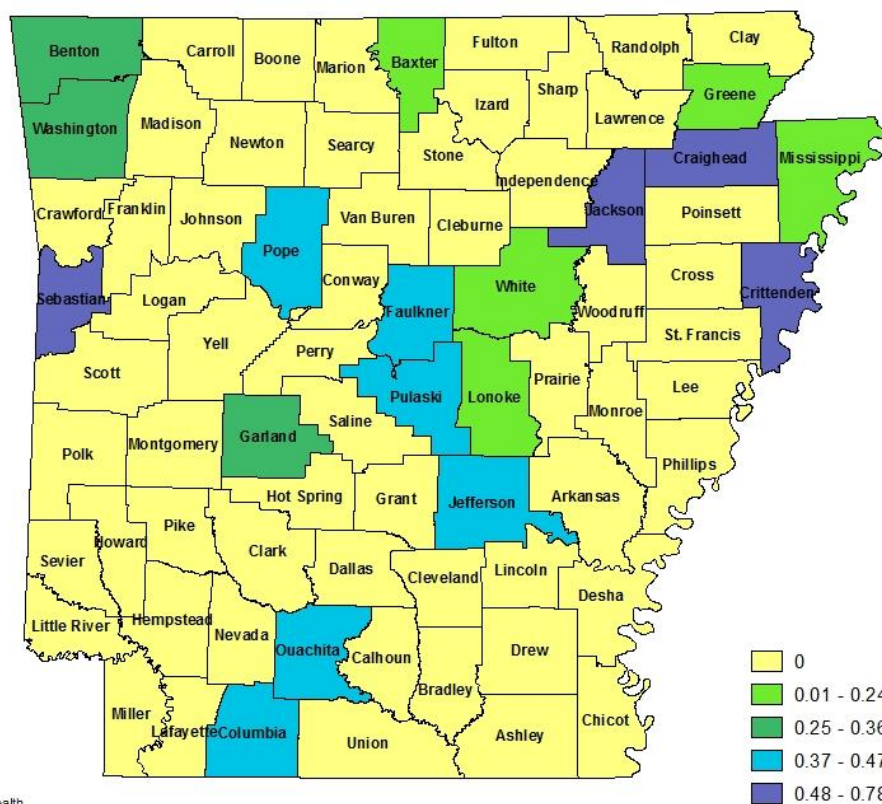

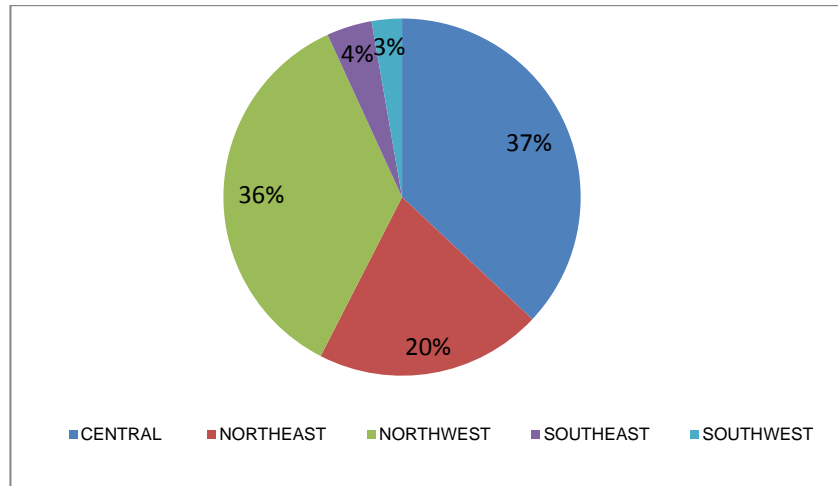
Podiatrists by Counties Per 10,000 Population



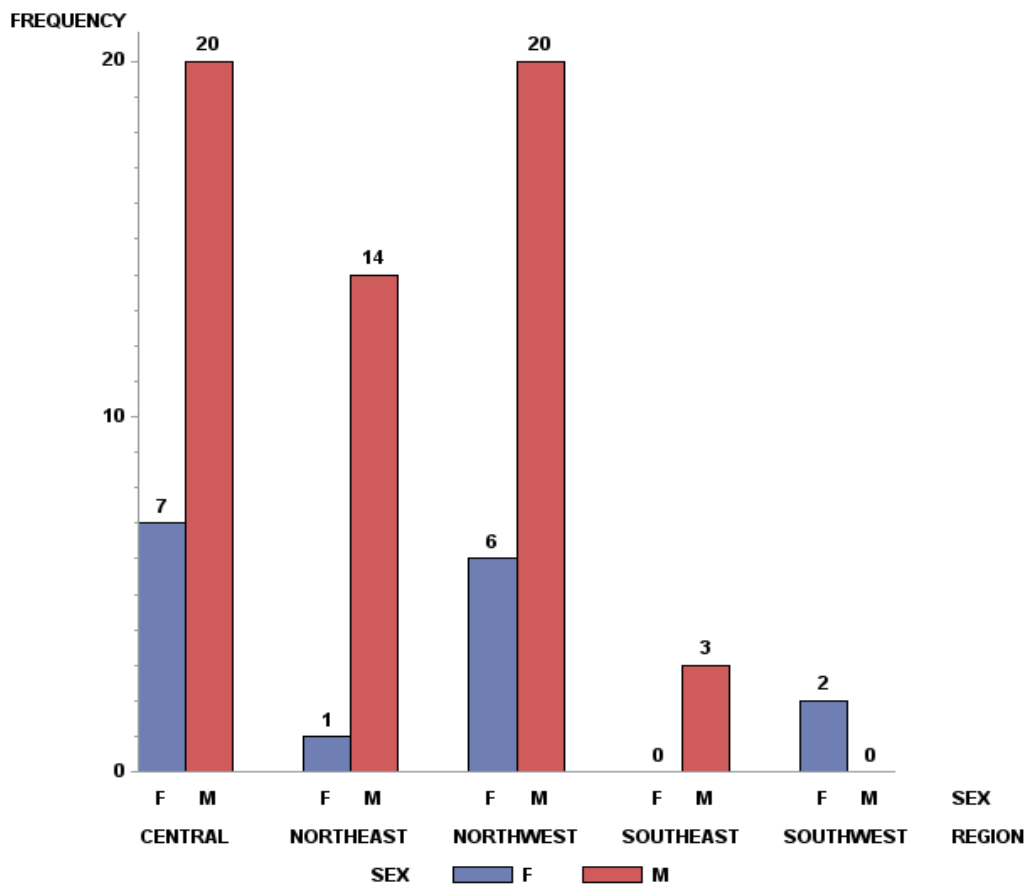

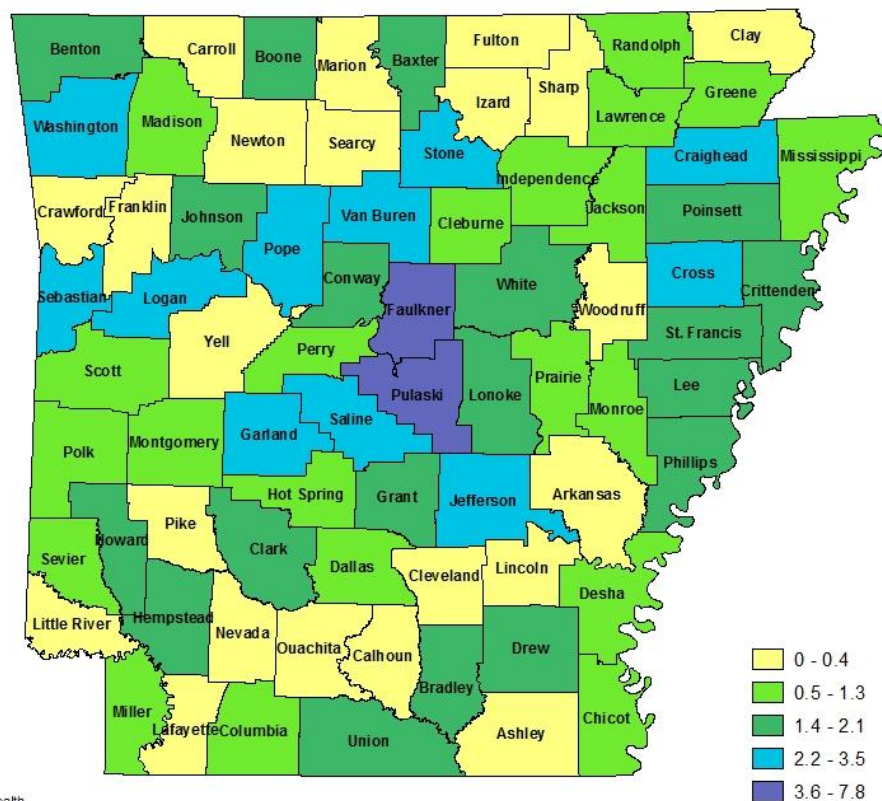

Psychology Examiners in Arkansas

In 2014, the Psychology Board licensed 832 psychologists with mailing addresses in Arkansas, about 2.8 per 10,000 population. This total includes 432 Psychologists (P), 172 Psychologists Examiners (E), and 228 Psychological Examiner Independents (EI); about 1.5, 0.6 and 0.8 respectively, per 10,000 population. Of the 75 Arkansas counties, 19 (25%) did not have a registered psychologist and 11 (15%) of the counties had only one.

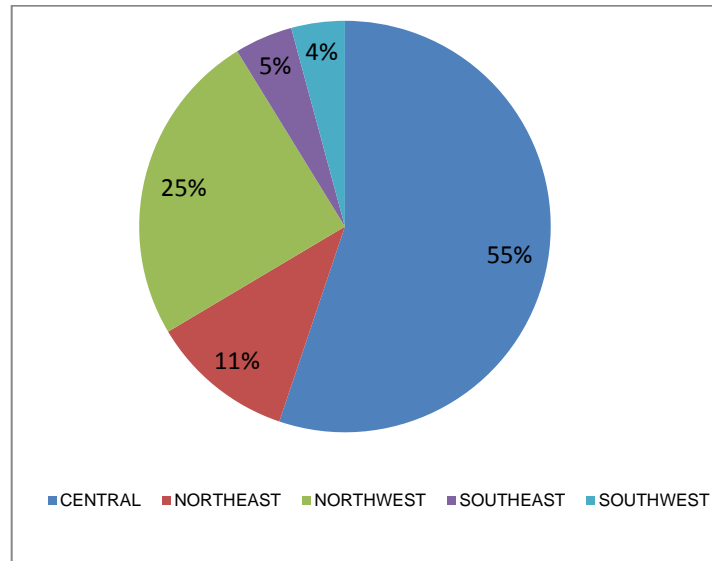
Psychologists by Counties Per 10,000 Population



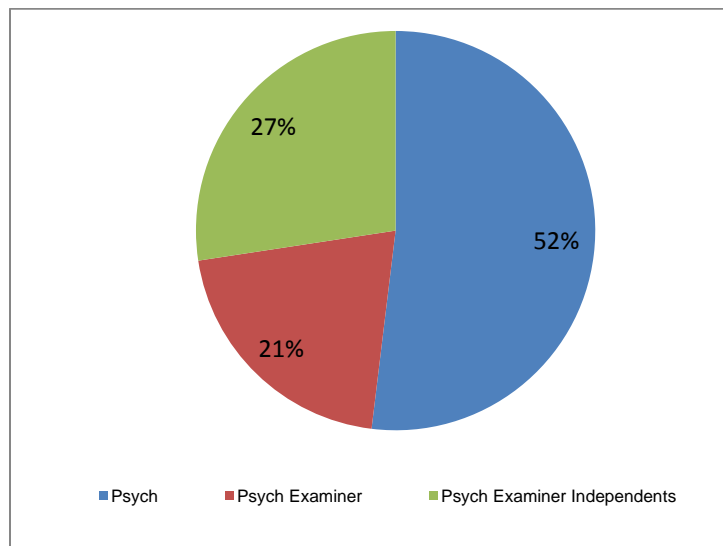

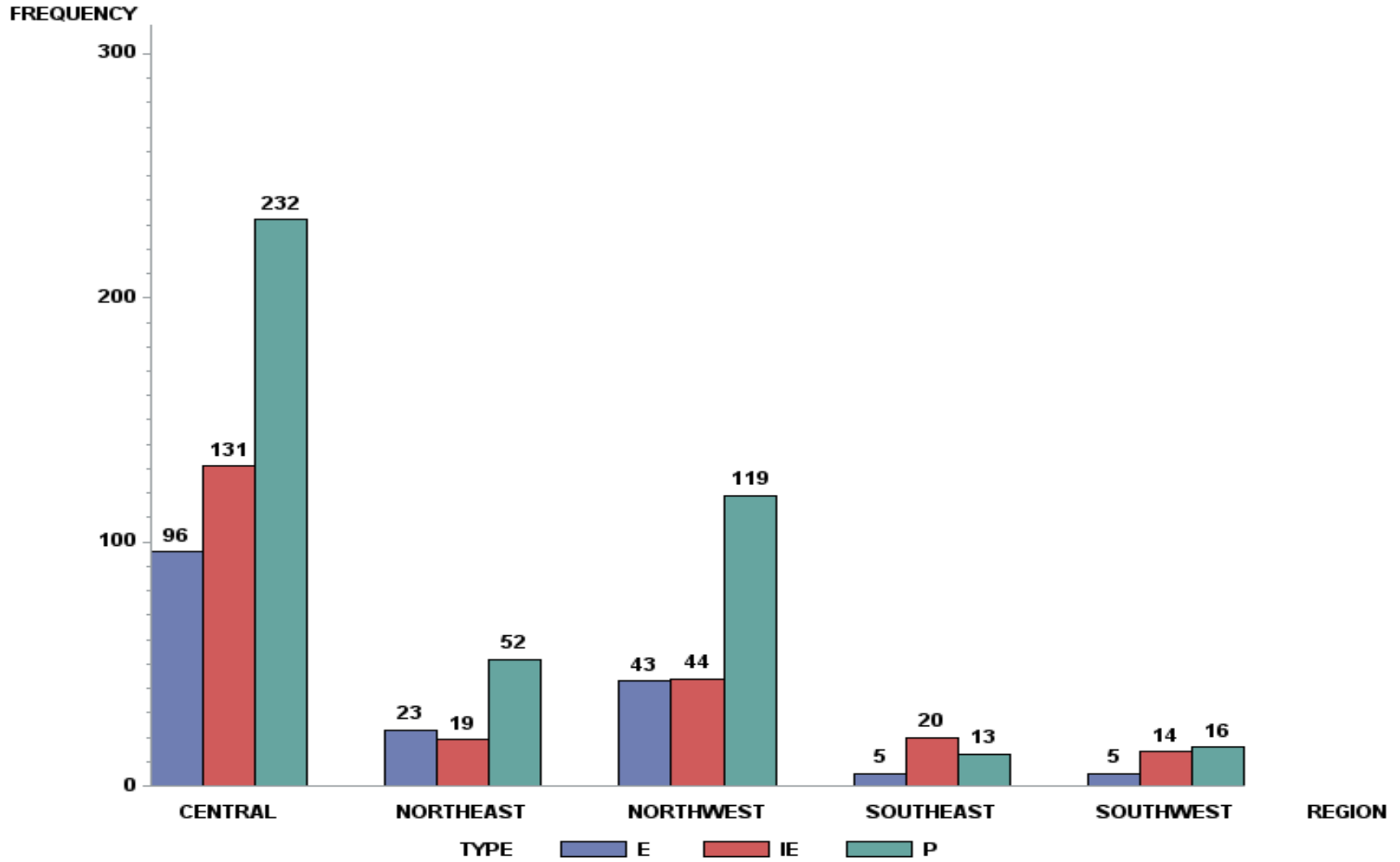
Distribution of Psychologists by Region

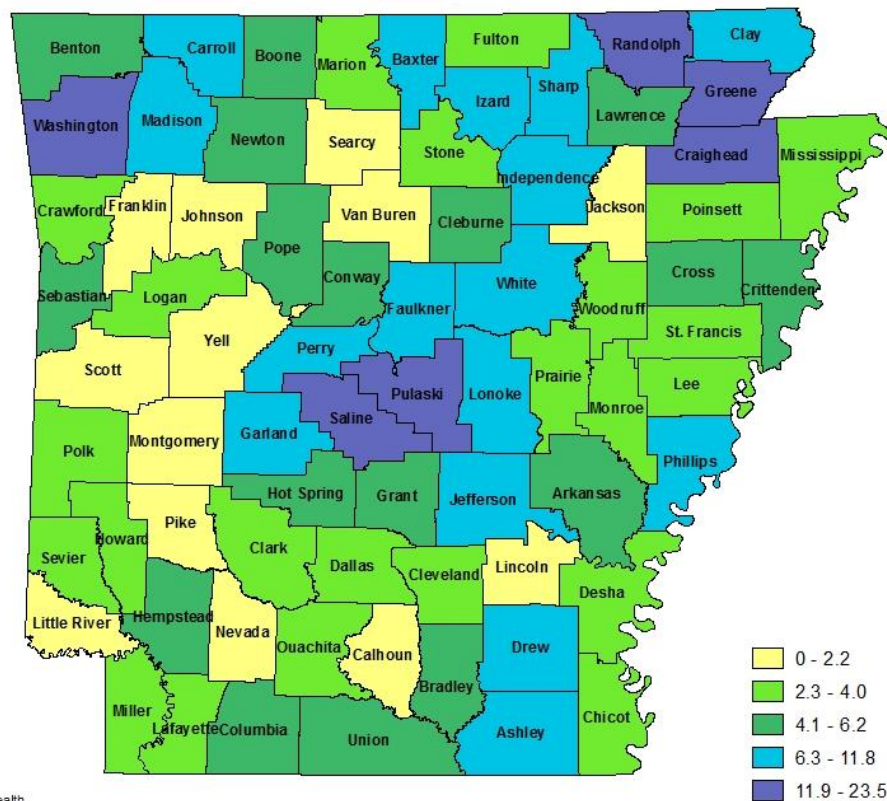

Social Workers in Arkansas

In 2014, the Social Work Licensing Board licensed 2,775 social workers with mailing addresses in Arkansas about 9.3 per 10,000 populations. This total includes 441 social workers (LSW), 1,466 certified social workers (LCSW), and 767 master social workers (LMSW). In addition, the Social Worker Licensing Board issued 101 provisional licenses for social workers with mailing addresses in Arkansas (*Provisional license for social workers means: First-time applicants for LSW or LMSW licensure will be issued a provisional license upon approval of his or her application. A provisional license will be issued one time per person and expires exactly one-year from the date of issuance. Provisional licensing is prohibited at the LCSW level.*). This total includes 51 Provisional license social workers (PLSW), and 50 provisional license master social workers (PLMSW). At least one fully licensed social worker was licensed in each of the Arkansas counties with the exception of Pike and Searcy County.

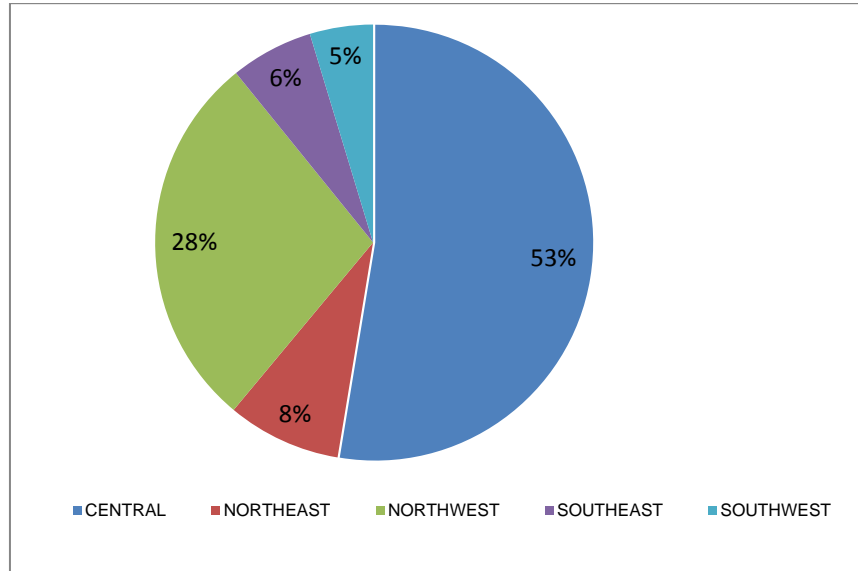
Social Workers by Counties Per 10,000 Population



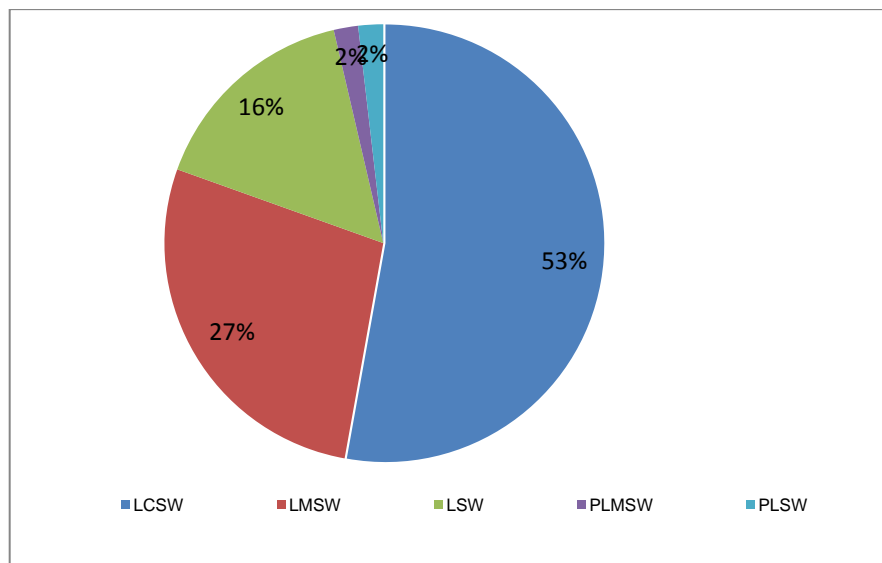

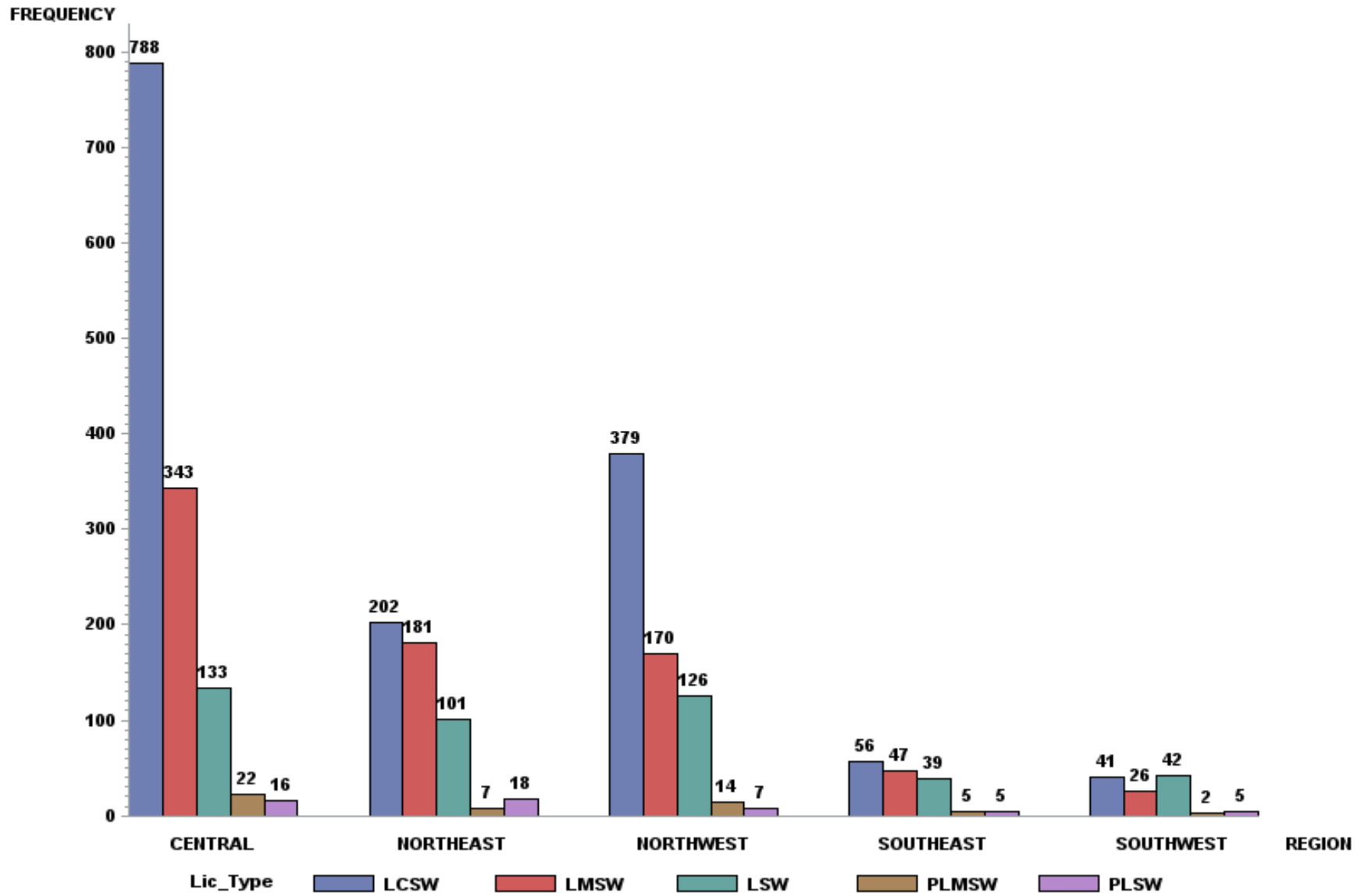
Distribution of Social Workers by Region

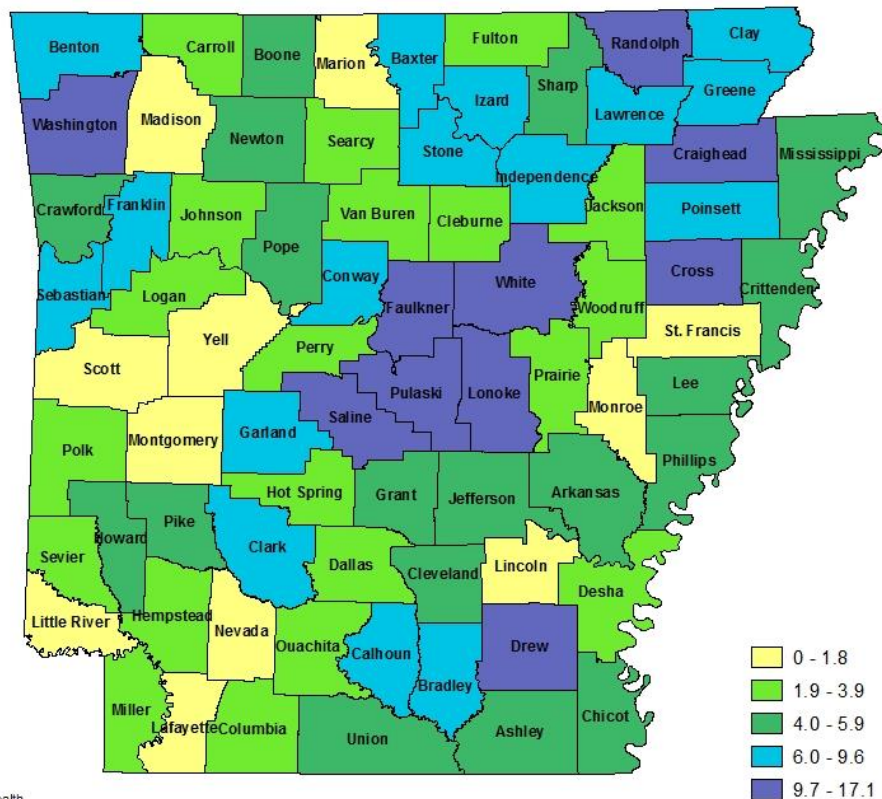

Speech Pathologists and Audiologists in Arkansas

In 2014, the Speech Pathology and Audiology Board licensed 2,268 speech pathologists, about 7.6 per 10,000 populations, and 147 audiologists, about 0.5 per 10,000 populations, with mailing addresses in Arkansas. Of the 75 counties in Arkansas, 1 (1%) county had no registered speech pathologists or audiologists and 53 (71%) counties had one or more speech pathologists but no audiologists in the registry.

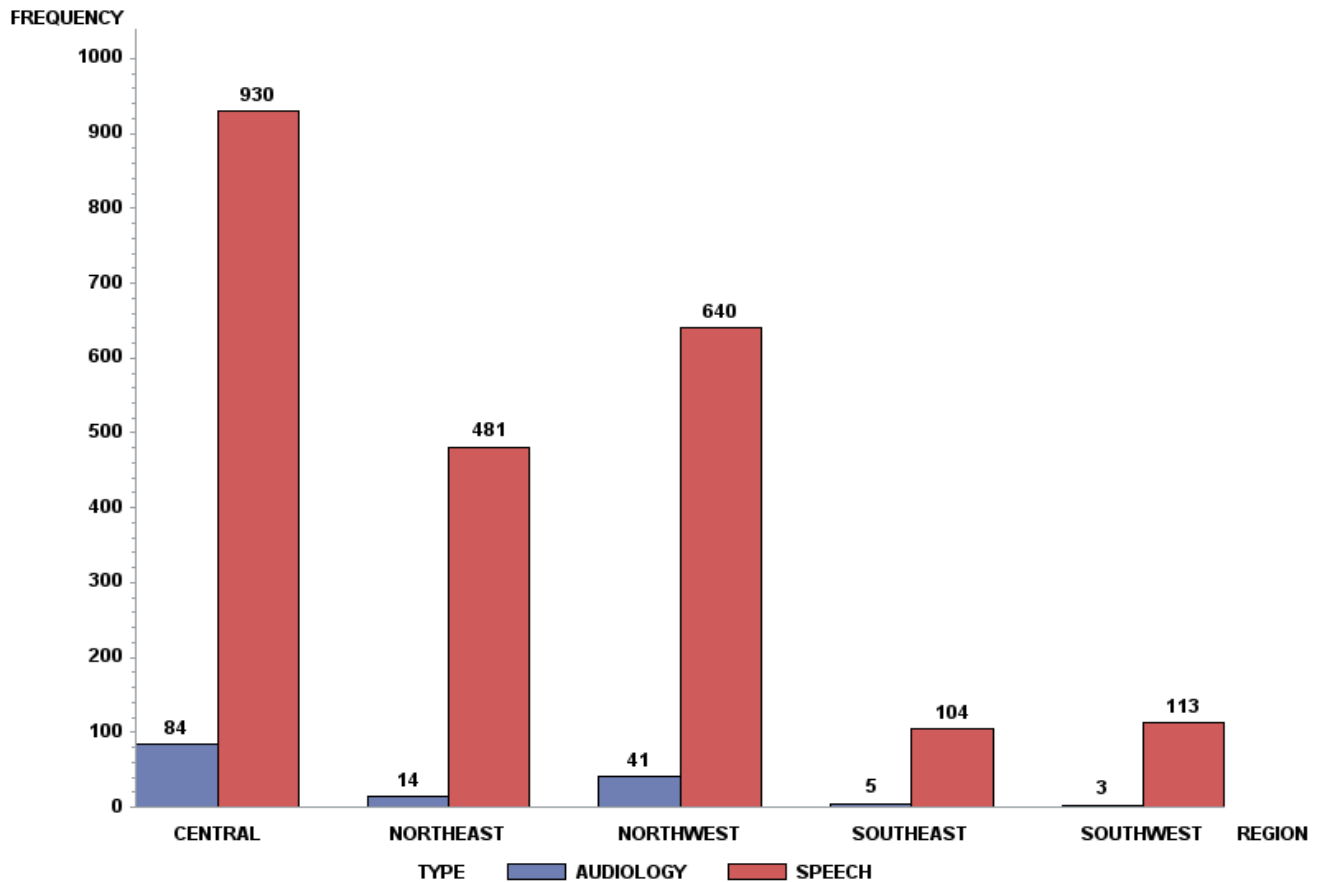
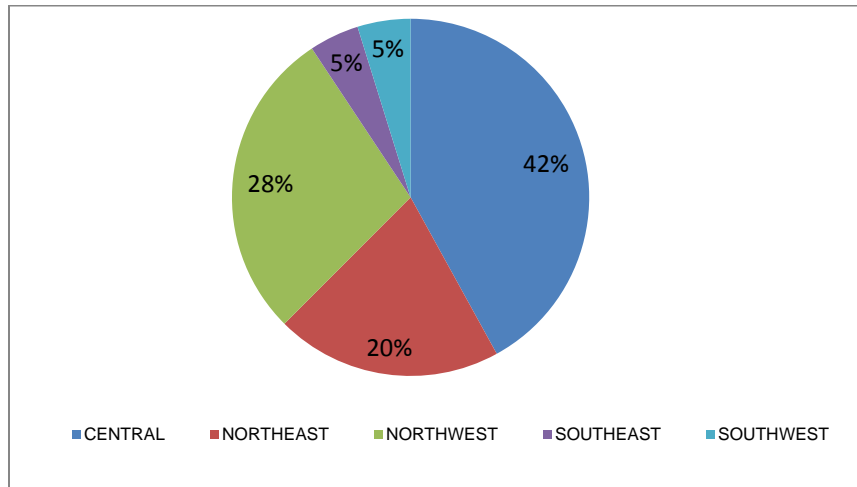
**Speech Pathologists and Audiologists by Counties
Per 10,000 Population**



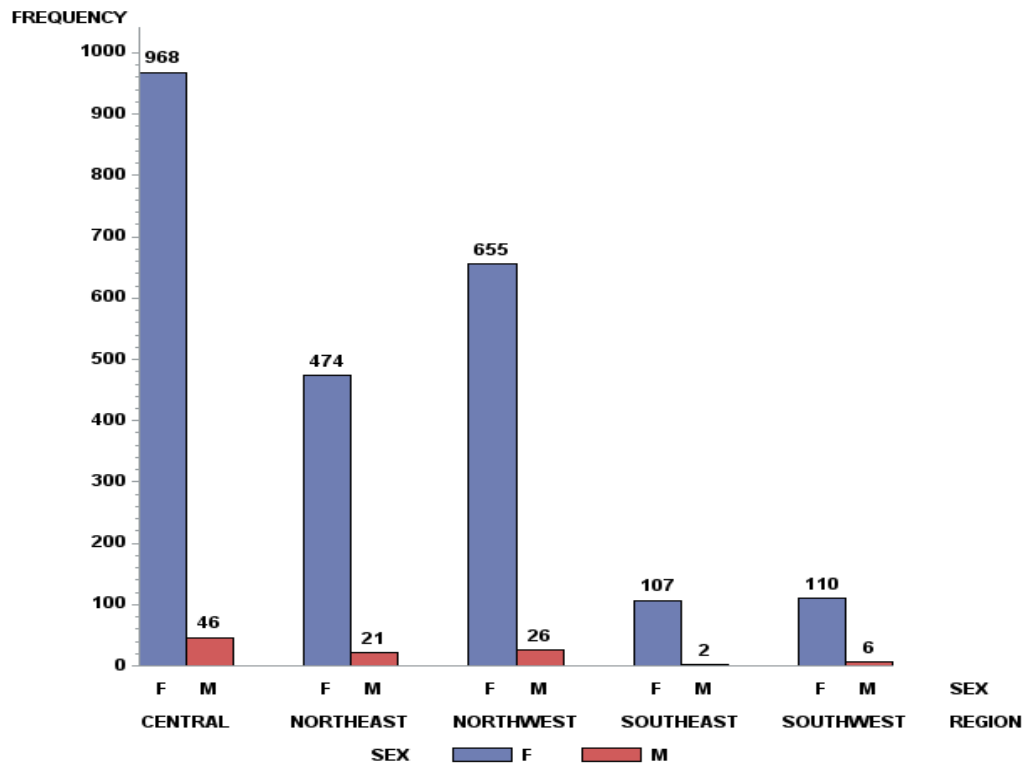

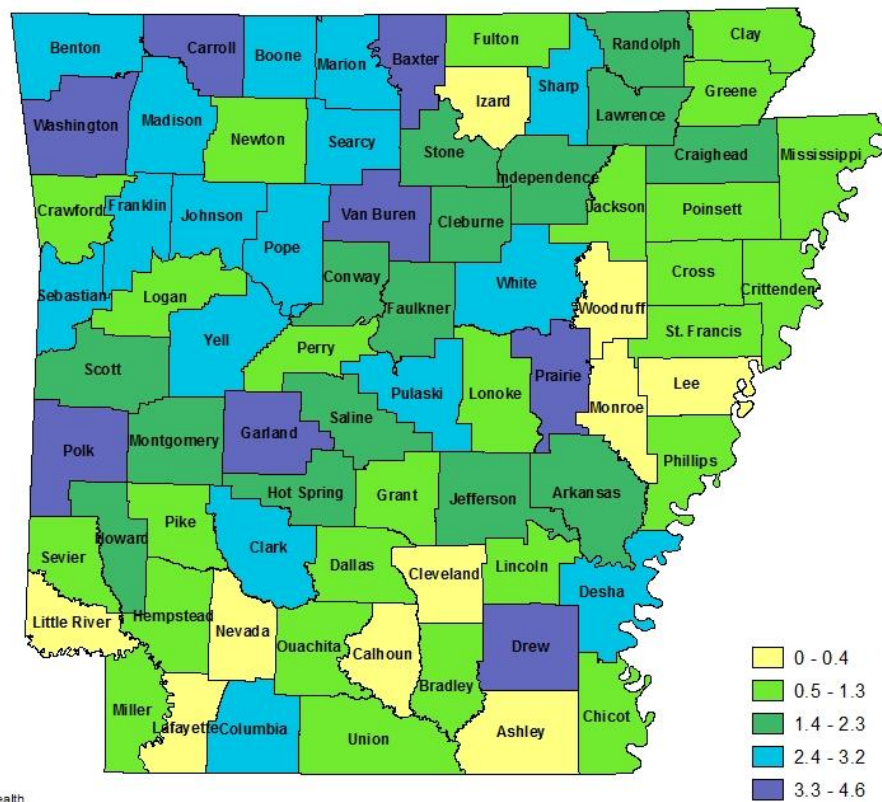

Veterinarians by Counties Per 10,000 Population

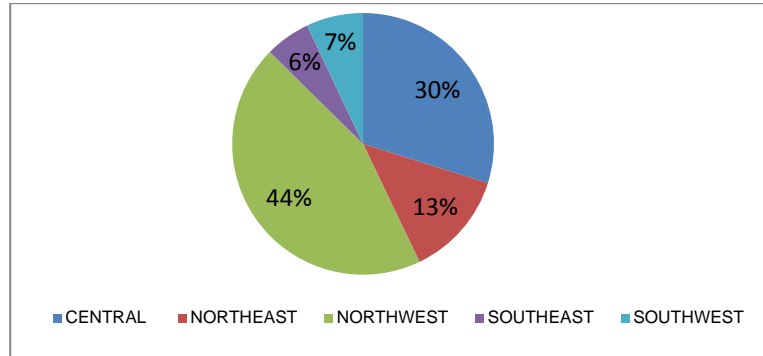

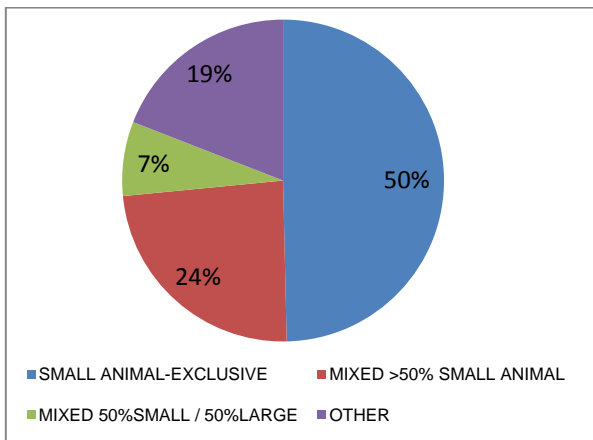

VETERINARIANS BY ARKANSAS REGION

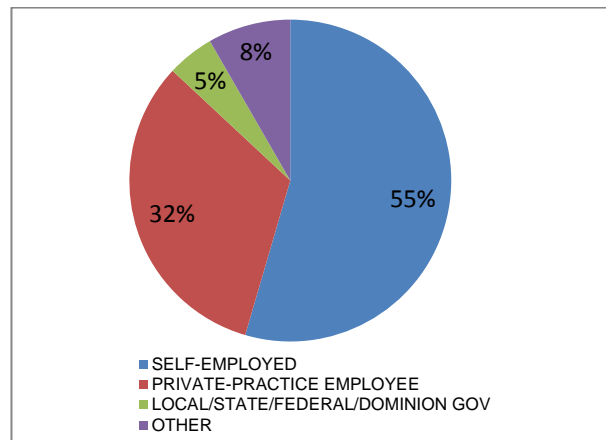
