Inactive Status

Individuals wishing to be placed on inactive status must submit a written request to the Board.

- 1. A Physical Therapist or Physical Therapist Assistant on inactive status may not engage in the provision of physical therapy services.
- 2. To return to active status, the applicant must demonstrate completion of delinquent continuing education requirements up to four (4) units (40 contact hours) and pay the annual license fee, and a reinstatement fee as outlined in Section VIII.
- 3. A criminal background check is required for reinstatement.
