Determines the scene is safe	1	
Determines the mechanism of injury/nature of illness	1	
Determines the number of patients	1

<b>PRIMARY SURVEY/RESUSCITATION</b>		
Verbalized general impression of the patient	1	
Determines responsiveness/Level of Consciousness	1	
Determines chief complaint/apparent life-threats	1	
<b>Airway</b>		
__ Opens and assesses airway __ Inserts adjunct as indicated	2	
<b>Breathing</b>		
__ Checks pulse __ Assesses adequate ventilation __ Initiates appropriate Oxygen Therapy	4	
__ Manages any injury which may compromise breathing/ventilation		
<b>Circulation</b>		
__ Checks pulse __ Assesses skin(either color,temp,or condition)	4	
__ Initiates shock management __ Assesses for and controls bleeding		
Identifies patient priority and makes treatment/transport decision.	1	
<b>HISTORY TAKING</b>		
History of the present illness		
__ Onset __ Quality __ Severity __ Provocation	8	
__ Radiation __ Time		
__ Clarifying questions of associated signs and symptoms related to OPQRST		
Past Medical history		
__ Allergies __ Past Pertinent History __ Events leading to present illness	5	
__ Medication __ Last oral intake		
<b>SECONDARY ASSESSMENT</b>		
Assesses effected body part/system		
__ Cardiovascular __ Neurological __ Integumentary __ Reproductive	5	
__ Pulmonary __ Musculoskeletal __ GI/GU __ Psychological/Social		
<b>VITAL SIGNS</b>		
__ Pulse __ Respiratory Rate and Quality __ Blood Pressure	4	
States field impression of patient	1	
Interventions (verbalizes proper interventions/treatment)	1	
<b>REASSESSMENTS</b>		
Demonstrates how and when to reassess the patient to determine changes in condition	1	
Provides accurate verbal report to arriving EMS unit	1
