PREFACE

This report is based on information obtained by licensing boards during the 2021 license renewal process. Copies of practitioner responses to questions on license renewal applications were provided to the Arkansas Department of Health (ADH) Health Statistics Branch by the licensing boards. Because the data were collected by several boards using questionnaires designed to meet the licensing requirements of the individual professions, a certain consistency of format and content, desirable for manpower measurement, is missing from the data. Various items of demographic data, such as ethnic origin and gender, are obtained by some, but not all, of the boards. Information relating to a practitioner's location- address, city, county, state, etc.- meets the licensing board's need to communicate with the practitioner by mail and may or may not identify the site(s) where health-related services are performed.

The report includes tables, maps and graphs representing health professions manpower distribution and demographics in Arkansas counties. The 2010 Census from the U.S. Census Bureau, Population Division, was used in the computation of population ratios throughout this report.

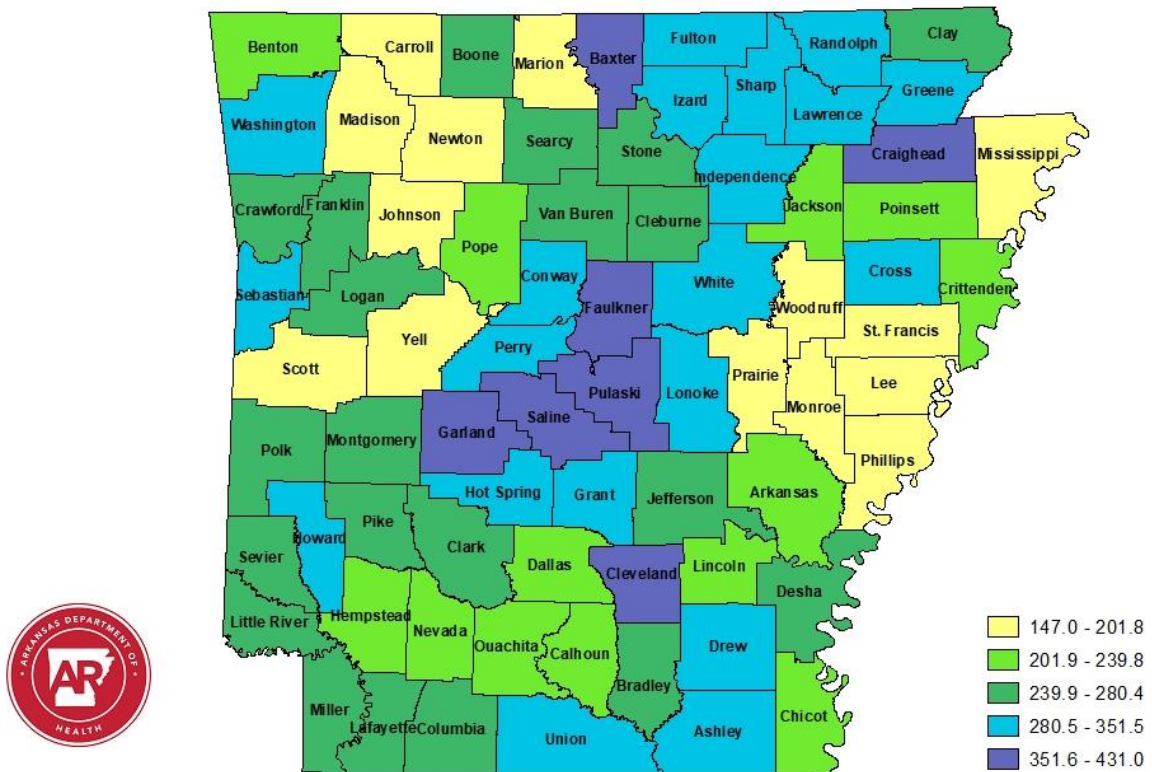

Health Professionals in Arkansas

In 2021, there were 93,234 licensed health professionals with Arkansas mailing addresses serving 3 million Arkansans, a population ratio of 308.1 professionals for every 10,000 population living in the State. There were 17 professions administered by 13 boards. The largest registration was by the Arkansas State Board of Nursing with 56,104 licensees, followed by the Arkansas State Medical Board with 12,539 licensees. The smallest registration was by the Arkansas Board of Podiatric Medicine with 76 licensees. As a group, health professionals were distributed evenly across the counties with a heavier concentration in counties with larger populations.

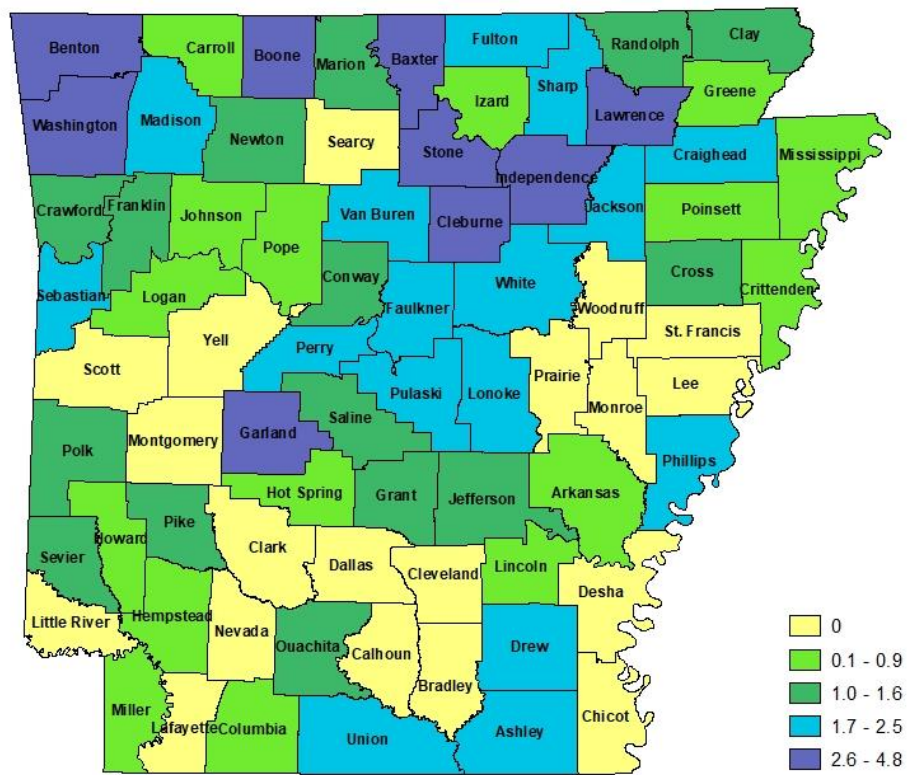

Chiropractors in Arkansas

In 2021, the Board of Chiropractic Examiners licensed 596 chiropractors with mailing addresses in Arkansas: about 2 per 10,000 population. Of the 75 counties in Arkansas, 19 counties (25%) had no registered chiropractors and 10 other counties (13%) had only one.

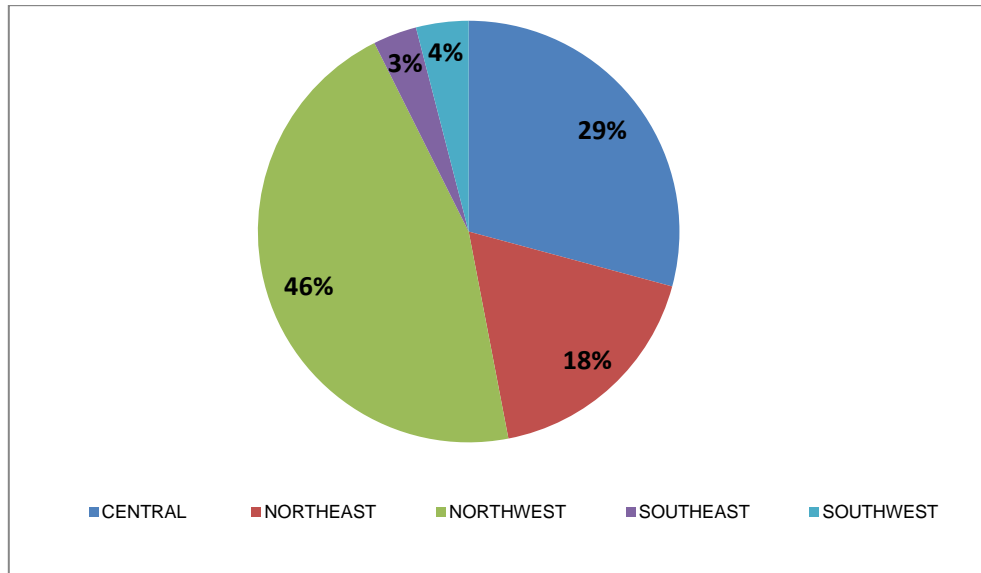
Chiropractors by County Per 10,000 Population



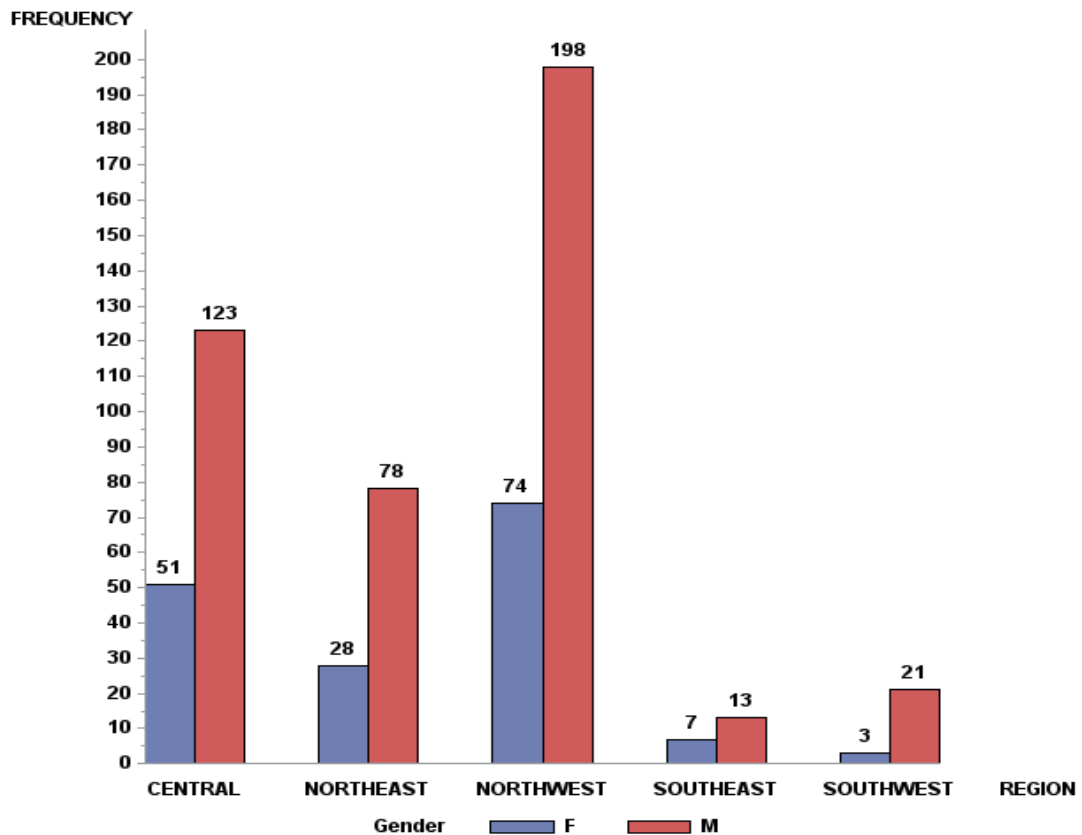

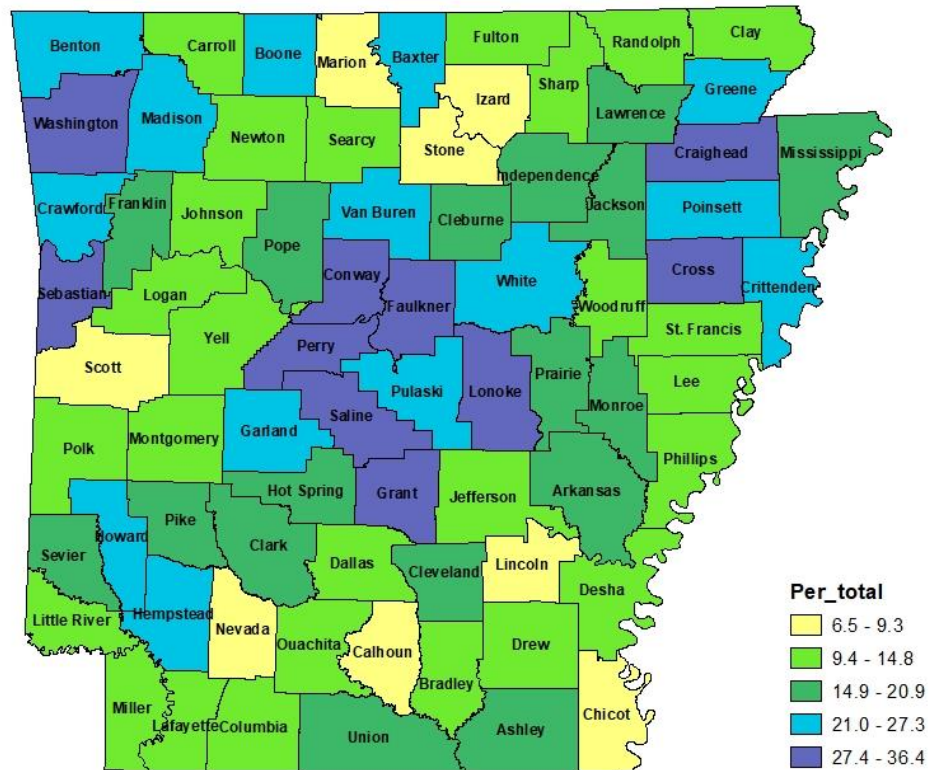

Dental Health Providers in Arkansas

In 2021, the Board of Dental Examiners licensed 7,277 providers of dental health services with mailing addresses in Arkansas: about 24 per 10,000 population. This total includes 1,345 dentists (DD), 4,213 dental assistants (DA), and 1,719 dental hygienists (DH). Overall, the number of dental health providers increased by 7.2 % for the state. There was a decrease in DDs by 3.1%, a decrease in DHs by 2.4%, and an increase in DAs by 15.9%. Each of the 75 counties in Arkansas had at least four registered dental health providers.

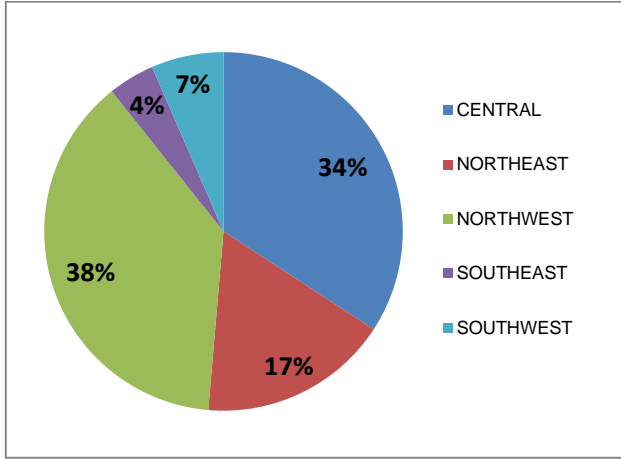
Dental Health Providers by County Per 10,000 People



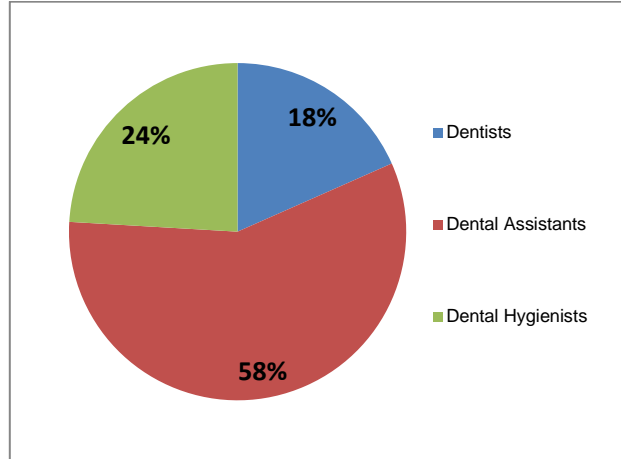

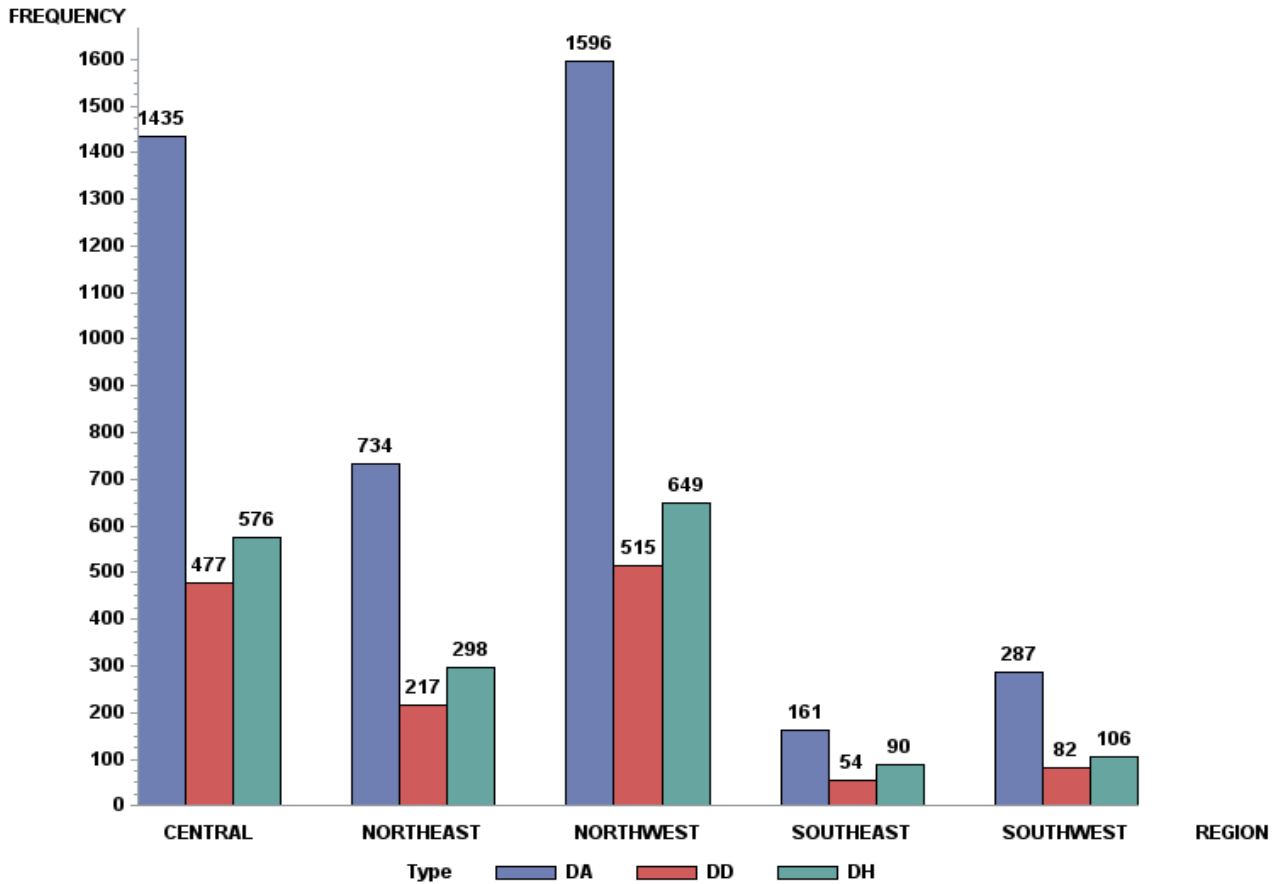
Distribution of Dental Providers by Region



Distribution of Dental Providers by Specialty

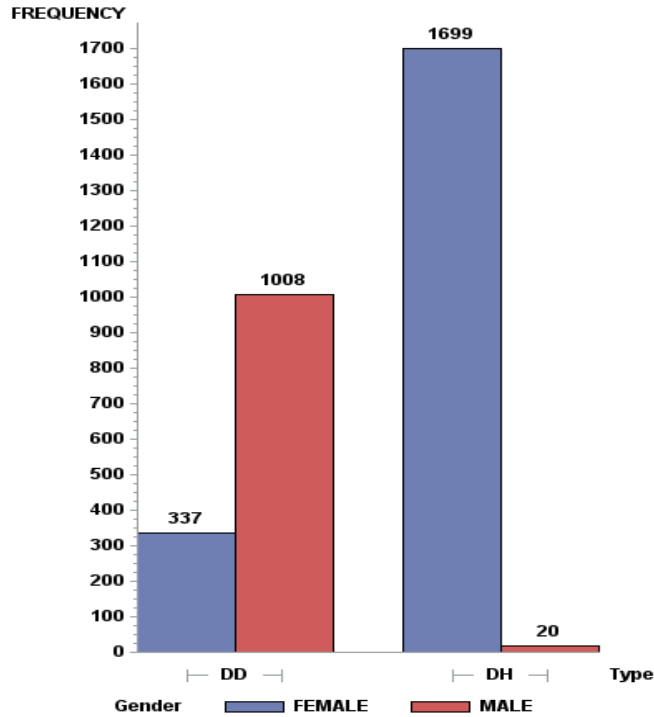


Dental Health Providers by Region

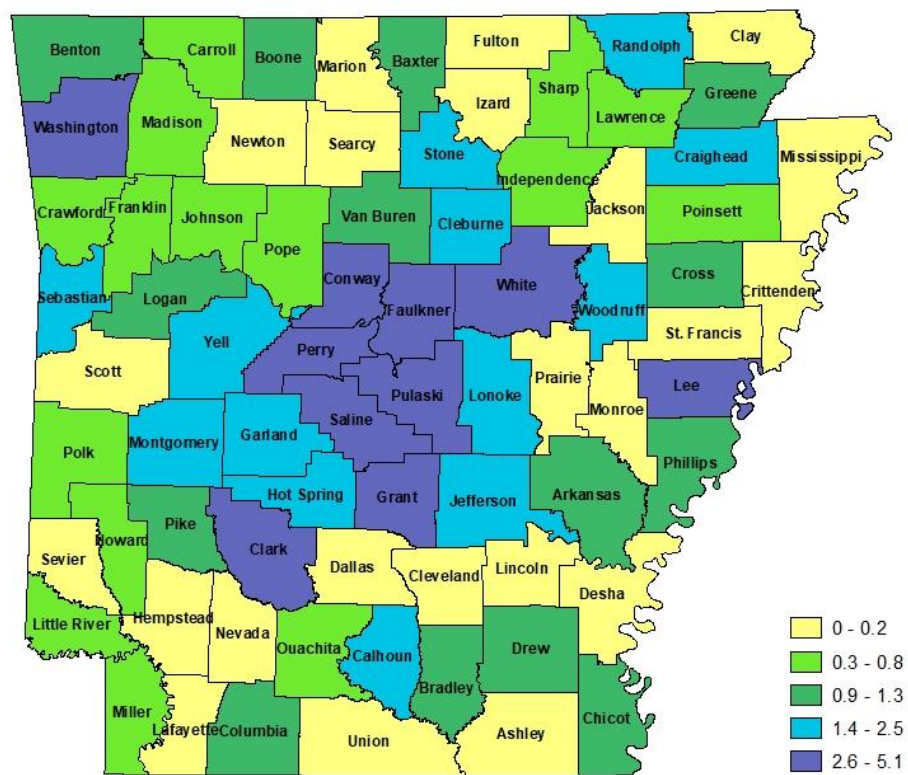

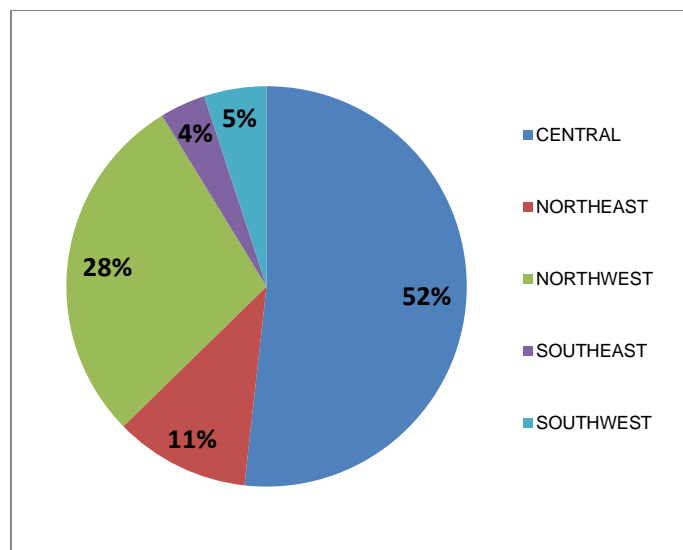
Dietitians by County Per 10,000 Population

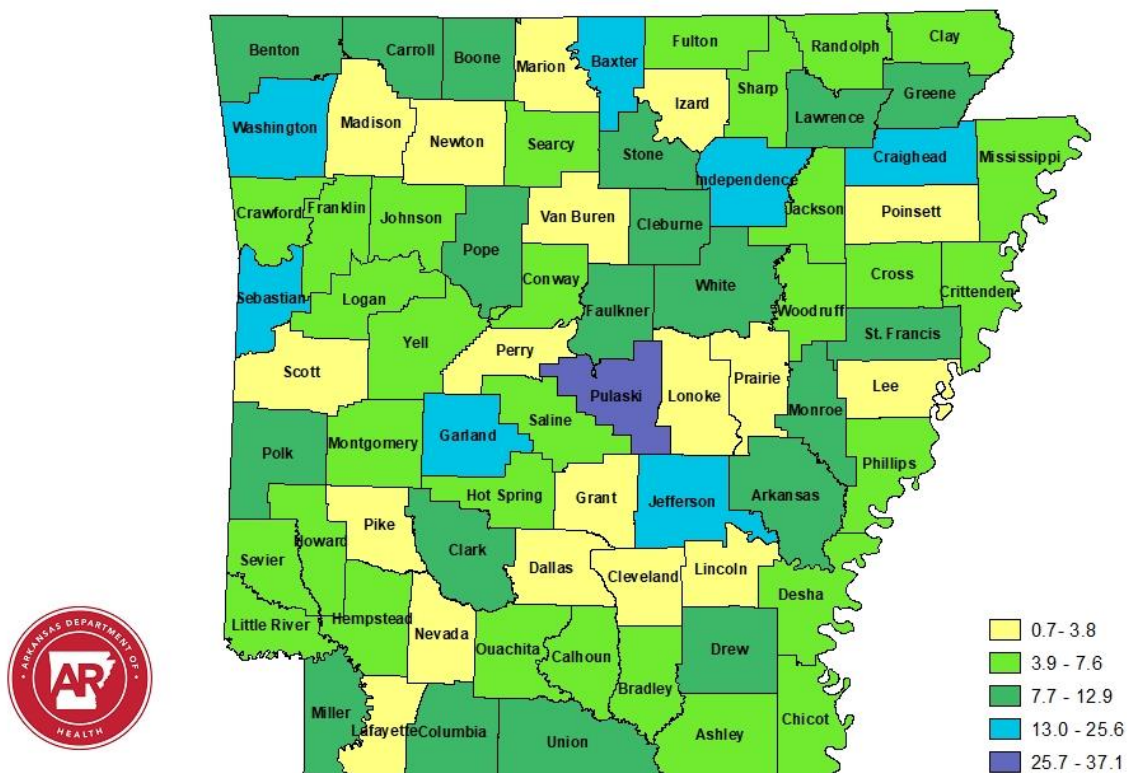

Medical Professionals in Arkansas

In 2021, the Medical Board licensed 12,801 health professionals with mailing addresses in Arkansas. The 2021 registry includes 4,333 physicians (34%) registered in five primary care specialties with mailing addresses in Arkansas; about 14.3 per 10,000 population. This list includes: 1,622 family practice, 83 general practice, 1,578 internal medicine, 338 obstetrics-gynecologists (OB/GYN), and 712 pediatrics. At least one fully licensed primary care physician was registered in each Arkansas county. The board licensed 3,046 physicians as secondary specialists and 15 physicians who reported no specialty. Also, the board licensed 5,407 health professionals as Health-Related Professionals. This total is made up of 1,861 Respiratory Therapists (LRCP), 1,707 Occupational Therapists (OT), 1,000 Occupational Therapy Assistants (OT-A), 562 Physician Assistants (PA), 6 Radiologists (RA), 3 Radiology Assistants (RPA), 250 Surgical Technologists (ST), and 18 Licensed Genetic Counselors (LGC).

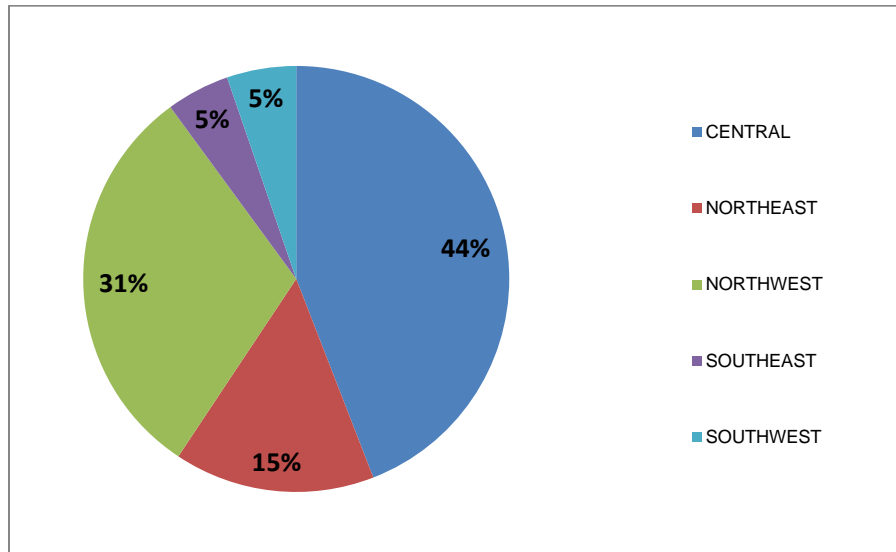
Primary Care Physicians by County Per 10,000 Population



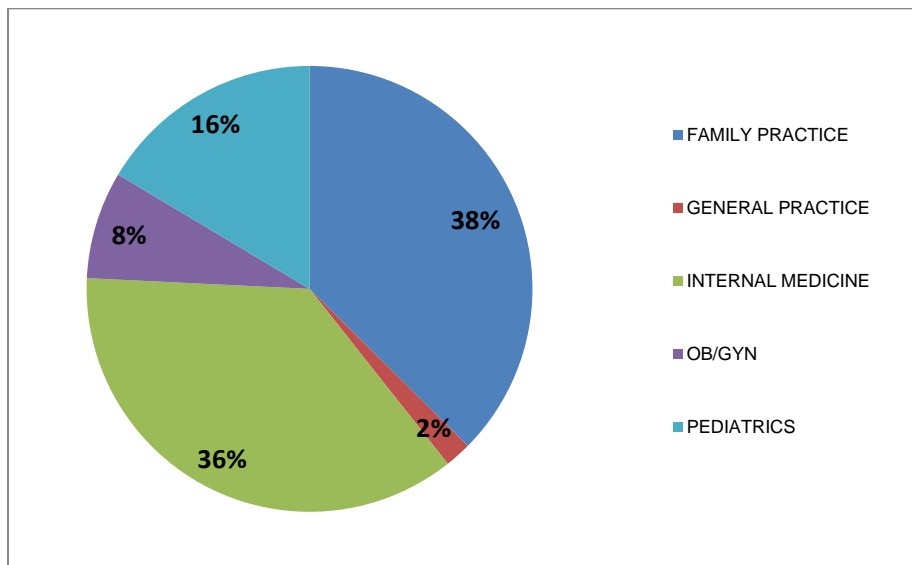

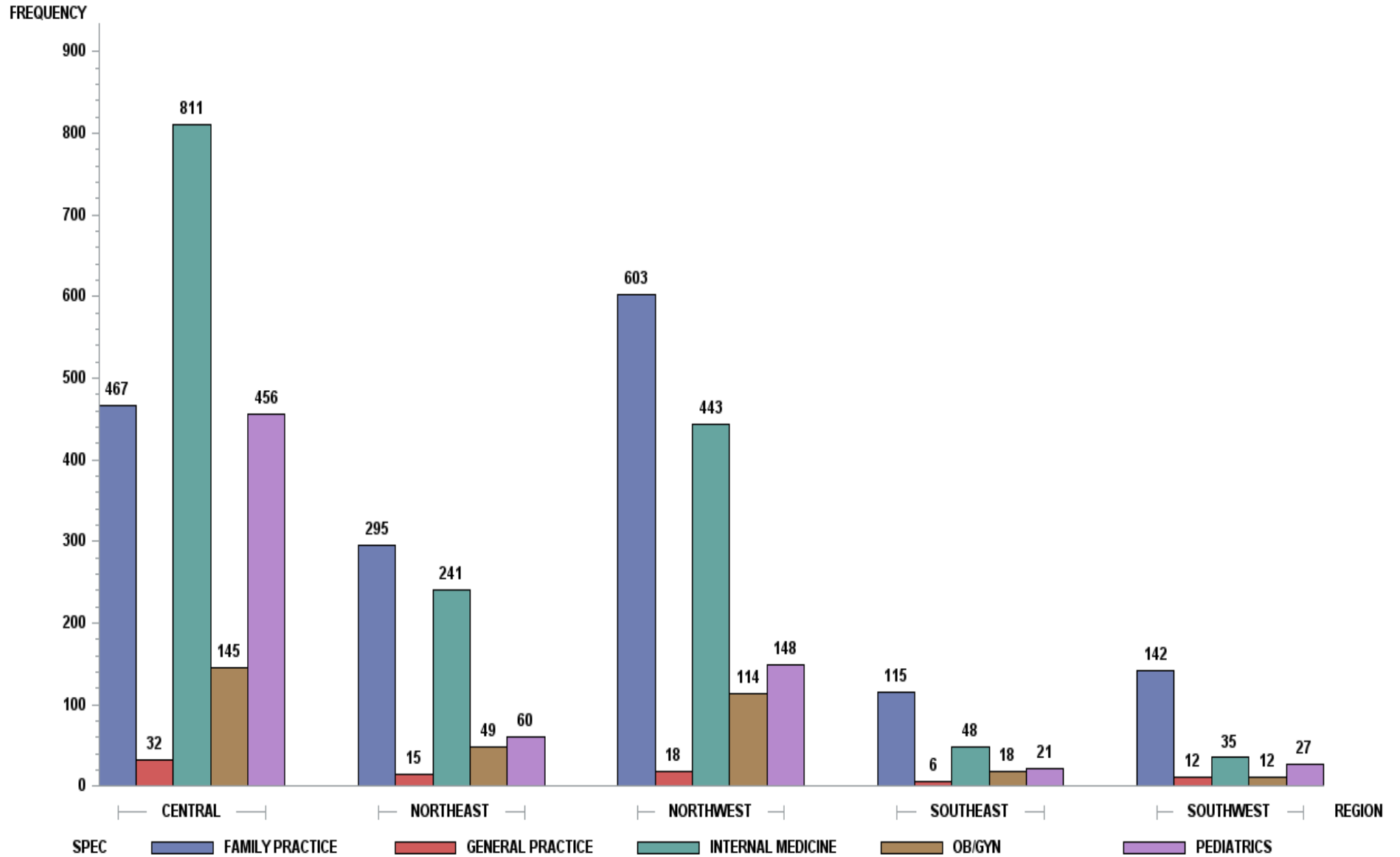
Distribution of Primary Care Physicians by Region



Distribution of Primary Care Physicians by Specialty

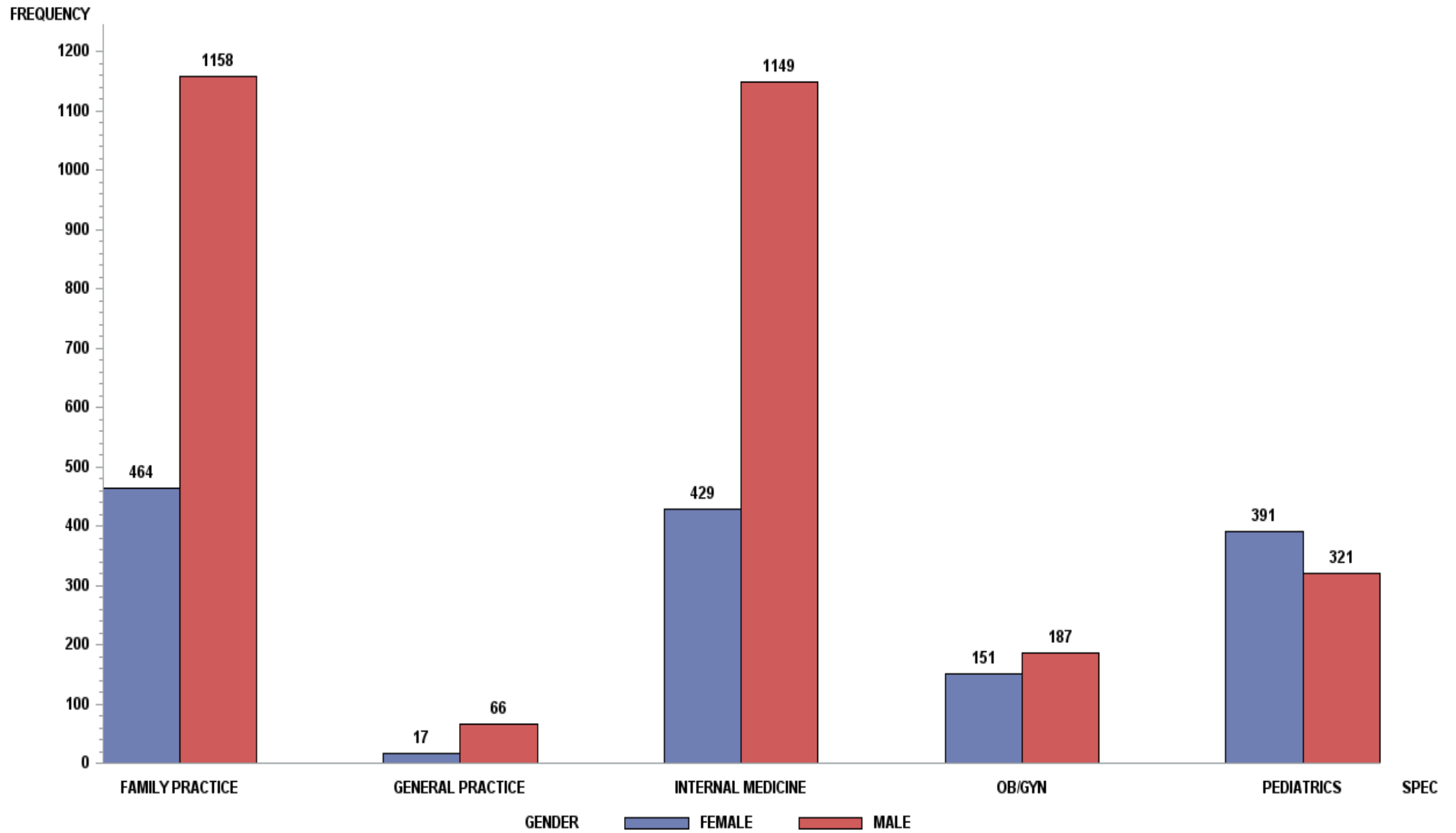


Primary Care Physicians by Region and Specialty



The graph below displays gender demographics among primary care physicians by specialty.

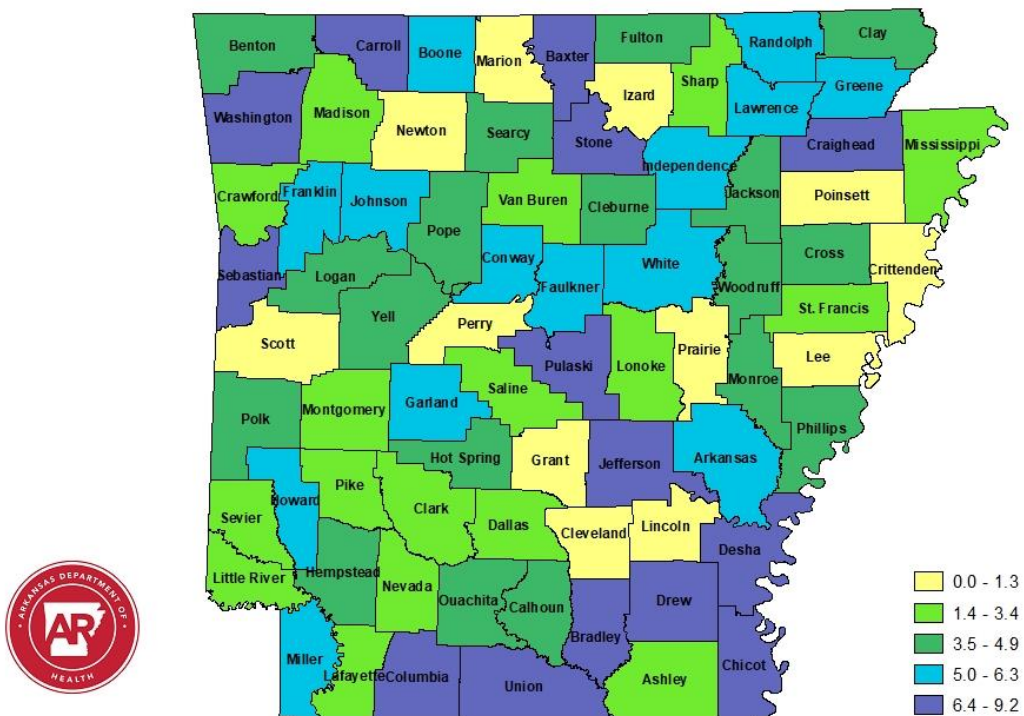
Primary Care Physicians by Gender and Specialty

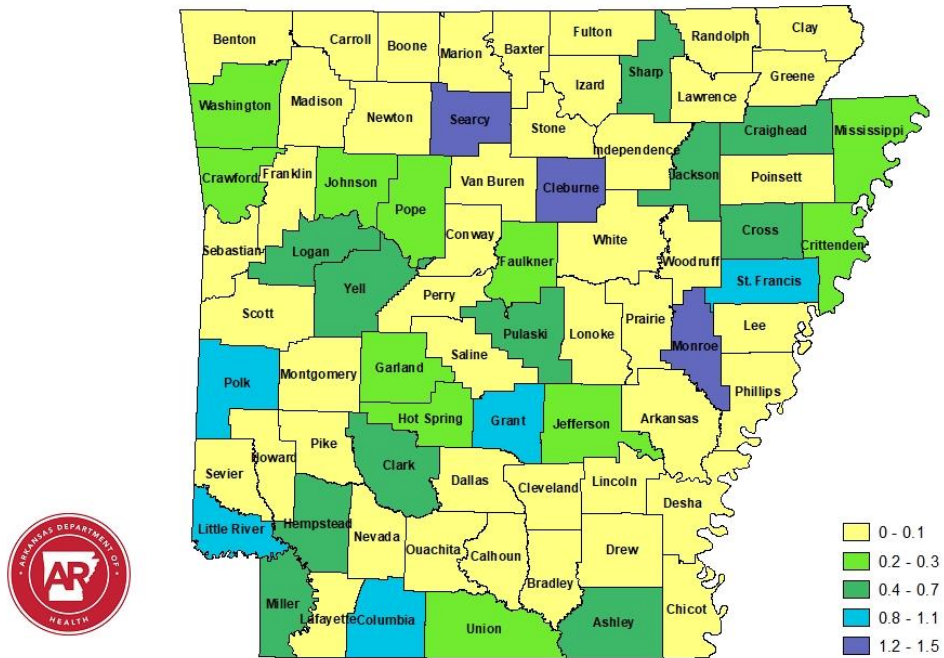

Family Practice Physicians by County Per 10,000 Population



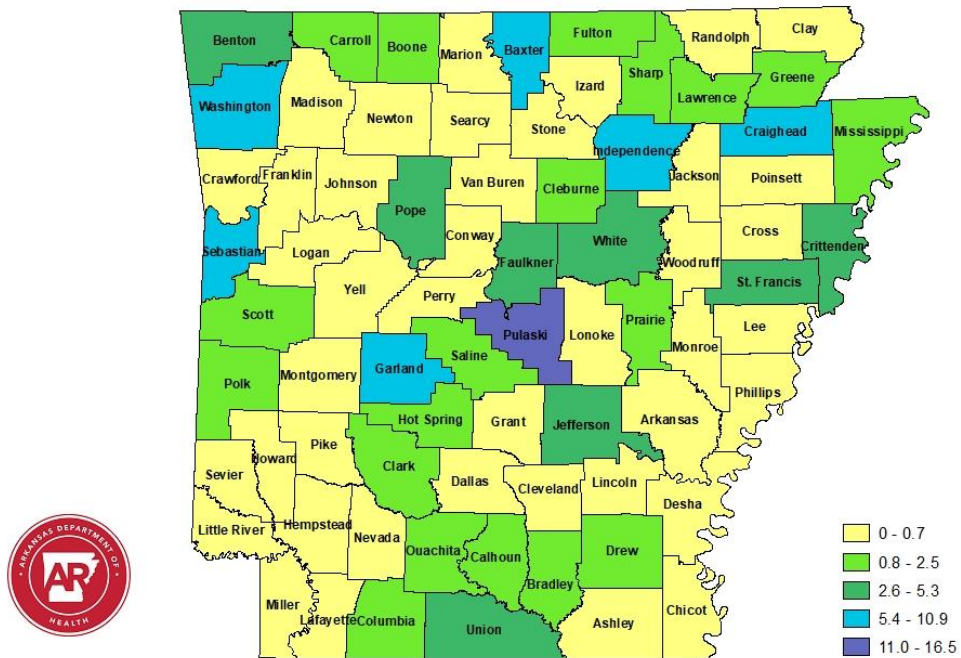

General Practice Physicians Per 10,000 Population



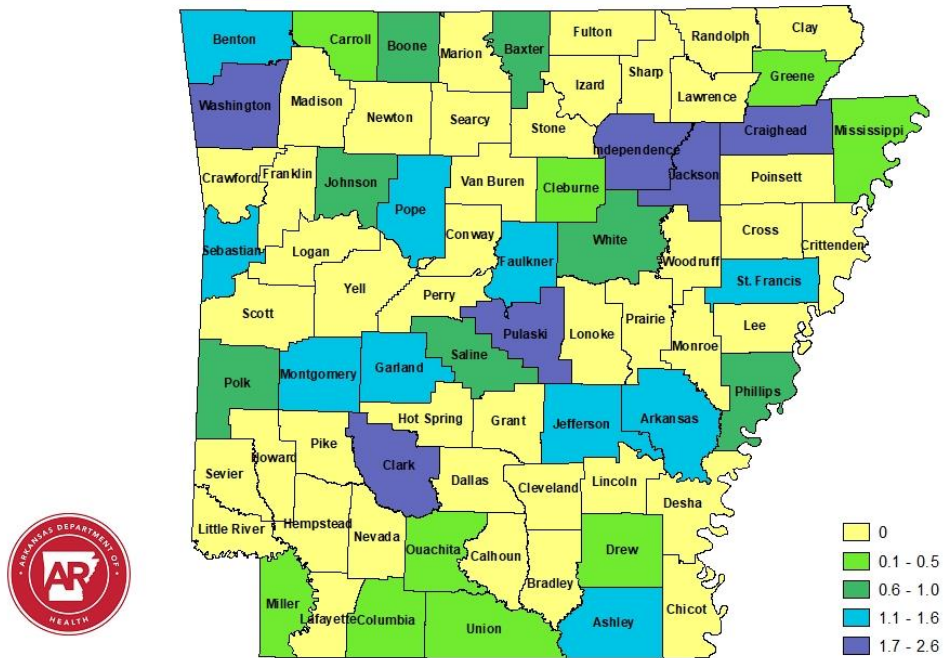

Internal Medicine Physicians by County Per 10,000 Population



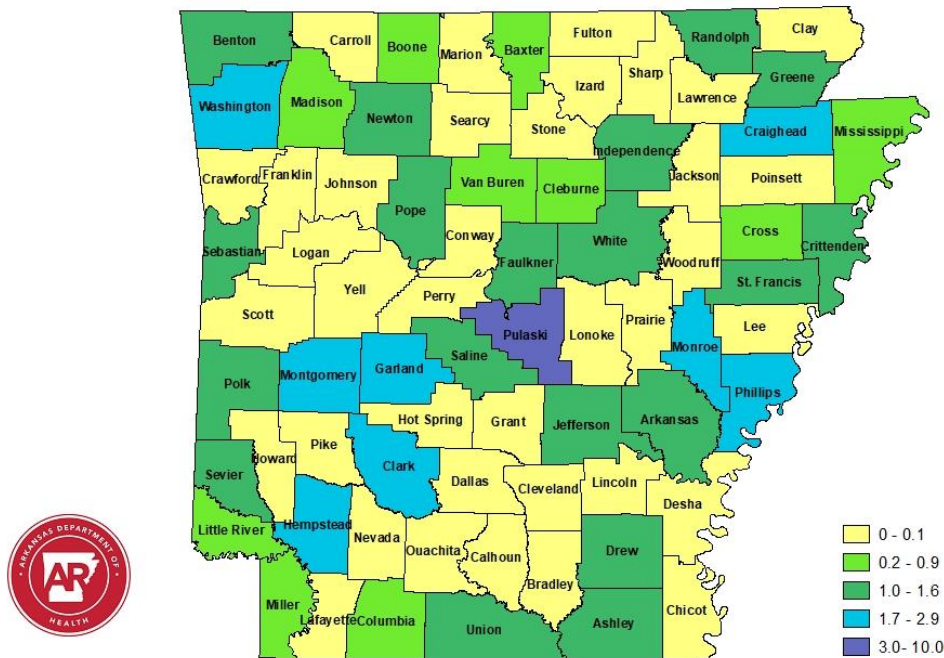

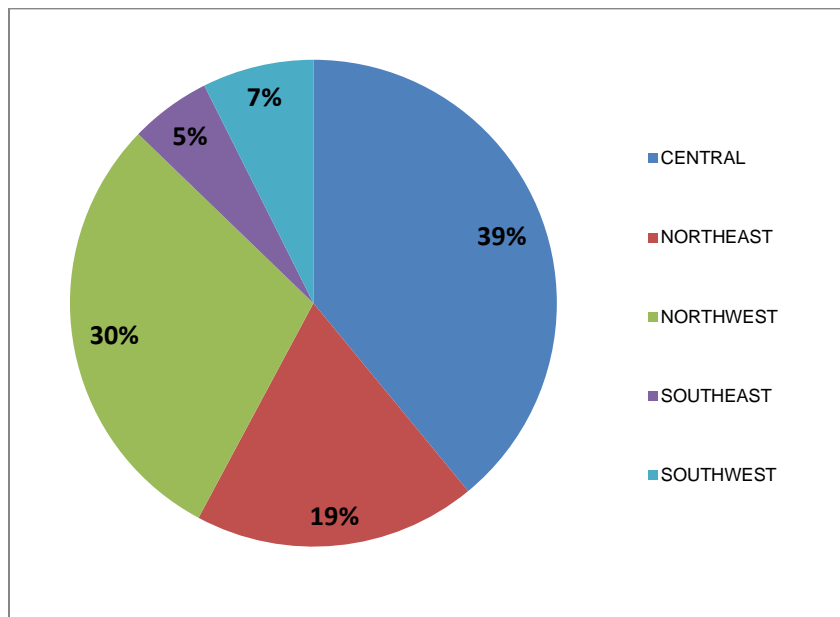

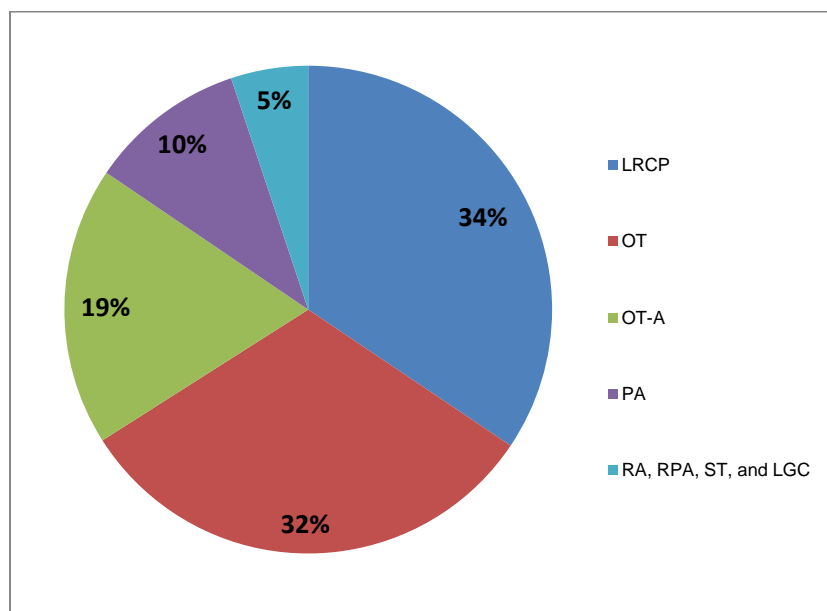

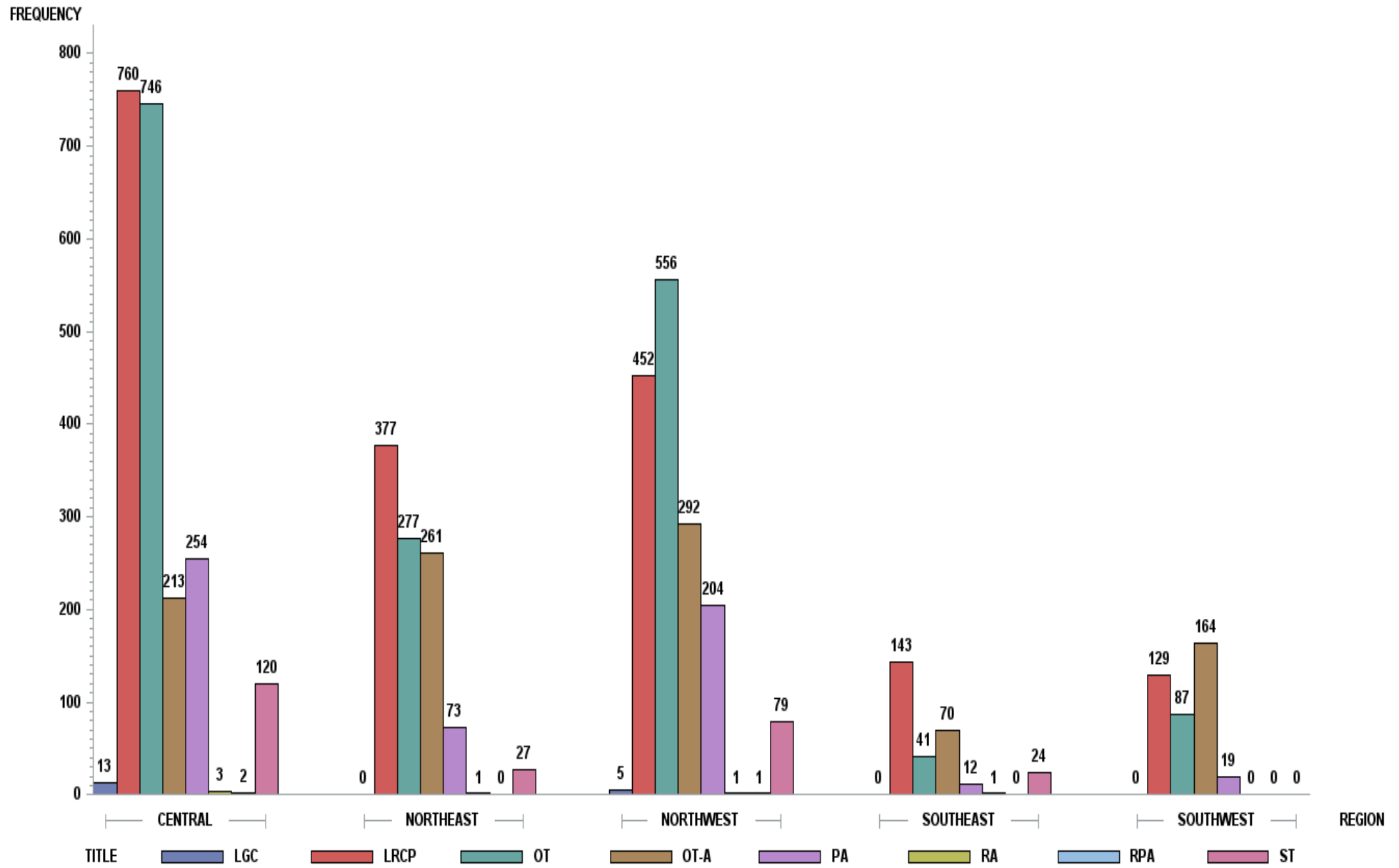
Health-Related Professionals by Region



Health-Related Professionals by Specialty

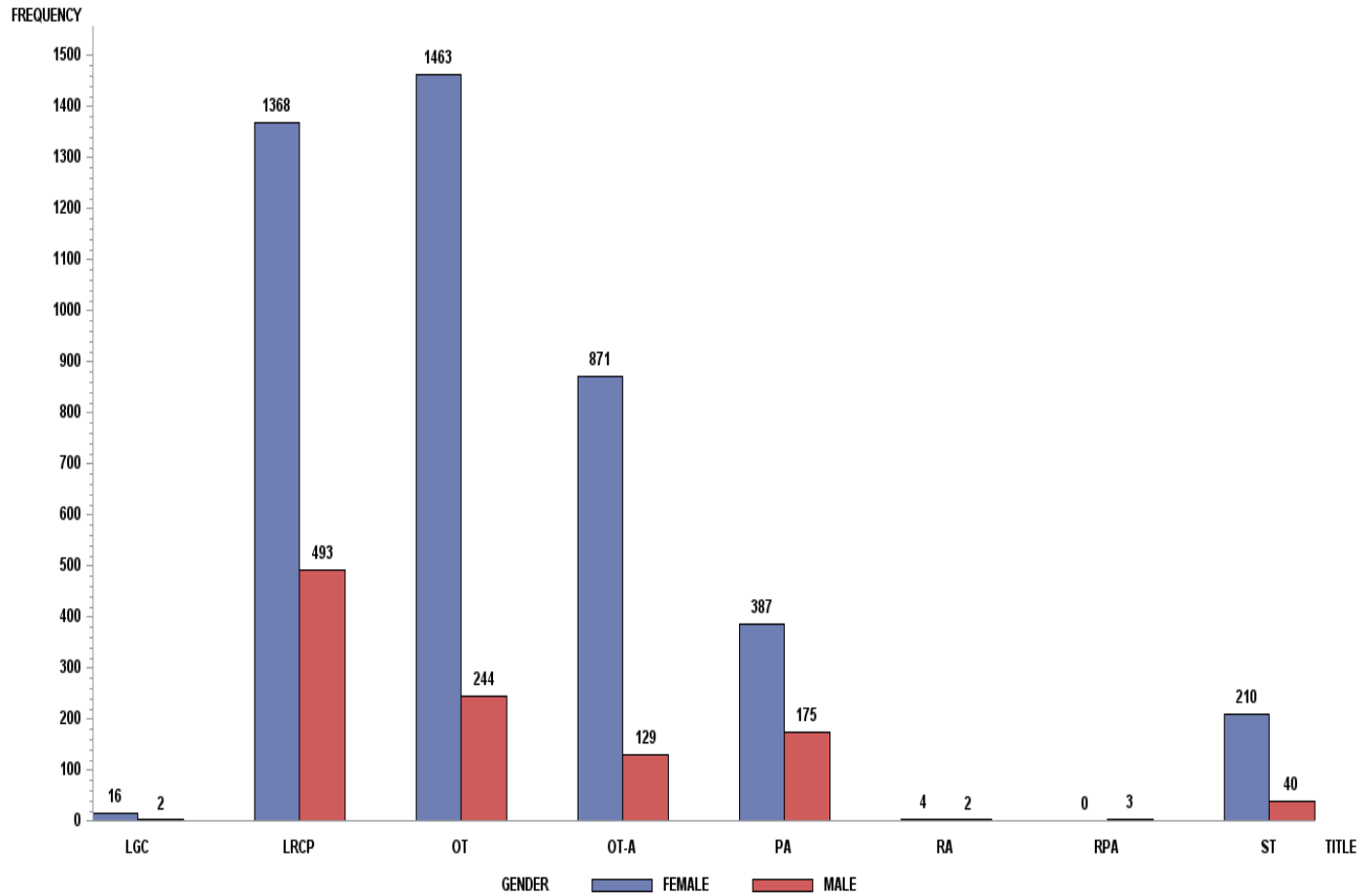


Health-Related Professionals by Region and Specialty

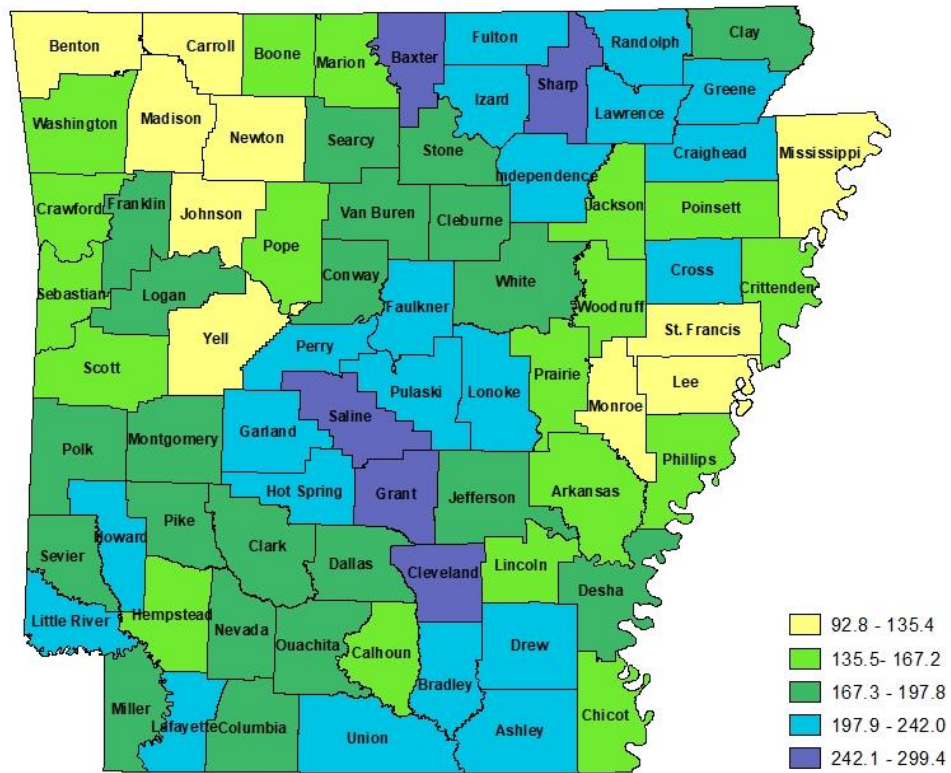
Nurses in Arkansas

In 2021, the Nursing Board licensed 56,103 nurses with mailing addresses in Arkansas, about 185.4 per 10,000 population. This total includes 37,963 Registered Nurses (RN), 13,004 Licensed Practical Nurses (LPN), 48 Licensed Psychiatric Technician Nurses (LPTN), and 250 Registered Nurse Practitioners (RNP). There were 4,838 nurses registered as Advanced Practice Nurses (APN).

These 56,103 nurses had a total of 61,939 licenses, however for the purposes of this report, the following hierarchy was used to take the highest of the five license types: LPN < LPTN < RN < RNP < APN. The APNs consist of four different licenses but will be grouped together for most of this section. They will be broken down into individual licenses later in the section. The number of licensed nurses for the state increased 2.2% from 2020 to 2021.

After completing basic nursing programs, RN and LPN must pass nationally standardized examinations. LPTNs must have passed a state licensure exam. RNPs must complete a nurse practitioner program in addition to their RN program. To be licensed as an APN, an RN must complete an advanced practice nursing program and hold certification from a Board approved, nationally recognized, certifying body.

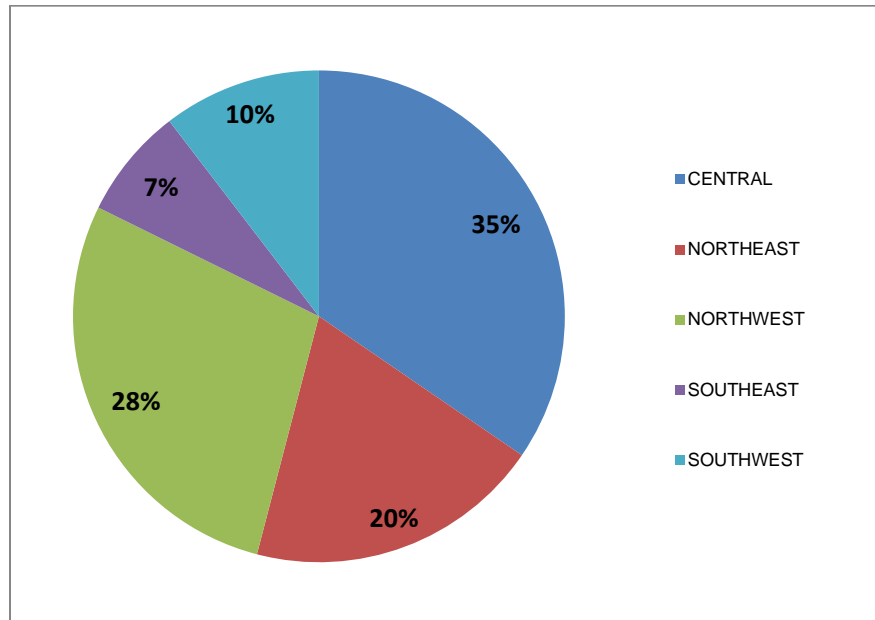
Nurses by County Per 10,000 Population



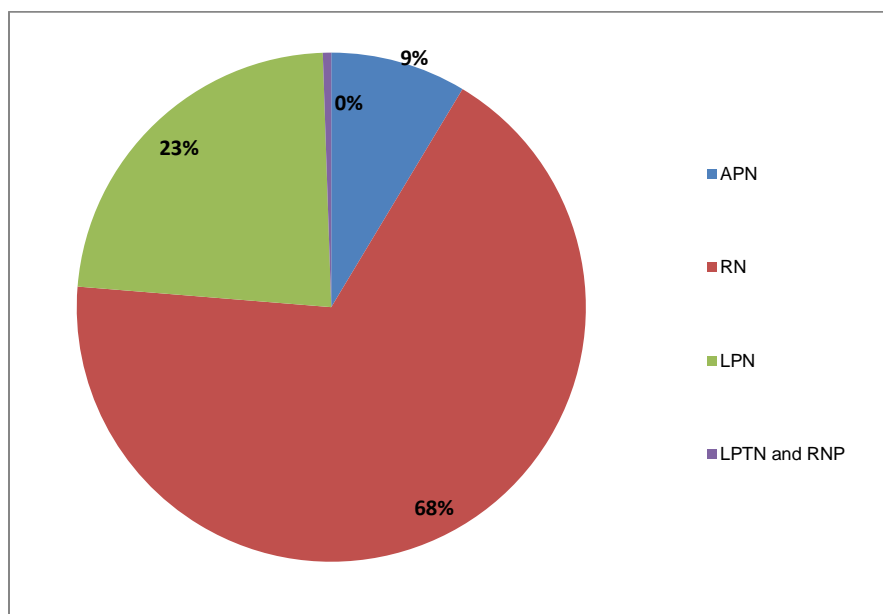

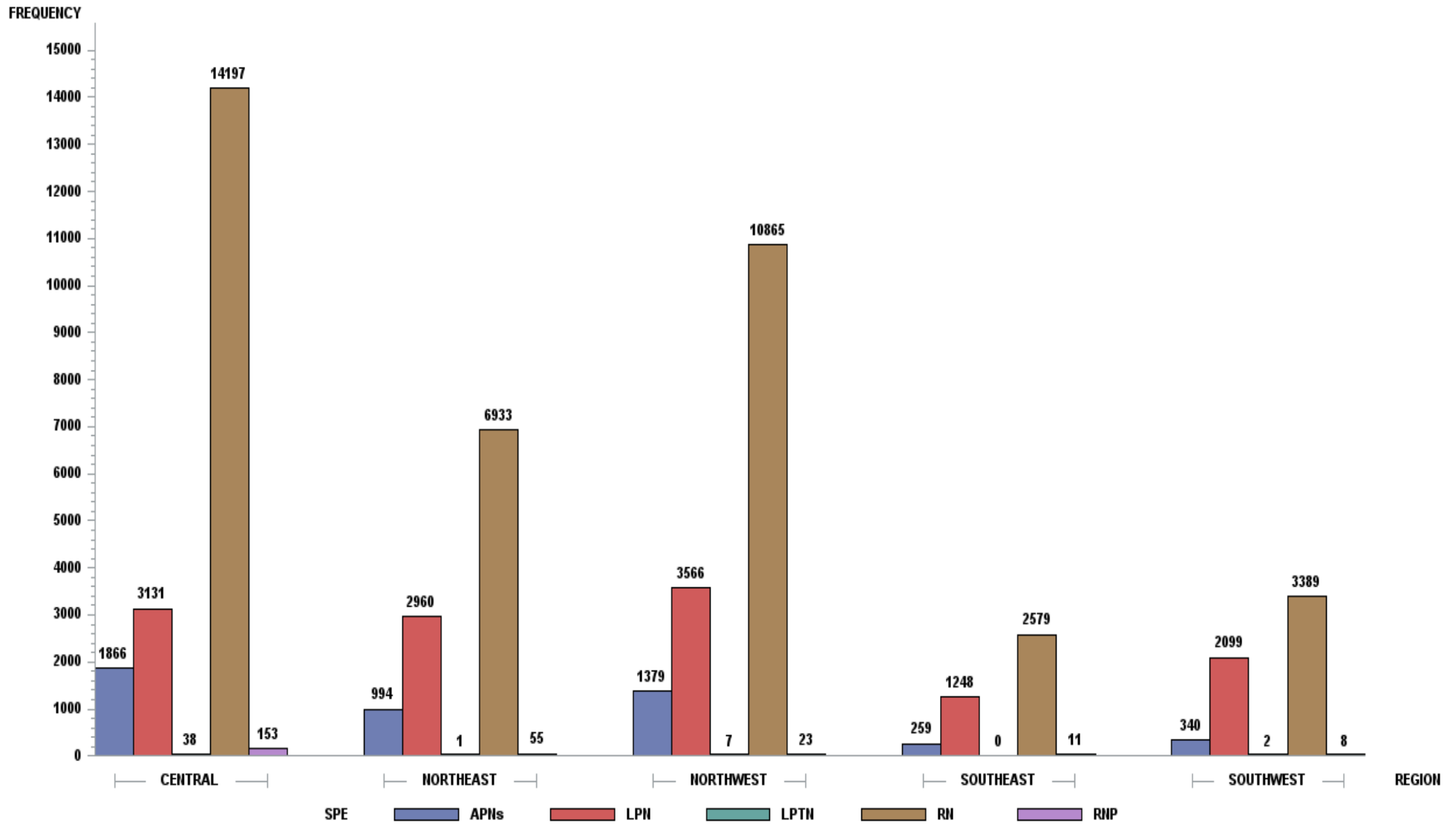
Distribution of Nurses by Region



Distribution of Nurses by Title

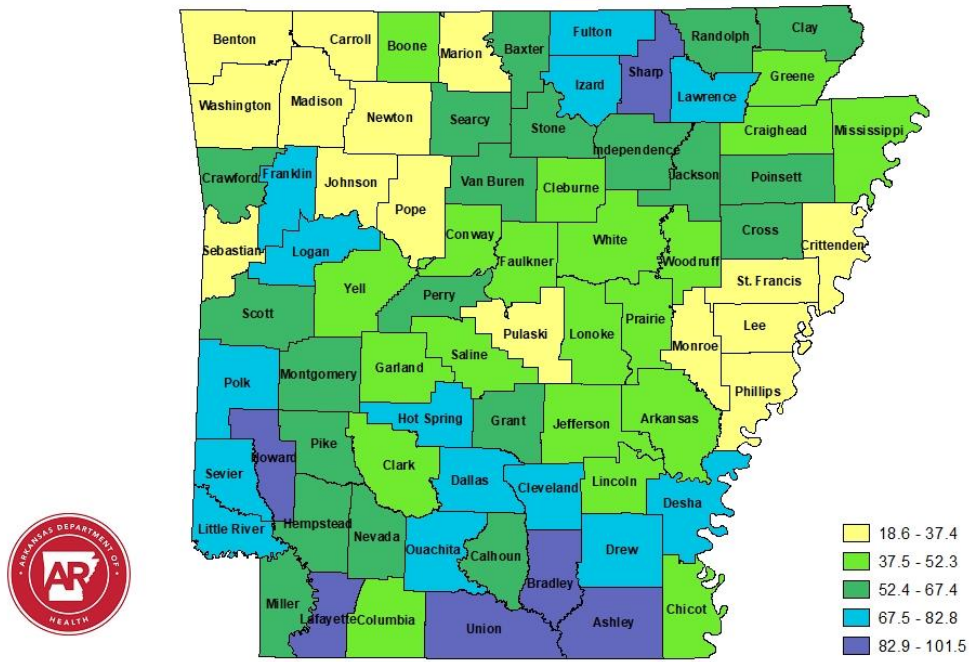


Nurses by Region and License Type



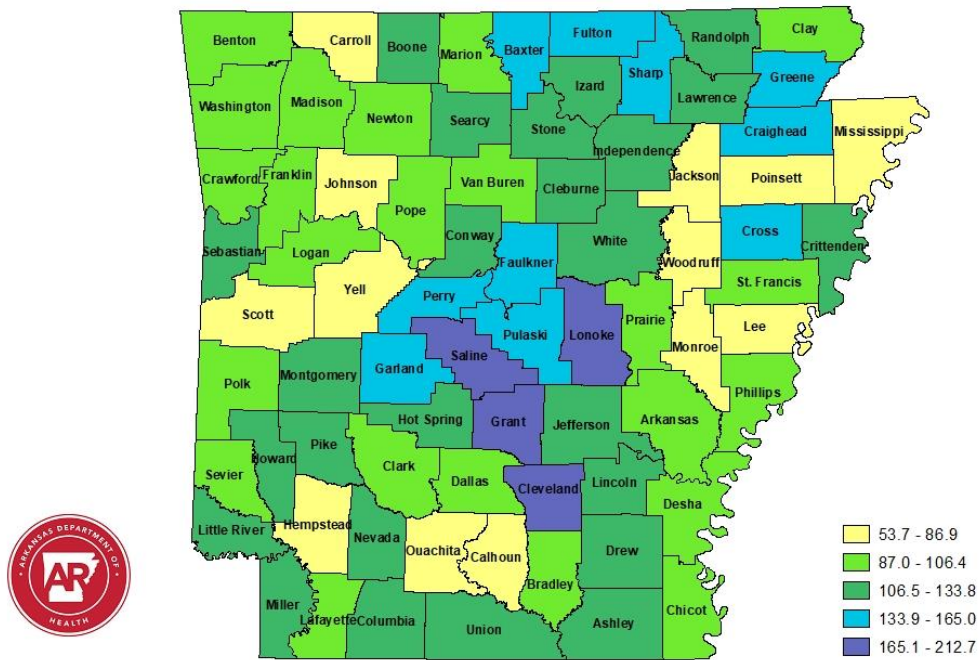

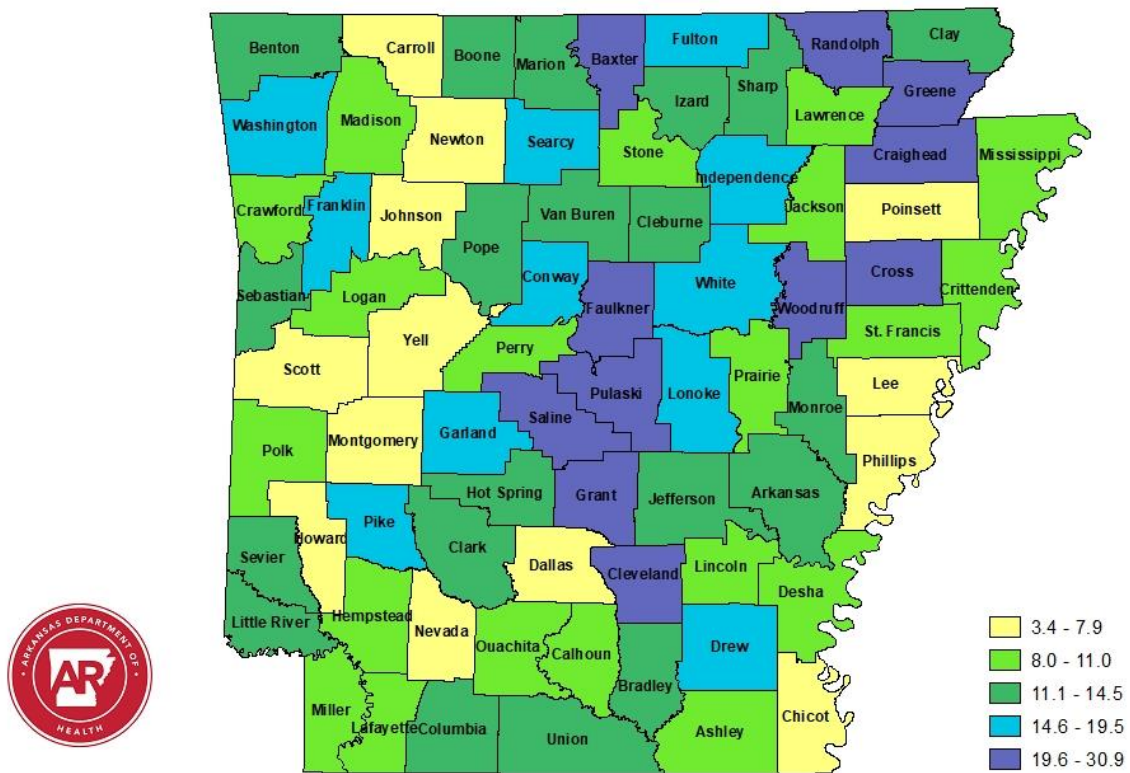

At this point in the section, the Advanced Practice Nurse group will be broken down into the individual license types. The four licenses in this category are: Certified Nurse Midwife (CNM), Clinical Nurse Specialist (CNS), Certified Registered Nurse Anesthetist (CNRA), and Certified Nurse Practitioner (CNP). Certified Nurse Practitioner has replaced the term Advanced Nurse Practitioner (ANP). These four licenses are considered equal in educational requirements so there is not a hierarchy for this group. Since they are considered equal, the nurses that have more than one APN license will be counted in the analysis for each license that they have.

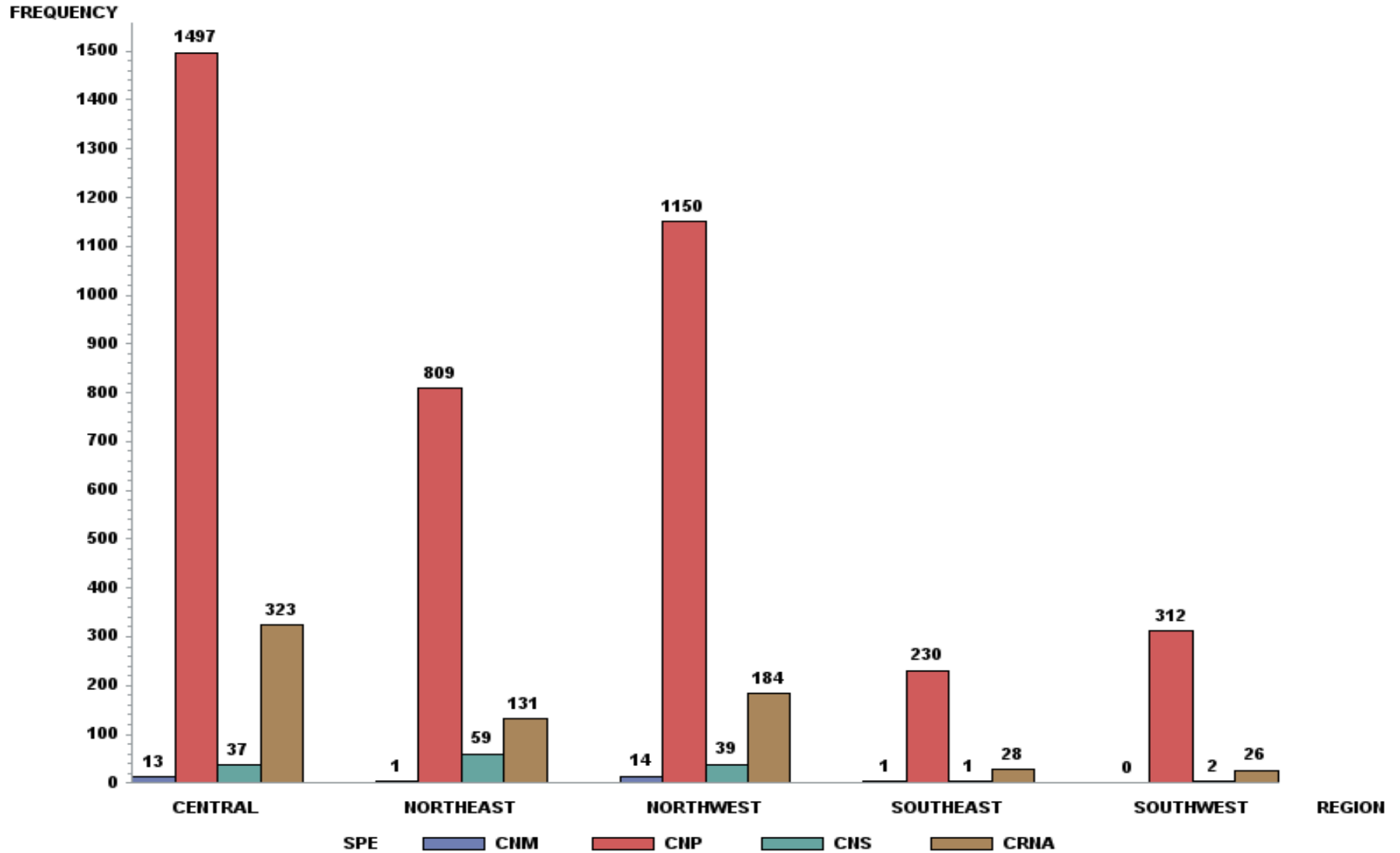

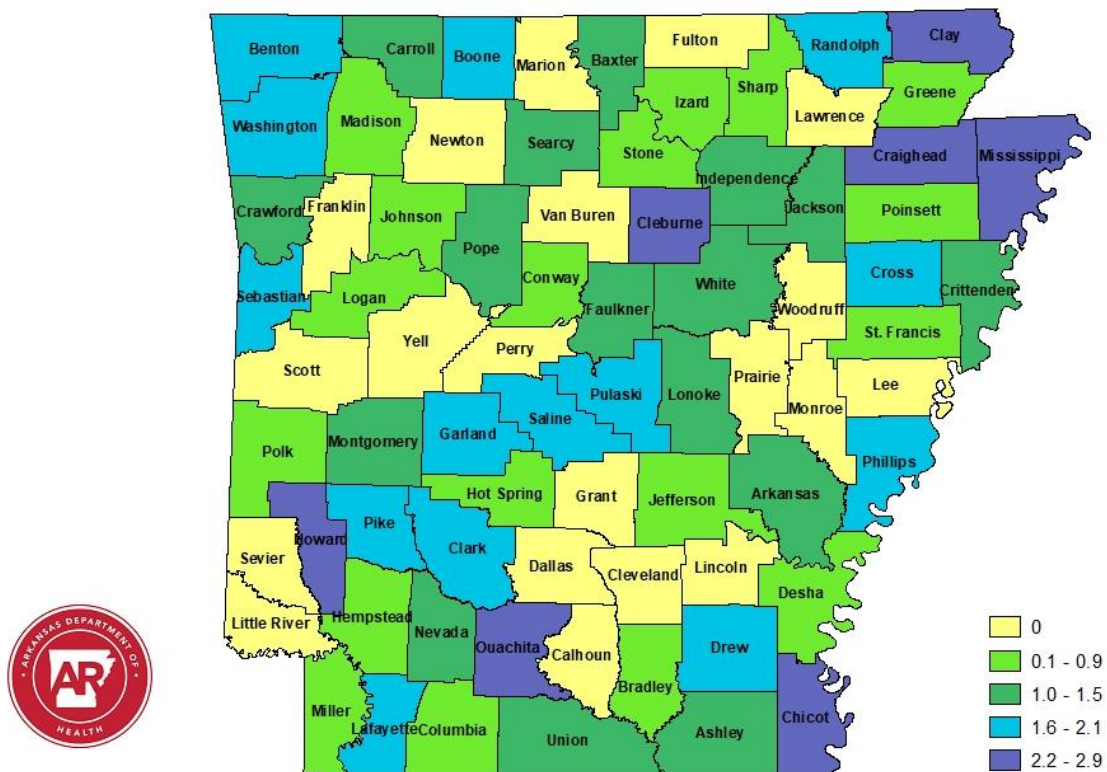

Optometry in Arkansas

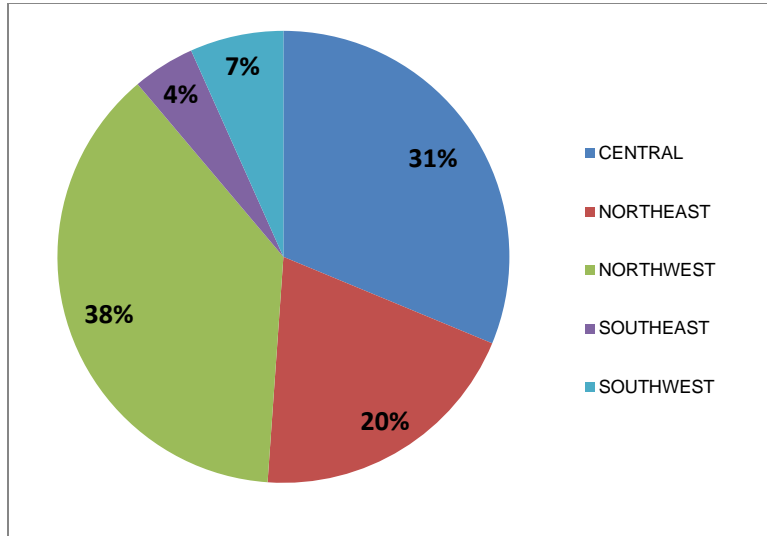
Optometrists by County Per 10,000 Population



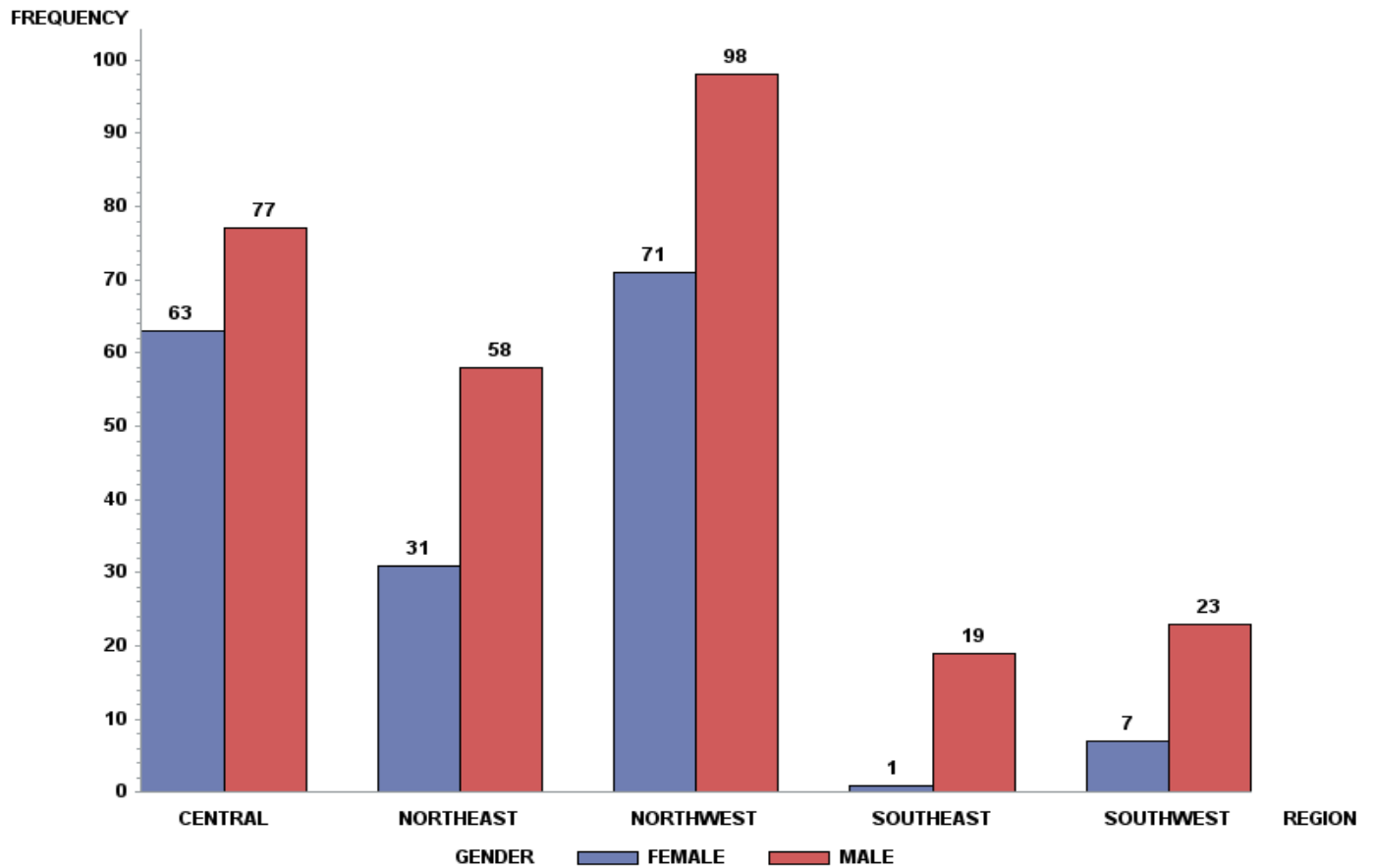

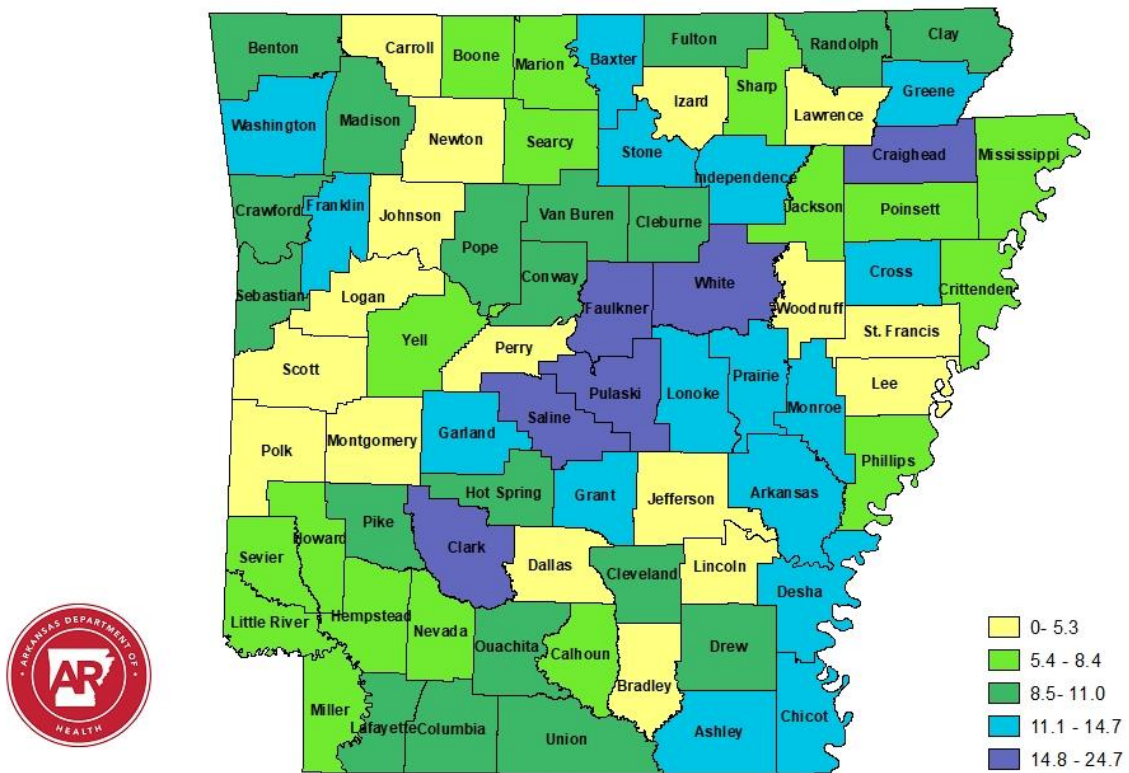

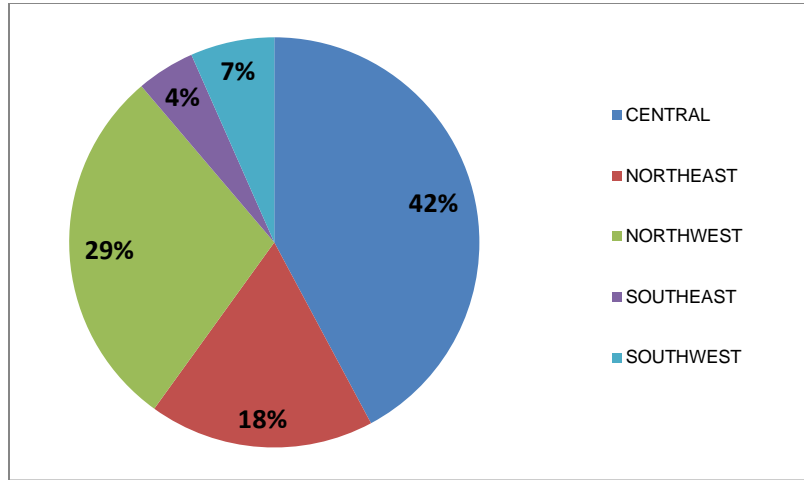
Pharmacists by County Per 10,000 Population



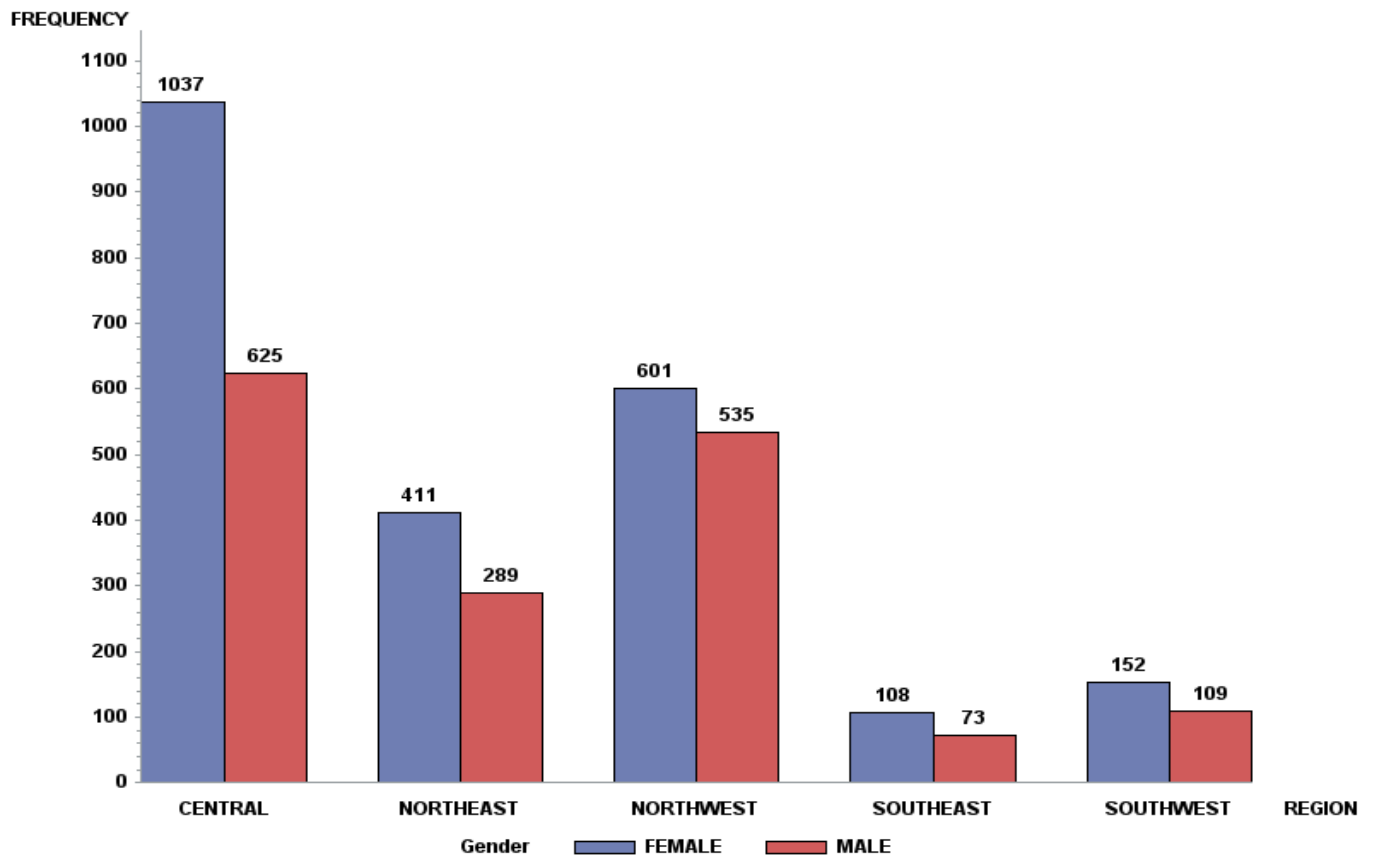

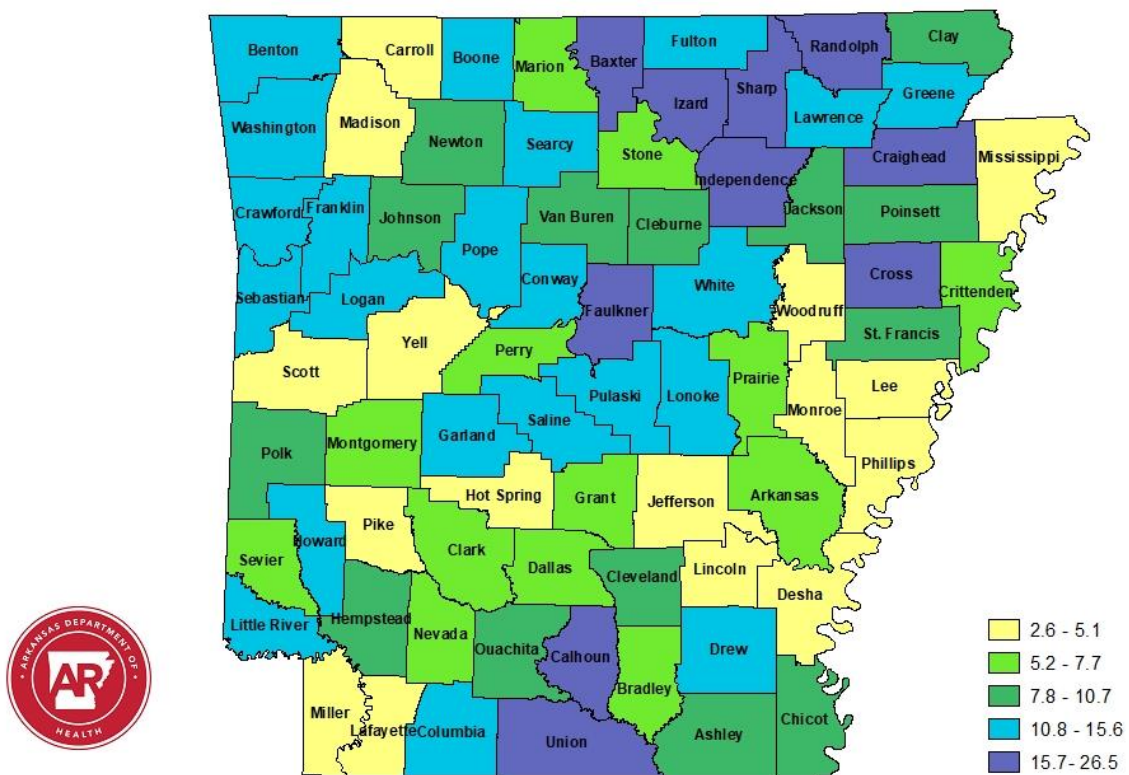

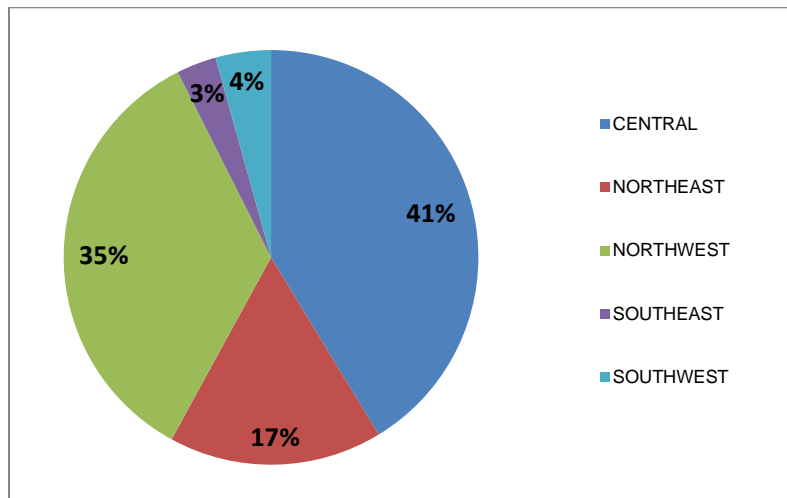
Physical Therapists by County Per 10,000 Population



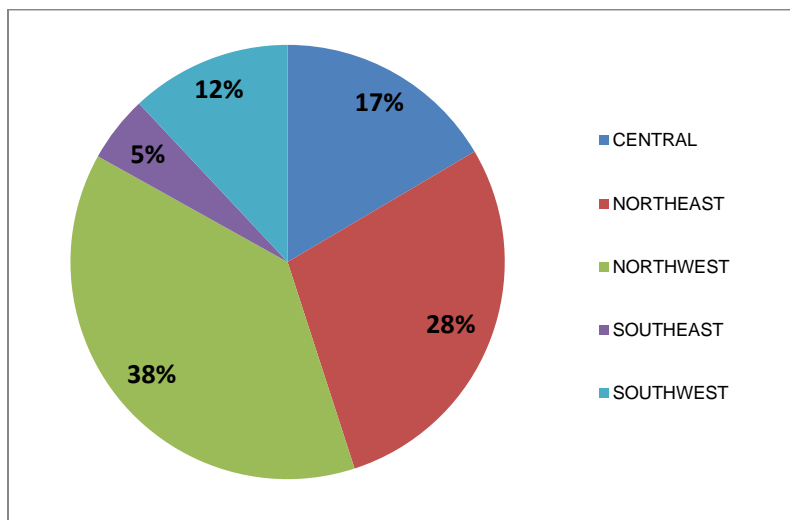

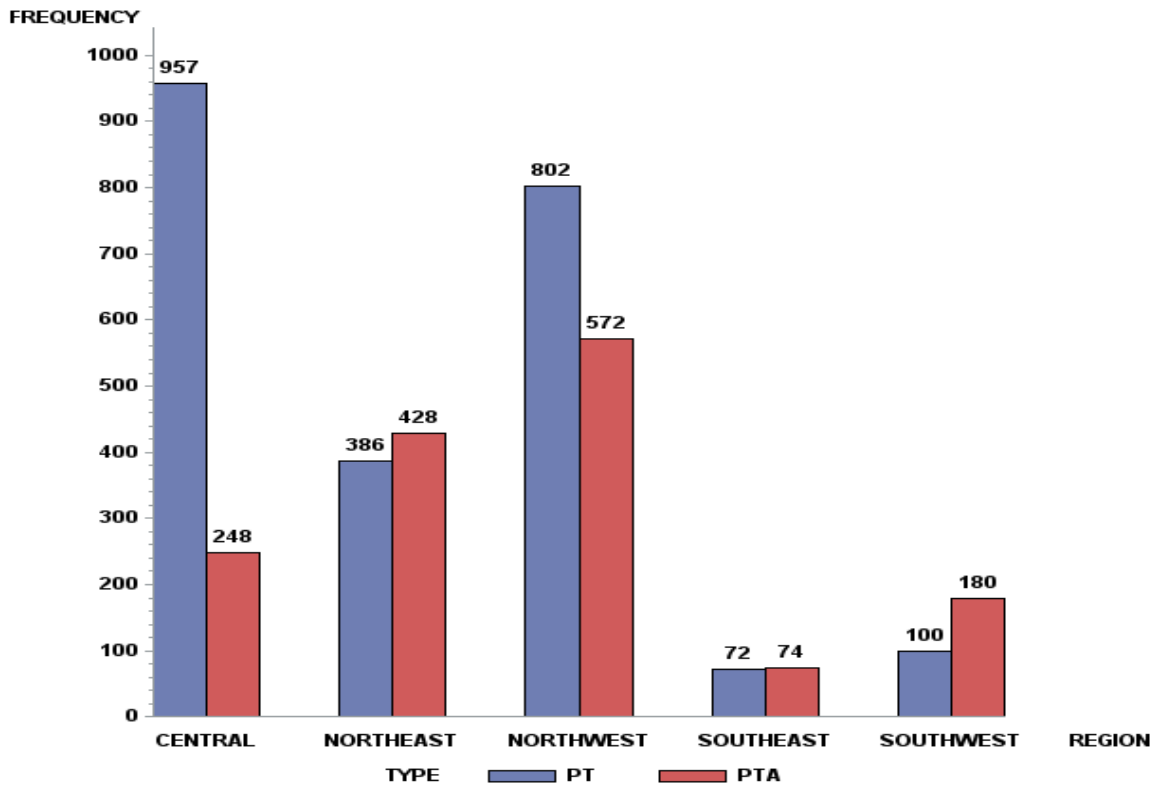

Physical Therapists by Region

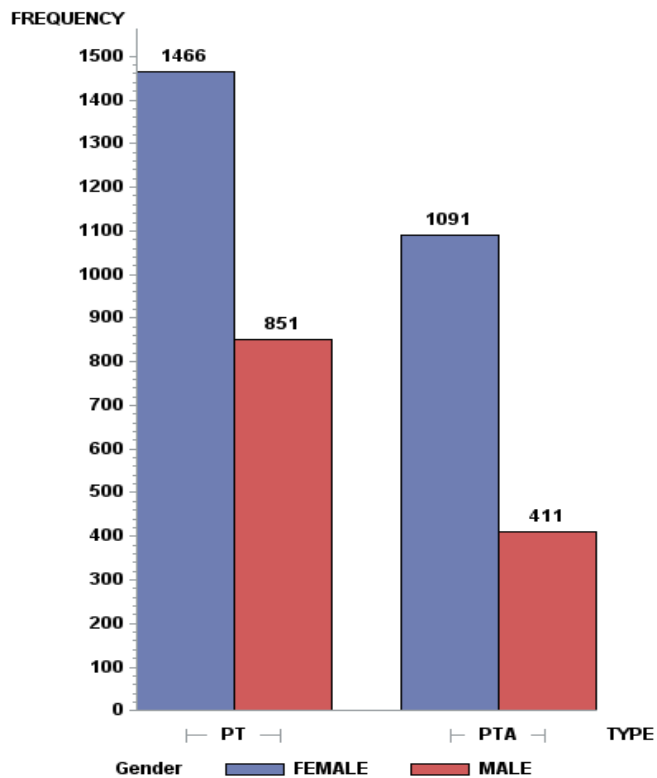


Physical Therapist Assistants by Region

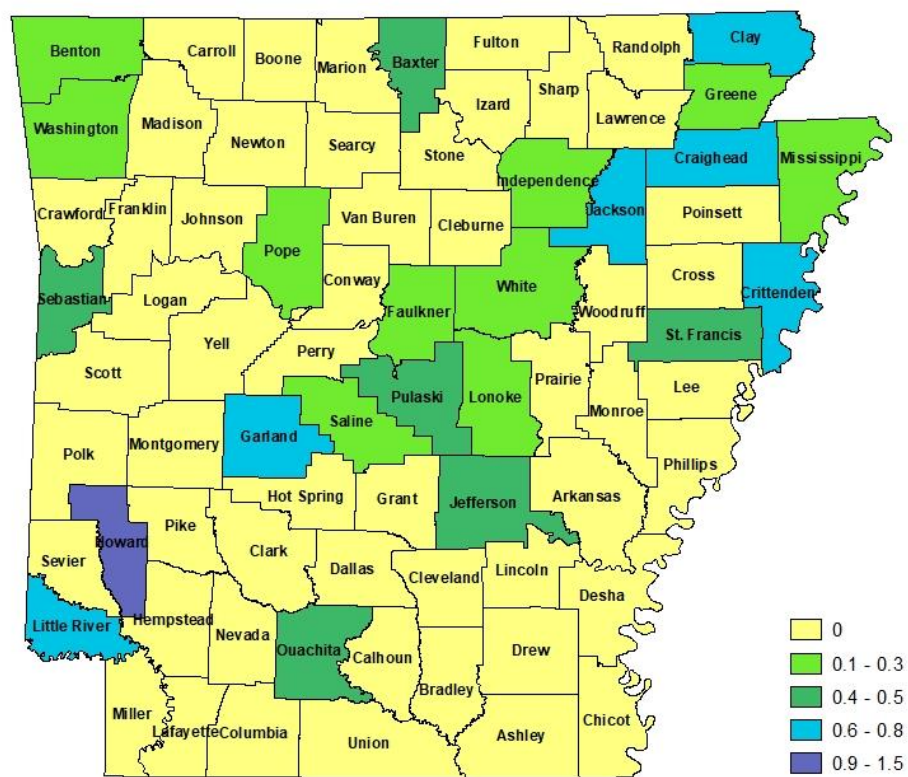

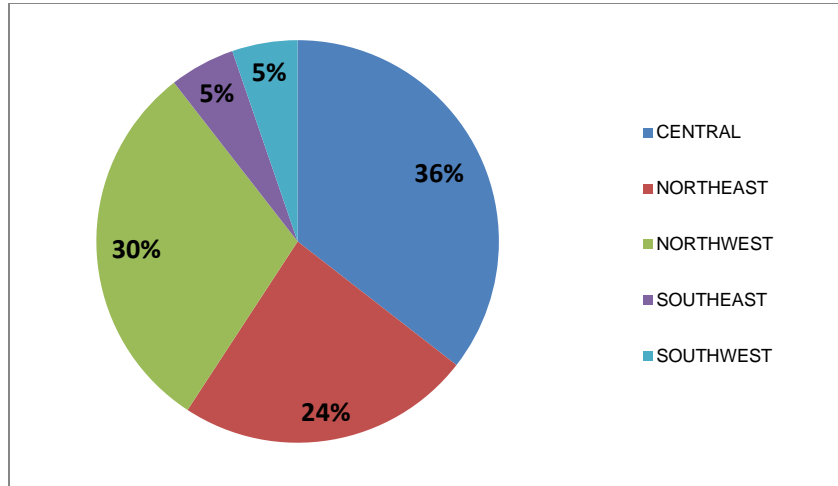
Podiatrists by County Per 10,000 Population



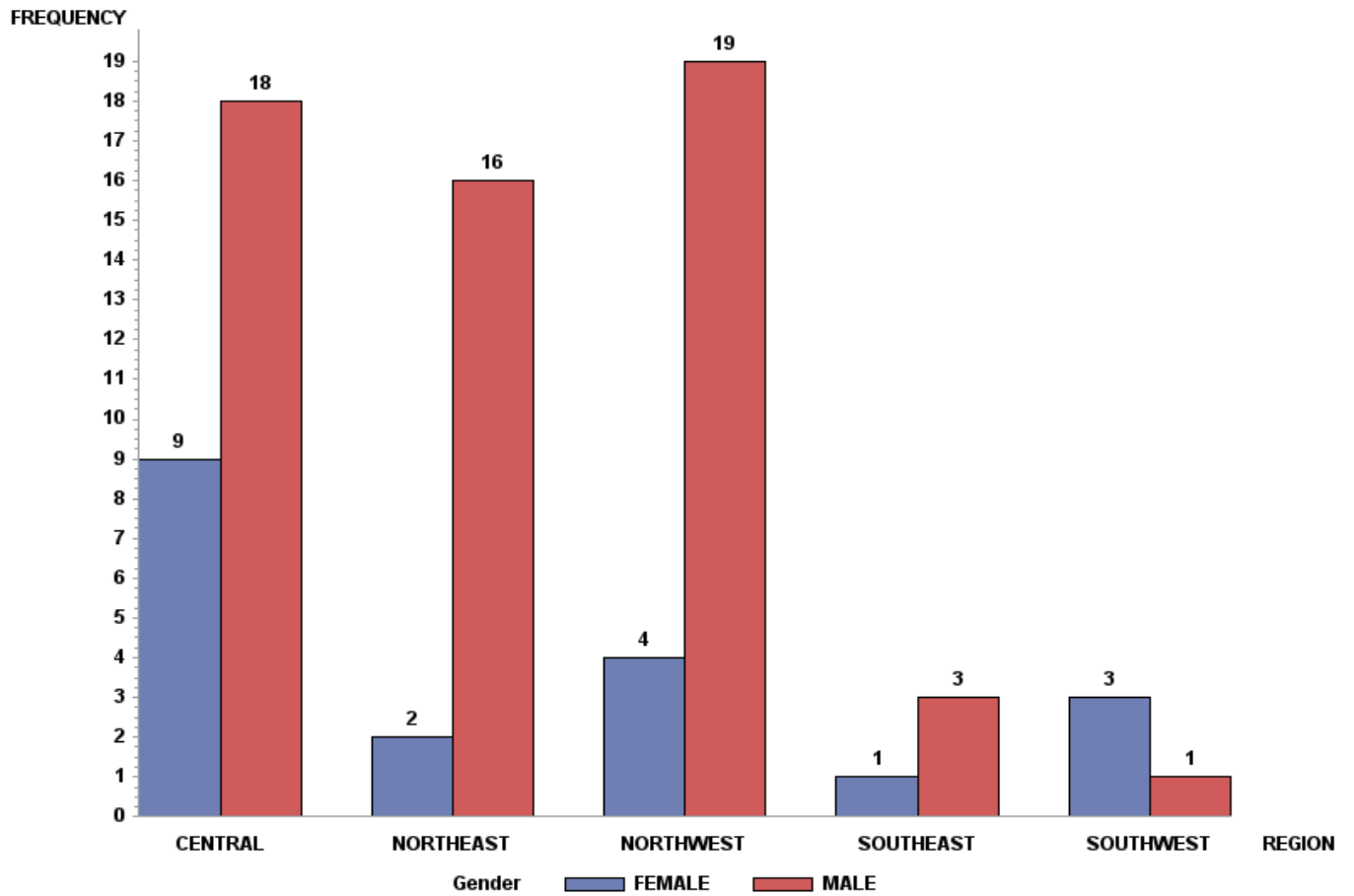

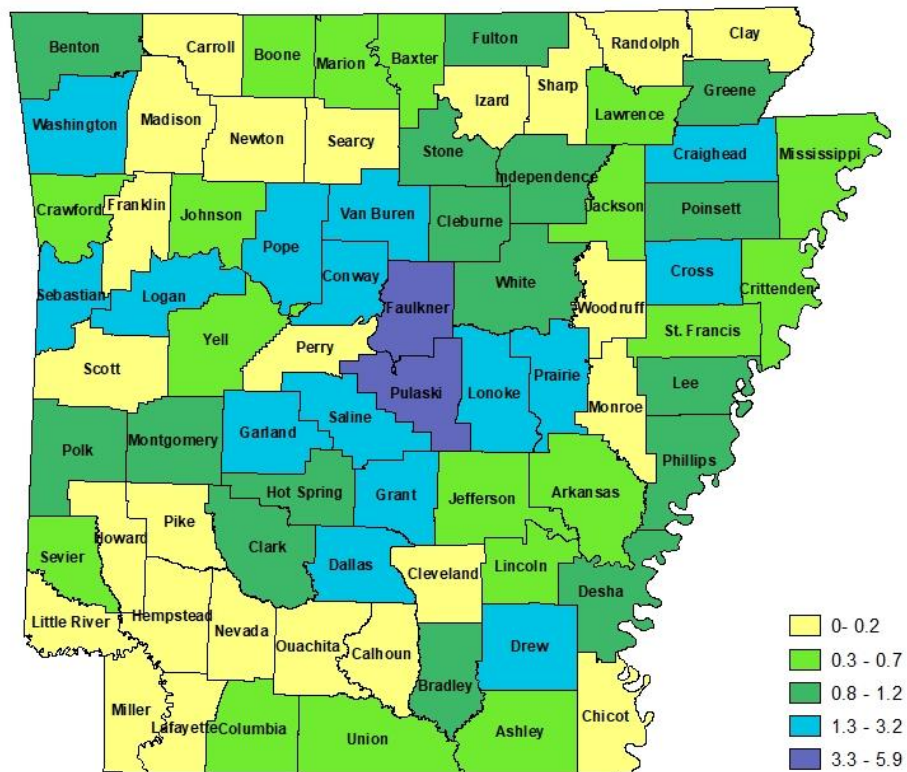

In 2021, the Psychology Board licensed 620 psychologists with mailing addresses in Arkansas; about 2 per 10,000 population. This total includes 373 Psychologists (P), 47 Psychologists Examiners (E), and 200 Psychological Examiner Independents (IE); about 1.2, 0.2 and 0.7 respectively, per 10,000 population. Of the 75 Arkansas counties, 23 (31%) did not have a registered psychologist and 18 (24%) of the counties had only one.

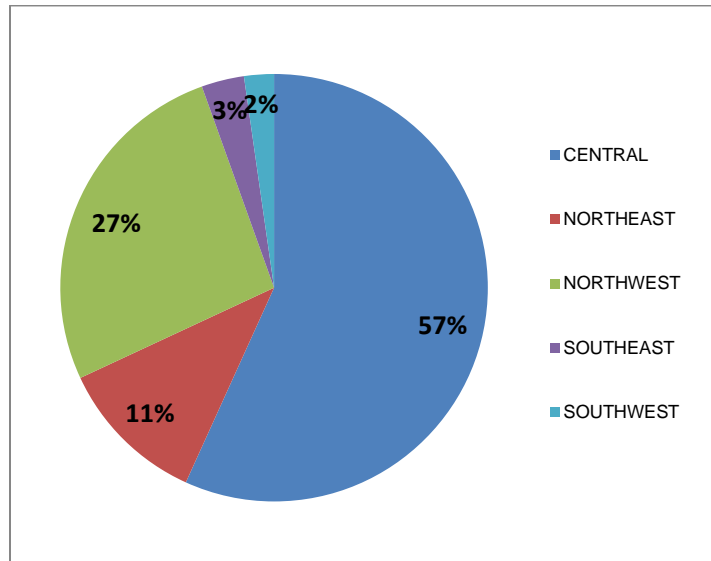
Psychologists by County Per 10,000 Population



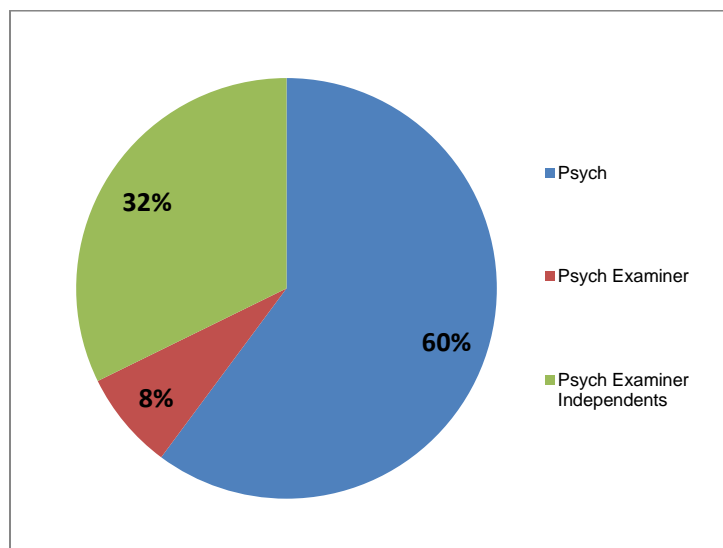

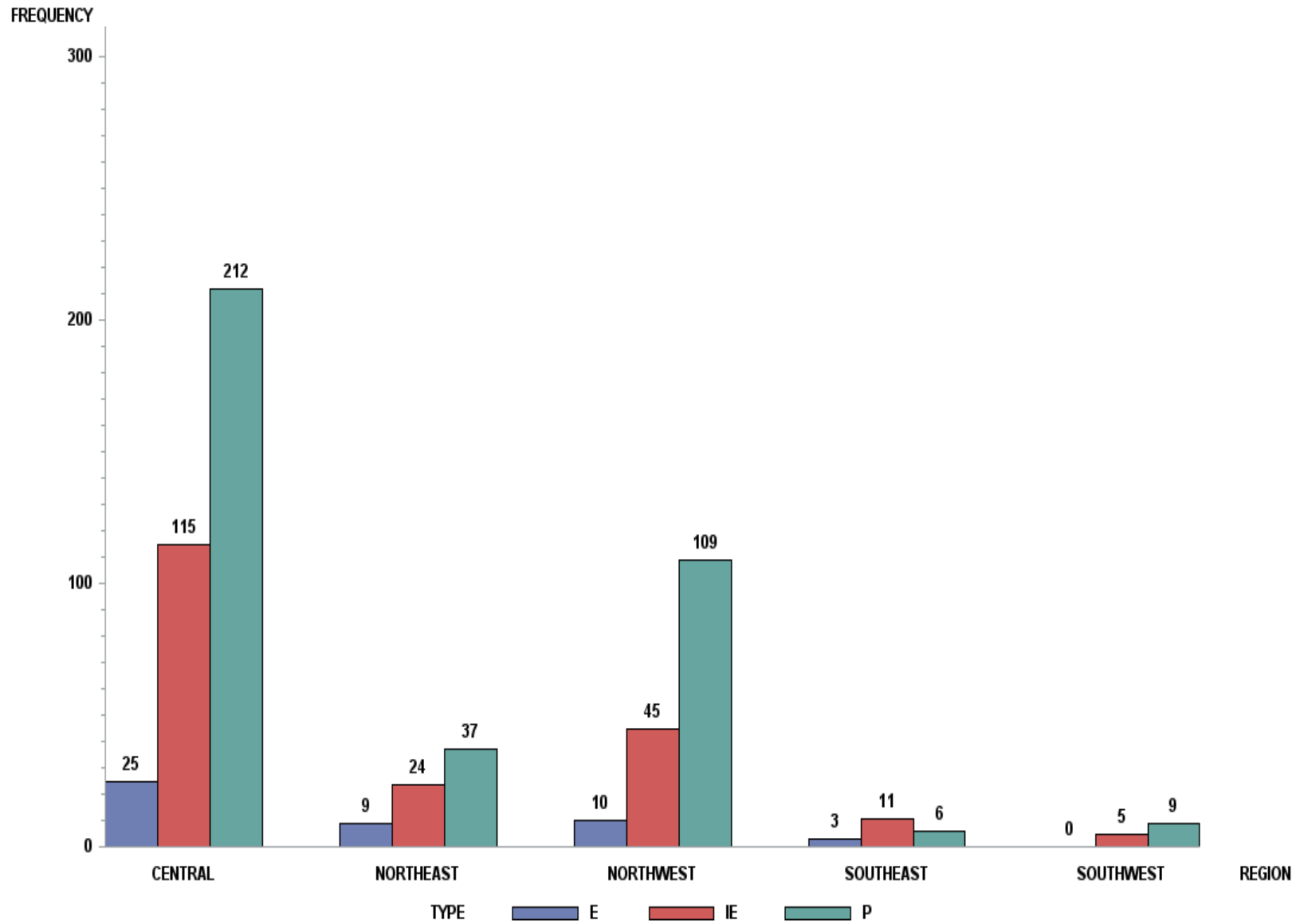
Distribution of Psychologists by Region



Distribution of Psychologists by Title

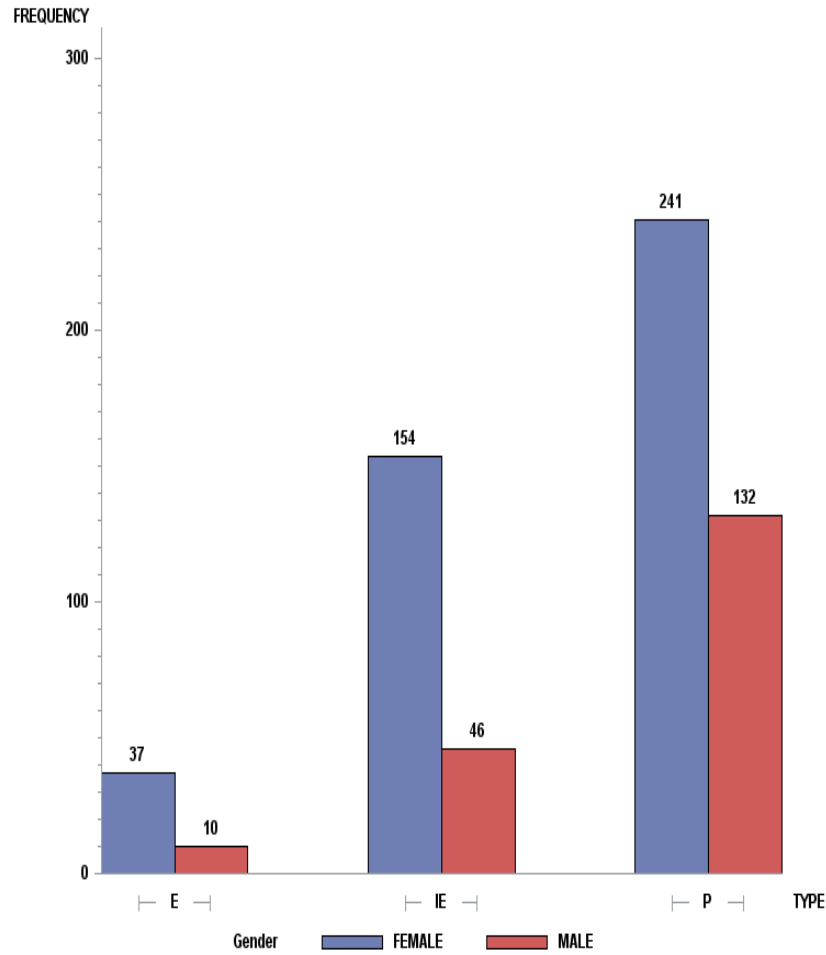


Psychologists by Region and License Type

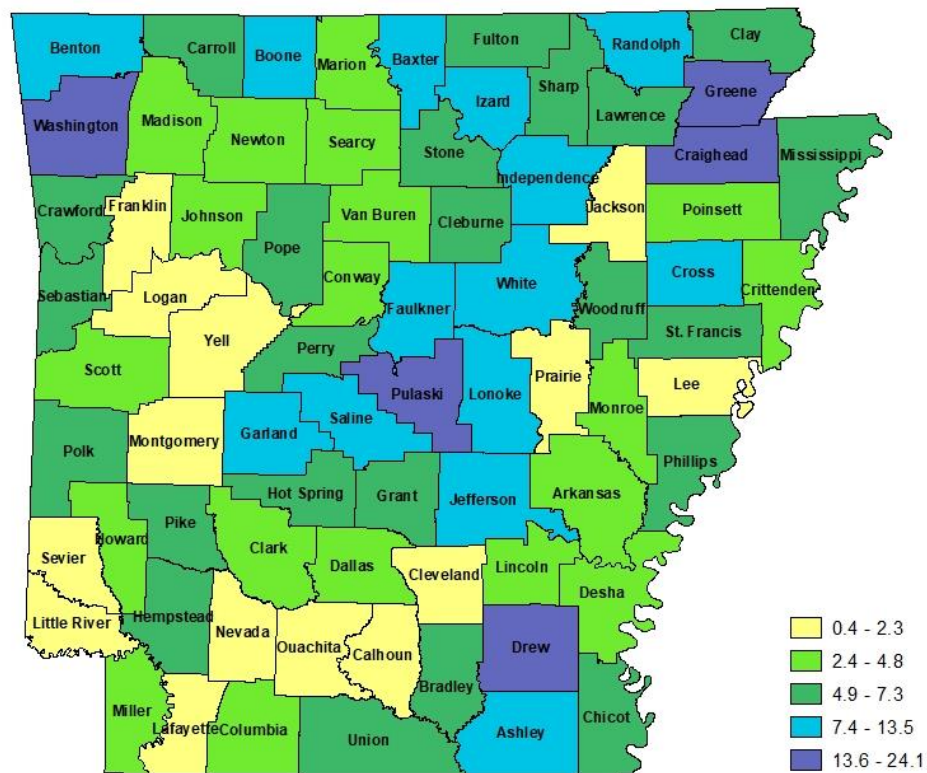

Social Workers in Arkansas

In 2021, the Social Work Licensing Board licensed 3,341 social workers with mailing addresses in Arkansas: about 11 per 10,000 population. This total includes 342 social workers (LSW), 1,894 certified social workers (LCSW), and 968 master social workers (LMSW). In addition, the Social Worker Licensing Board issued 137 provisional licenses for social workers with mailing addresses in Arkansas (*Provisional license for social workers means: First-time applicants for LSW or LMSW licensure will be issued a provisional license upon approval of his or her application. A provisional license will be issued one time per person and expires exactly one-year from the date of issuance. Provisional licensing is prohibited at the LCSW level.*). This total includes 38 Provisional license social workers (PLSW), and 99 provisional license master social workers (PLMSW). At least one fully licensed social worker was licensed in each of the Arkansas counties.

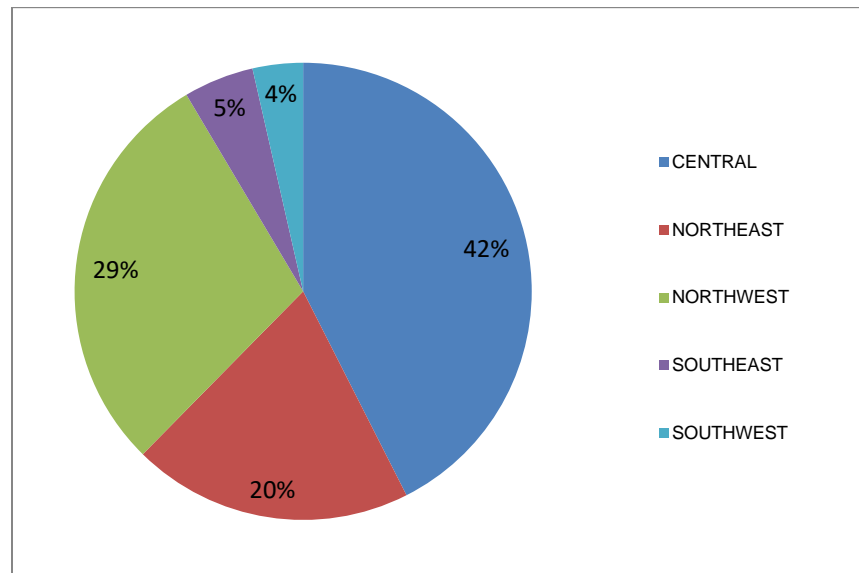
Social Workers by County Per 10,000 Population



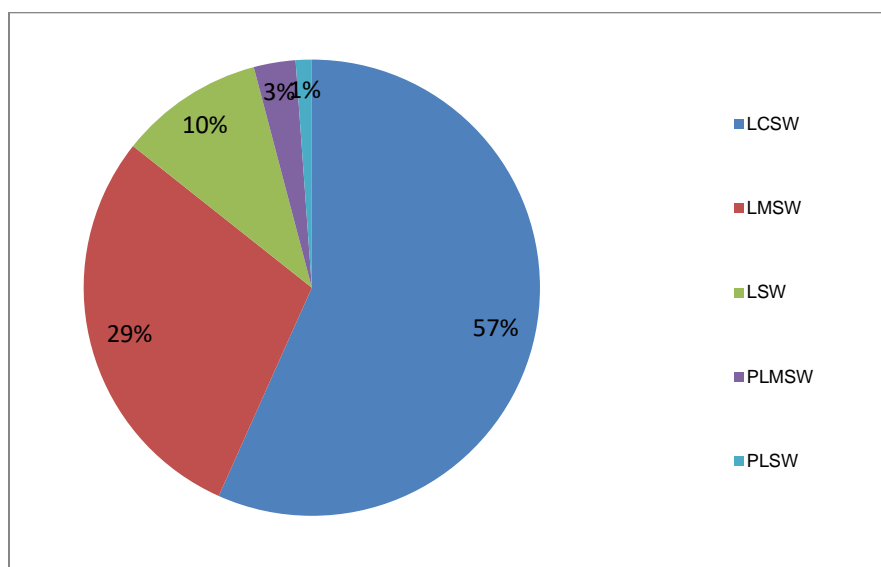

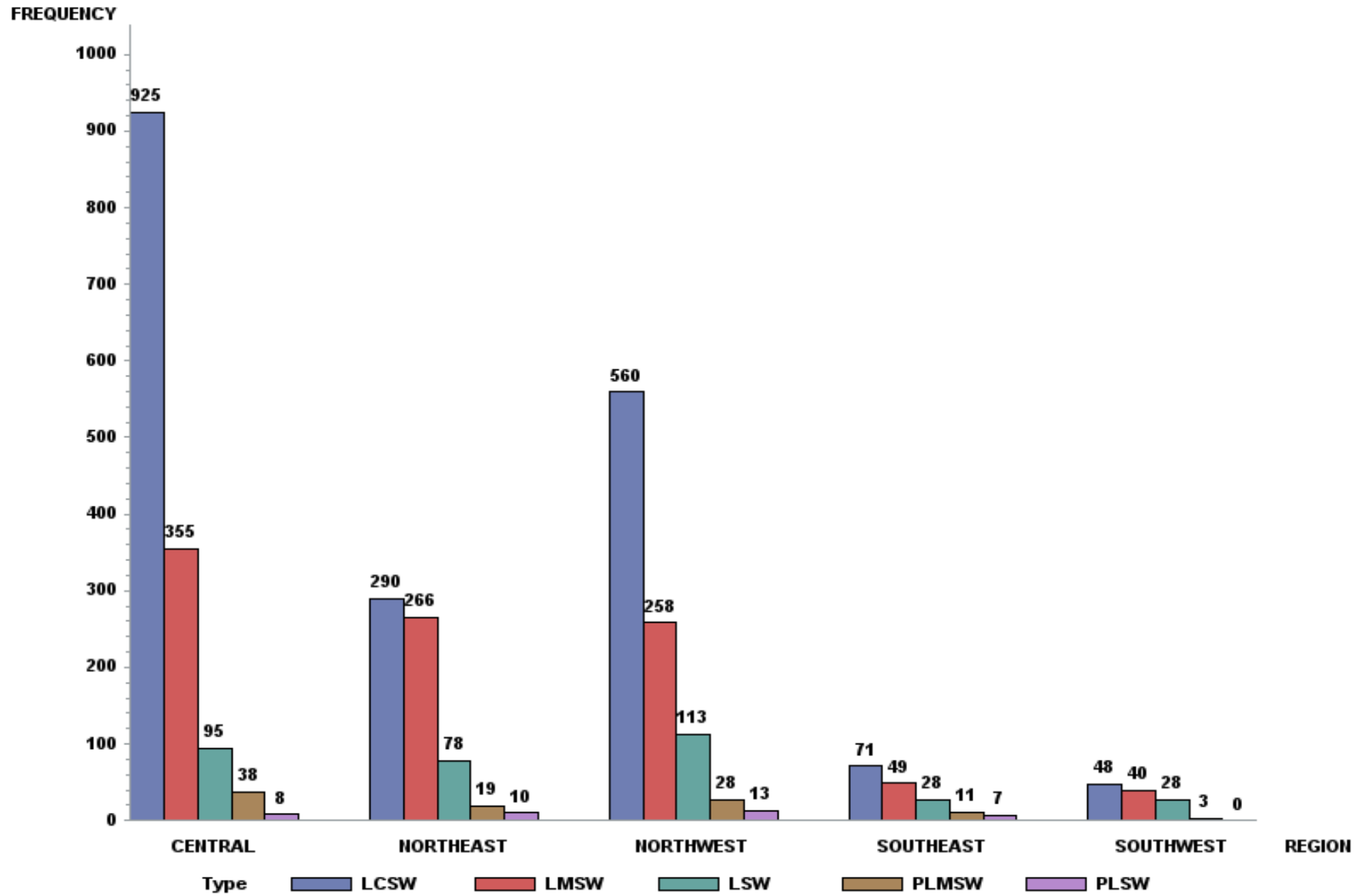
Distribution of Social Workers by Region

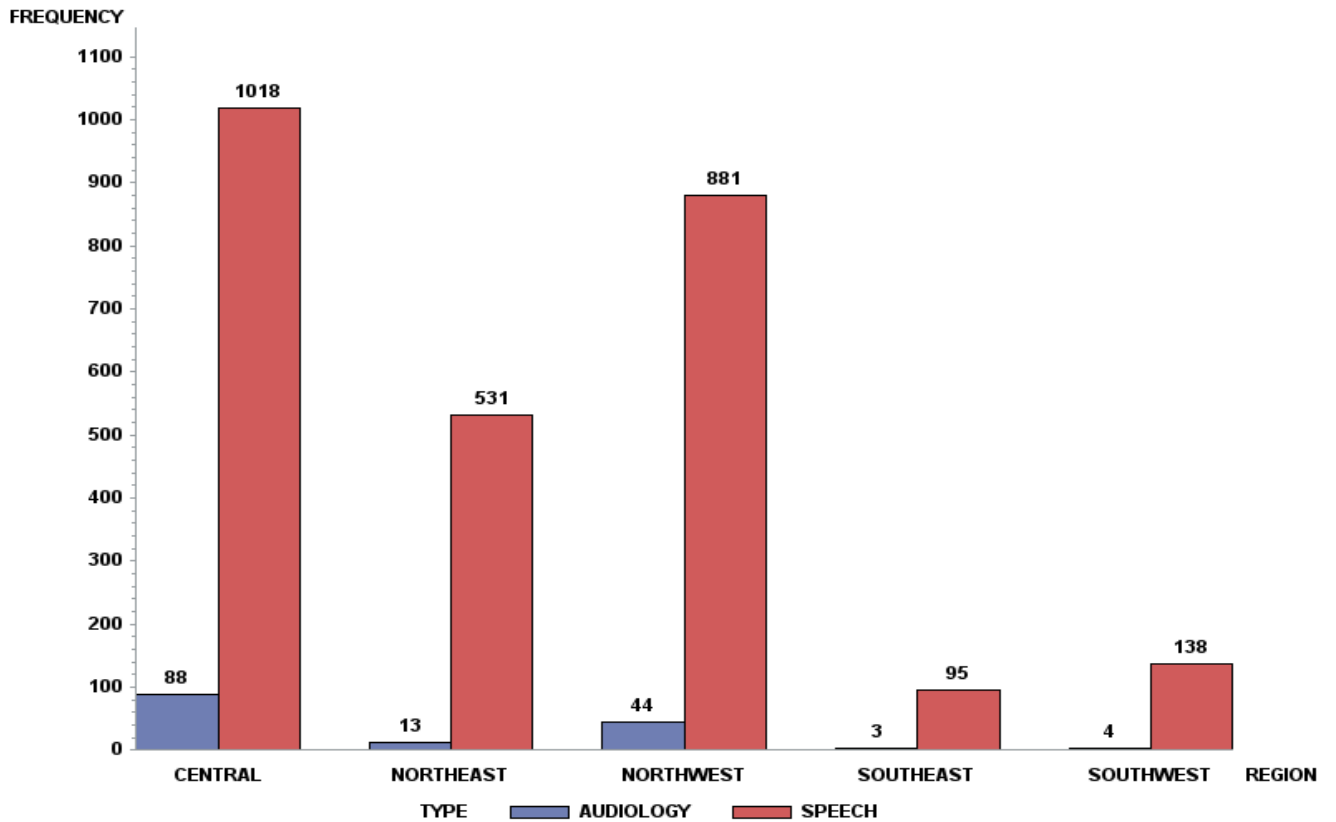
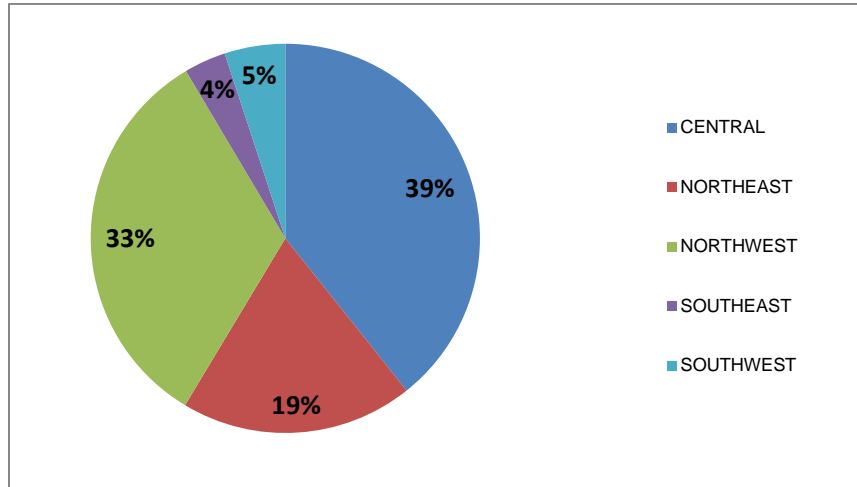
Speech Pathologists and Audiologists by County Per 10,000 Population

Speech Pathologists and Audiologists by Region



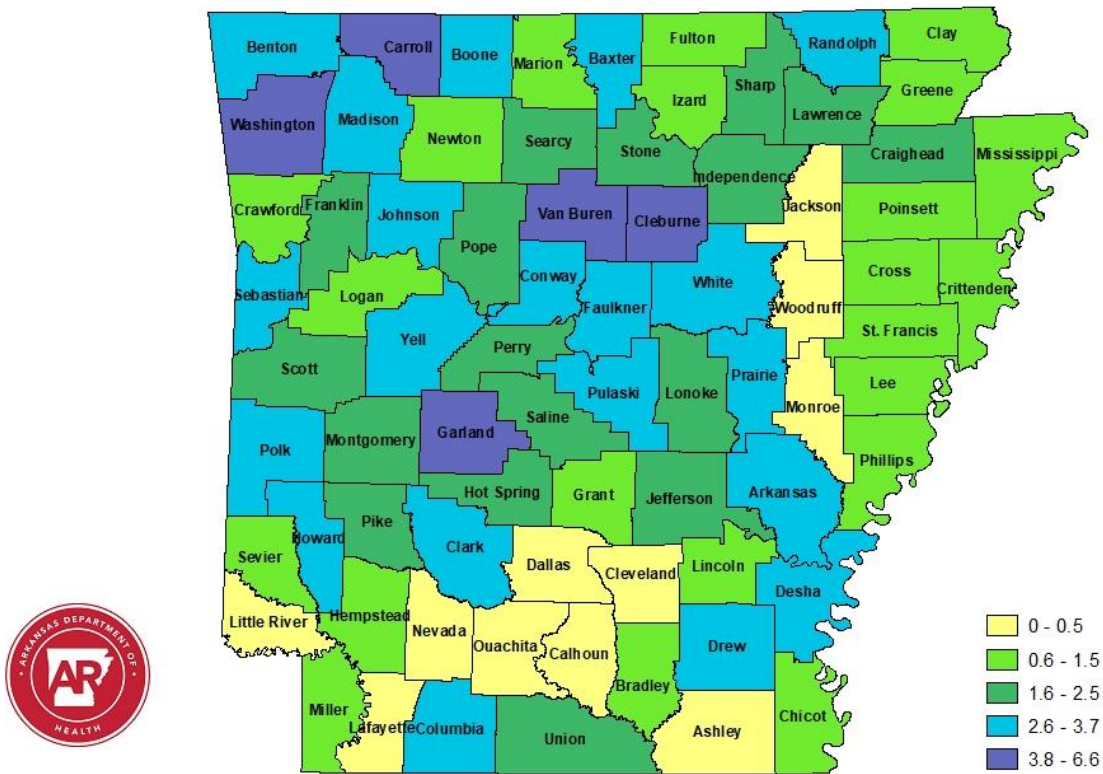

Veterinarians by County Per 10,000 Population

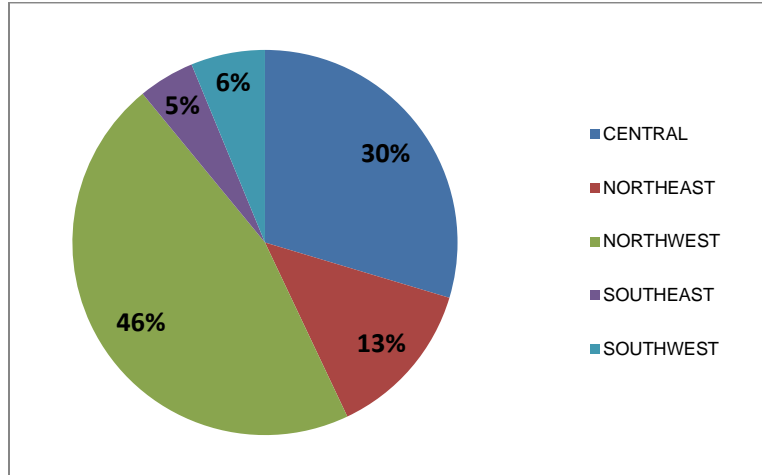

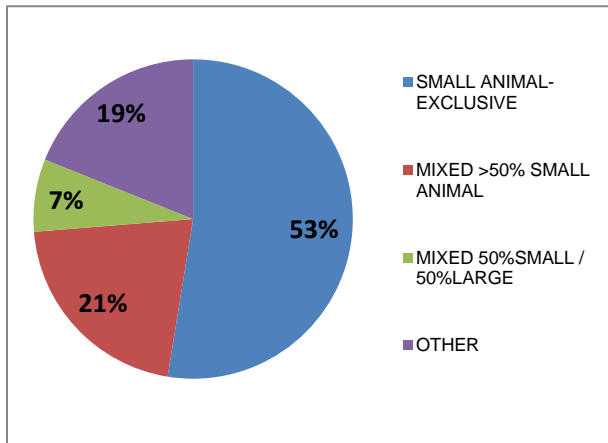

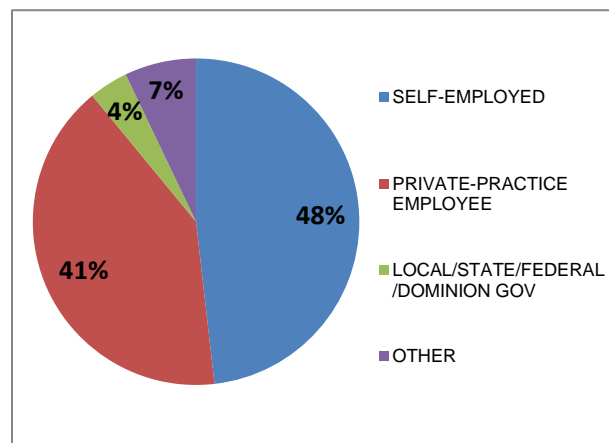
